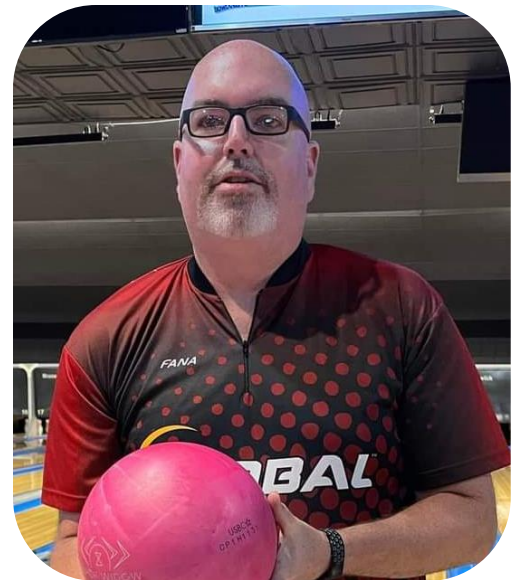

Weekly Highlights

Shephard is top bowler:

Mike Shephard tossed 755 (268 – 69 pins over average – 264-223 – 158 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to register the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. It was his 7th 700 series this bowling season in the three leagues he is bowling in full time. He has 4 (703-753-705-719) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League, 2 (747-755) in SMCL and 1 (707) in the Border City Men's League.



Leneve rolls career high triple:

Brian Leneve rolled 740 (230-231-279 – 86 pins over average – 161 pins over average for three games) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to record his career highest triple. His highest sanctioned game is 290. He came



in second place for the most pins over average for three games and the second high triple of the week in LCTA play. Leneve followed the footsteps of his dad when he started bowling at age 6 taking part in the Lake Huron Lanes and Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowling Programs. However he did say he has only bowled about a total of 11 years. Leneve is currently averaging 193 after 17 weeks of bowling in the FNFML. The right handed bowler's passion in the summer is chasing that little white ball around the golf course.

Mazgaj records personal high scores:



Zyg Mazgaj fired 644 (206-192- 246 – 84 pins over average – 158 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to post his career personal high scores. Mazgaj did not come up through a youth bowling program but started bowling at the ripe age of 53 and has been bowling steady for 22 years. He got interested in bowling when his fellow coworker Bill Cole at Nova (both are retired now) encouraged him to take up 10-pin bowling.

Cole also encouraged Mazgaj to enter tournaments like the Ontario Provincials, United States Bowling Congress tournaments and some tournaments held in Windsor. He said Bill gave me a nudge to sign up for my first Ontario Tenpin Bowling Tournament when it was held in Sarnia many years ago. Mazgaj said "I really enjoy travelling to tournaments with the guys that I bowl with because you learn a lot about bowling even at my age and you would be surprised the amount of worldly knowledge stored in those elders heads". He says he enjoys watching sports in general, nothing special nor particular. Zyg is always trying to improve his game and he said "I rely on the knowledge and worldly bowling wisdom of the bowling elders I bowl with



each week”. Zyg’s main hobby is cruising as he and his wife have taken several cruises over the years. Mazgaj is averaging 165 after 54 games in the BCML.

Desmarais is 100 pins over average:

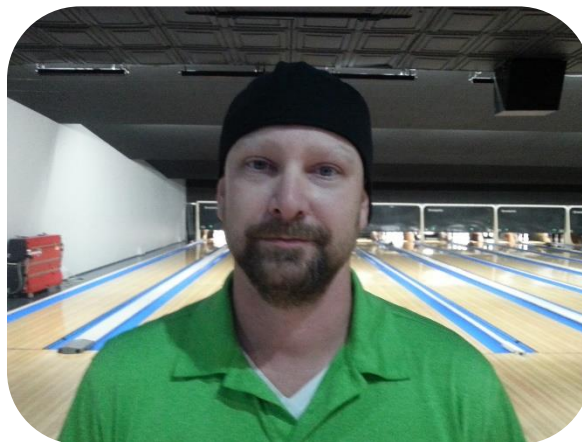


Craig Desmarais wheeled 266 (102 pins over average) in his first game of the night in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 5 & 6 at Hi-Way Bowl to take the honours as the high over average for a single game this week in LCTA activity. His accomplishment makes him eligible to receive a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch in recognition of his score. Desmarais has been bowling for 23 years. He started bowling at age 11 but did not come up through an organized youth bowling

association. Why did he take up 10-pin bowling? The answer is simple as he was following the footsteps of his father. Besides bowling, his other sporting interests are weightlifting and football. He said his hobbies are weightlifting and board games. He is currently averaging 164 for 51 games in the league. His personal sanctioned high scores are 682 and 279. Desmarais bowls on the team “Bowling Stones” with his wife Sascha, Cheryl Karchewski and George Karchewski.

Lucas increases career high scores:

Jason Lucas tossed 670 (263 – 94 pins over average – 193-214 – 163 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men’s League (BCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to increase his career high scores. His previous high scores were



649 and 255. His new high single was good for second place in the week's most pins over average for a single game and his new high triple was good for the week's most pins over average for three games. Lucas is averaging 172 for 57 games in the BCML this year.

Kinny nipped to fourth:



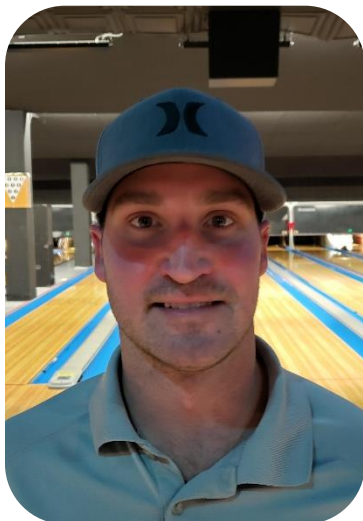

it was time to get back on the lanes which he did last year thanks to his cousin Ryan Webb who twisted his arm to return. Kinney is averaging 199 after 17



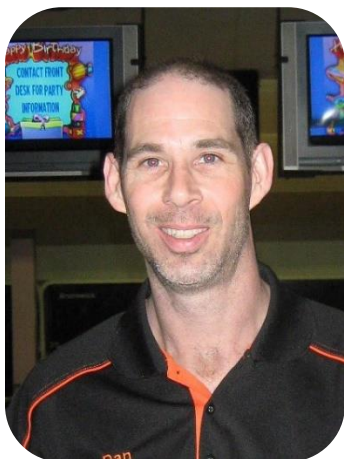
weeks of bowling. His sanctioned career high scores are 800 and 279 which he recorded on October 2, 2002.

Dan Chopp rolled the first ten strikes with perfect pocket hits. He missed the pocket on his 11th delivery leaving three pins. He made the spare ending up with a 287 which was good for the high single of the week in LCTA competition. He was bowling in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 724 (287 – 73 pins over average – 203-234) triple which was good for the sixth high triple of the week. Chopper is averaging 216 after 57 games in the BCML this year.

Ridealgh knocked to seventh spot:

Bill Ridealgh fired 722 (243-223-256 – 65 pins over average – 149 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record the seventh high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action.
