Wilkinson is perfect:



Johnny Wilkinson fired twelve explosive strikes in a row in the 1046 Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to post a perfect game in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. He performed the feat in his third game of the night on lanes 31 & 32. It was his career 4th perfect game and the 4th 300 shot in the LCTA this season. The high rev right handed bowler finished the night with 718 (225- 300 – 99 pins over average).

Lacasse leads the way:

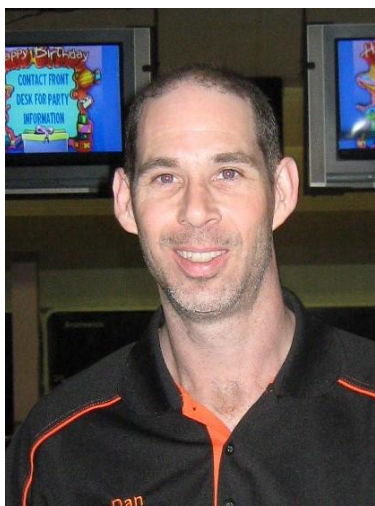


Pat Lacasse rolled 777 (266-266-245 – 138 pins over average for three games) on lanes 19 & 20 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to lead the way on the lanes as he posted the high triple in LCTA action. Lacasse, a smooth left handed solid opponent, has 4-800's and 8-300's to his credit in American and Canadian league and tournament competition.

Plumb and Chopp are second best:

Larry Plumb hurled 756 (245-221-290 – 85 pins over average - 11 in a row -141 pins over average for three games) on lanes 15 & 16 in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple of the week. Plumb, who is a right handed bowler and usually delivers a fast first ball shot between the 8-11 boards, is averaging 213 after six weeks of bowling. Larry has 7-300's and 6-800's under his belt in league and tournament action in Canada

and the United States.



Dan Chopp rolled 756 (244-245-267) in the Border City Men's League at Marcin Bowl on lanes 21 & 22 to share the honours for the second high triple of the week. He is having an awesome year so far averaging 234 after 21 games in the league. Chopp is a smooth right handed bowler who has learned to roll the ball the right way when he was developing his skills through the Marcin Bowl SMAA Youth Bowling Program. He credits his past bowling coaches Dave LeClair, Roger Croteau and Tom Stokes for his success. Chopper has 8-300's to his credit having bowled three of them in the Border City Men's League in the 2015-2016 season.
