## **Mandeville win's men's division:**

Kris Mandeville was the winner in the men's division in the 2019-2020 Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) Scholarship Handicap Tournament. The tournament was held over a two week period (Jan. 6 - 19) with bowlers competing against each other in different leagues. Each bowler paid a nominal fee and used their scores for that night. Half of the entry fee went into the Youth Scholarship Fund and the other half was paid out to the winning bowlers. There were 209 men's entries topping last year's 177. The top ten paid positions in

Marc Renaud tossed the first ten strikes in his second game of the night. On his eleventh delivery, he momentarily left a ringing 10-pin but a vicious scout pin came flying across the alley doing its job wiping out the standing pin. His last shot was a solid pocket hit giving him a perfect game and the high single in LCTA action this week. He was participating in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at



Marcin Bowl on lanes 33 & 34 finishing the night with a 654 (300 – 77 pins over average) triple. Marc started bowling at age 8 in the youth bowling program called “Sports Club 444” at Bowlero Bowl in Windsor and he has been hitting the lanes for twenty plus years. He has a career 7-300's and 2-800's (800-801) to his credit. The once a week right handed bowler throws a ton of revs and is currently leading the league in the high average department with 223 after 51 games.



**Croskery leads the way:**

Jordan Croskery fired 793 (289- 77 pins over average – 289 – 215 – 157 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Jordan started bowling at age 11 coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and has been hitting the lanes for 17 years. Jordan is bowling in two leagues this year: the Target Trios Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl and the BMNML. He also spares in other leagues as required. He said his biggest accomplishment in bowling was when he won the JAX 60 HAMMER CHAMPIONSHIP in Jackson Michigan on April 20th last year. He has 2-800’s and 6-300’s to his credit.

**Lapointe rolls into second place:**

Ben Lapointe tossed 771 (234-279-258 – 117 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. This week he also fired 749 (269-240-232 – 110 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Mixed League (RCAFA) at Hi-Way Bowl. The high revs right hander is on a roll as he posted his career highest triple 787 (243-265-279) in the BMNML earlier in this bowling season putting him closer to the ultimate 800 series



which competitive bowlers try to achieve in their lifetime. This writer is keeping tabs on this great twenty year old bowler's 700 triples and he now has 36-700 plus triples (25 in adult leagues and 11 in youth leagues). This year he is averaging 222 after 36 games in the BMNML and in the RCAFA league his average is 213 after 66 games. His has 1-300, 2-299's and 3-298's to his credit.

### **Vandermeer slides into third:**



Rob Vandermeer wheeled 749 (289 – 74 pins over average-275) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the third high triple in LCTA bowling this past week. He is a right handed bowler with an unusual action as he sets his bowling ball down about two feet before the foul line in his delivery. Vandermeer is bowling in three leagues (full time or sparing) this year: the SMML, the Border City Men's League (BCML) and the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML). His averages in the leagues are: SMML (217-36 games), the BCML

(209 – 66 games) and the BMNML (215-12). Rob has a career 3-300's in his credit, all recorded in the BCML.

### **Newman covers fourth place:**

George Newman tossed 748 (234-225-289 – 85 pins over average – 139 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to post the week's fourth high triple. George started bowling in a 5-Pin youth bowling program at Northgate Bowl when he was 6 years old. He worked at the bowling alley at the back with the machines in his youth years. He started bowling 10-pin at age 16 and then at age 18

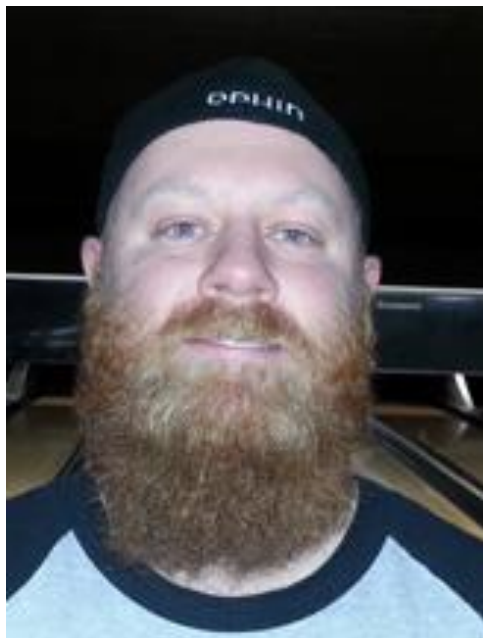


he began participating in adult 10-Pin leagues. His personal high scores are 796 and 300. The lefty is bowling in the same two leagues this year that he participated in last year:

Tom Stokes tossed 722 (268 – 74 pins over average -245 – 143 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to top his previous high triple of 700 and also record the week's second best high over average for three games. **Bestard leads the youth:**

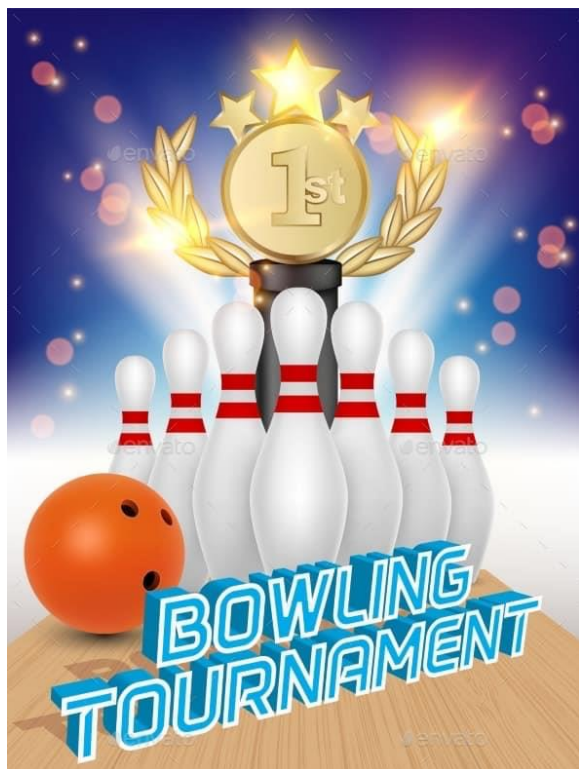
