## **Week's top bowler:**



Matt Salmons hurled 739 (255-289 – 71 pins over average) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to register the week's high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. Matt is having great year in the SMML averaging 220 after 39 games. Matt has 4-300's (sanctioned) to his credit and 1-800 (sanctioned – 803) which he achieved in Century Bowl in Edmonton.

Glenn Crowe tossed 734 (279 – 74 pins over average -236 – 219 - 119 pins over average for three games - lanes 31 & 32) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to tie for the second best triple in LCTA play this week. Melissa Legault fired 682 (247-236) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) at Marcin Bowl to lead the way for the ladies. Melissa established her skills on the lanes when she was coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. She is only bowling in the TNLL this year but has bowled in Port Huron over the years and is known as the only woman to record 2-800's (817-812) in the Port Huron Bowling Association history. She also has 12-300's to her credit. She is averaging 209 after 51 games this year.

**Personal best triple and high over average:**

Mike Nimmo tossed 639 (229 – 79 pins over average – 200 -210 – 189 pins over average for three games – on lanes 25 & 26) in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to post his personal highest triple and also the week's high over average. Mike did not come up through a youth bowling program but started bowling in the TNML last year and is hooked on the great sport. He is a once a week league bowler averaging 154 after 57 games. Last year he finished the season with a 151 average. His highest single game is 246. His main change (something his coach Gil Jean wanted him to do for a while) he said "is when I push out I just let my arm fall and let gravity do its thing resulting in a big difference in my consistency".
