## Weekly Highlights

### Pair are perfect in same league:

Kyle Adamson and Billy Best tossed perfect games this past week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling activity. They were the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> 300's in the LCTA this season.



Adamson wheeled his 300 (95 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl in his last game of the night posting his career 8<sup>th</sup> perfect game and finished the night with a 660 triple. It was his first perfect game since the 2016-2017 season when he rolled a 300 in his last game in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on November 21, 2016. Adamson is averaging 206 for 63 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 212 for 96 games.

Best rolled his 300 (95 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl in his last game of the night to record his career 4<sup>th</sup> 300 and finished the night with a 640 triple. It was his first perfect game since the 2022-2023 season when he tossed 300 in his last game of the night in the FTBMNML on March 27, 2023. Best is averaging 205 for 54 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 196 for 93 games.



Creasor fires top triple:



Jim Creasor fired 793 (278 – 55 pins over average – 276 – 53 pins over average – 239 – 124 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League as a spare on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season in the LCTA as he previously bowled 771 (204-300-267). Creasor is now averaging 231 for 15 games in the league.

Leneve joins 700 club:



Brian Leneve tossed 760 (248 - 46 pins over average - 267 – 65 pins over average – 245 – 43 pins over average – 154 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to register the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his first 700 of the season and his career highest triple topping his previous high 740 (230-231-279) which he recorded in the 2022-2023 season in the MFFL. He also bowled 706 (259-224-223) in the LCTA Team Tournament to record his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season. Leneve, a right-handed bowler, has a 290-career high single. Brian followed the footsteps of his dad ( lefty Dick Leneve) when he started bowling at age 6 taking part in the Lake Huron Lanes and Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowling Programs. However, he has only bowled for about a total of 14 years. Leneve is currently averaging 204 for 66 games in the MFFL bowling with teammates Beckie Leneve, Tyler Hoadley and Ed Hoadley. Last year in the league he averaged 196 for 90 games.

*Williams bowls career high triple:*



Dan Williams bowled 608 (191-181-236 – 72 pins over average) in the Mulder Financial Fun League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to record his career high triple. His personal high single is 241. Williams is averaging 166 for 63 games in the league this year bowling with teammates Becky Adams, Alexandra and Dion Maness. Last year in the league he averaged 167 for 96 games.

*Reidel tops his high scores:*

Youth bowler Reid Reidel wheeled 399 (112-170 – 56 pins over average – 117 ) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to top his previous high scores of 386 and 158. Reid is averaging 114 after 22 weeks on the lanes bowling with teammates Elias Ko and Callum Haywood. This is Reid’s third year in the PYL. In the 2022=2023 season he averaged 78 for 81 games. Last year in the league he averaged 99 for 69 games.

*Ingles beats his high single:*

Zachary Ingles rolled 247 (76 pins over average) in his first game of the day to beat his previous 245 high single. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl. Zachary is averaging 171 after 22 weeks of bowling. Last week in the PYL he recorded his career high triple 676 (239 -218-219).



### *Aitken wheels new high single:*



Dave Aitken wheeled 234 (81 pins over his average) in his second game of the night to beat his previous 219 high score. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 563 triple. His career high triple is 624 (219-197-208) which he tossed this season in the FTBMNML. Aitken is averaging 154 for 54 games this season bowling on the "Kingpins" team with Chris Slote, Everett Mauger, Ed Kelly and Carl Best. Last year in the league he averaged 153 for 84 games.

### *Plumb rolls a triplicate:*



Larry Plumb hurled 639 (213-213-213) in the Best Wiring Classic League on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record the LCTA's 2<sup>nd</sup> triplicate this season. The other one belongs to Chris Murphy when he fired 567 (189-189-189) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League. Triplicates tend to be a rarity, but the LCTA now has six in three seasons. The other four, Cheryl Karchewski 300 (100-100-100), Mel Kongus 549 (183-183-183), John Armstrong 741 (247-247-247) and Ben Lapointe 684 (228-228-228) were from the last two seasons.

### *Gauthier grabs third place:*



Brandon Gauthier fired 747 (247-235-265 – 54 pins over average ) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week. It was his 3<sup>rd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously rolled 776 (290-376-210) and 713 (231-237-245). Gauthier is averaging 213 for 54 games in the SPBCML this year.



Mezzatesta is good for fourth spot:



Roy Mezzatesta tossed 729 (247-203-279 – 68 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to register the 4<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. He also bowled 709 (236-259-214) in the LCTA Team Tournament for his 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> 700’s of the season. Roy is now averaging 213 for 55 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 206 for 93 games.

Ridealgh good for 2-700’s:



Jamie Ridealgh rolled 724 (258-254-212) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to post the 5<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. He also rolled 717 (227-256-234) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to tie with Bryce Watson and Kirk Ramsay for the 6<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. They were his 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> 700’s of the season as he previously bowled 729, 713, 705, 777 and 711. Jamie is having a solid year in both leagues averaging 222 for 42 games in the BWCL and 214 for 45 games in the FTBMNML.

Watson tossed 717 (275 – 67 pins over average – 215-227) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to record his 8<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season and his career 14<sup>th</sup> 700. Bryce is averaging 210 for 57 games in FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 205 for 74 games.



Ramsay wheeled 717 (244-248-225) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post his 9<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season. Kirk is averaging 231 for 54 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 220 for 33 games.

### *Parkkila gets number two:*

Justin Parkkila fired 713 (222-257-234 – 128 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to bowl his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 712 (252-231-219). His triple was good for the 7<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. Justin is now averaging 199 for 33 games in the league bowling with his twin brothers Cameron and Kole, Bryce Watson and Logan Klampsta.



### *Wickens enters 700 club:*



Jeff Wickens bowled 711 (228-273 – 76 pins over average – 210) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to register the 8<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. It was his first 700 of the season. Jeff is averaging 201 for 29 games in the league this year bowling on the "Marcin Maulers" team with teammates Ron Langille, Stewart Choptovy, Mike Sheppard and Curt Cassetta.

### *Lapointe notches another 700:*

Ben Lapointe rolled 705 (205-265 – 48 pins over average - 235) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to register the 9<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. It was his 22<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season and his career 136<sup>th</sup> 700. Lapointe remains 2 behind Mike Shephard in the race for the season's 700 crown. Ben is averaging 218 for 66 games in the SPBCML this year.



### *Shephard increases his crown lead:*
