## **Weekly Highlights**

### **Lefty is solid on the lanes:**



Steve Lewicki fired 733 (268 – 53 pins over average – 241-224) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 744 (265-224-255). Steve is averaging 219 after 18 games in the BWCL this season bowling with team mates Kelly Sitter and Kerry Friis. Last season he averaged 213 for 60 games in the league.

### **Roehler posts new high three:**



Zack Roehler hurled 690 (222-246 – 70 pins over average – 222 – 162 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action, to record a new personal high triple. His old high triple was 647 and his career high single is 256. Zack had 29 out of 30 marks splitting in the 10<sup>th</sup> frame of his last game. Roehler is a spare bowler on the "H. Moore Windows And Doors" team consisting of Bill Cole, Zyg Mazgaj, Mark Roehler and Rod Honke. Last year Zack averaged 176 for 30 games in the league.



**Jenken rolls first 200 game:**

Dennis Jenken rolled 214 (89 pins over average) in his first game of the night to register his career first 200 game. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl. Jenken's career high triple is 467 (189-115-163) which he recorded in the SPBCML in the 2023-2024 bowling season. Jenken started bowling in the SPBCML in the 2021-2022 season ending the year with a 98 average for 39 games. The following year he finished with a 107 average for 72 games. In the 2023-2024 season he finished with a 124 average for 90 games. In the 2024-2025 season he ended with a 124 average for 90 games.

This year Dennis is averaging 127 for 21 games bowling on the "Bluewater Plumbing Company" team with Mark Brooker, Rob Vandermeer and Dave LeClair.

**Parkkila wheels new high single:**
