Weekly Highlights

Croskery fires top triple:



Jordan Croskery fired 740 (234-265-241) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling activity. Jordan started bowling at age 11 coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and has been hitting the lanes for 19 years. Jordan is bowling in two leagues this year: the SMML and the Marcin Border City Men's League (BCML). He also spares in other leagues as required. He said his biggest accomplishment in bowling was when he won the JAX 60 HAMMER CHAMPIONSHIP in Jackson Michigan on April 20th last year. He has 2-800's

and 6-300's to his credit. He is currently averaging 208 for 21 games in the BCML and 224 after 18 games in the SMML.

Potvin wheels career first 700 series:

Brian Potvin wheeled 706 (248-256 – 76 pins over average – 202 – 166 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to record his career personal first 700 series. His previous high triple was 675. He also tied his career highest single game with his 256. Potvin is another 10-pin bowler who started out on



the lanes trying his luck with 5- pin. At age six he began enjoying the great sport of bowling (5pin) in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. After 12 years of 5-pin bowling and at the age of 18, Brian decided to give 10-pin a shot. He has been enjoying the fun and friendship ever since with fellow bowlers for thirty plus years. He is currently averaging 189 after 18 games. Last year in the BCML he averaged 184 for 51 games.

Legault is ladies top bowler:



Karyne Legault wheeled 688 (214-231-243 – 121 pins over average for three games) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) at Marcin Bowl to lead the way for the ladies this week in LCTA bowling action. Karyne started 10 pin bowling at the age of four coming up through Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl youth bowling programs and the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program at Northgate Bowl. Her bowling accomplishments include victories in the 2002 YBC Nationals in New Brunswick, 2005 CYC (Christian Youth Camps) Nationals in British Columbia, 2009 CYC Nationals In Winnipeg and 2010 Team Canada in Finland. She has 1-300 to her credit and her high triple is 797. This year she is averaging 202 after 9 games in the TNLL which is forced to bowl alternate weeks due to COVID 19. Last year in the TNLL Legault finished the year with a 213 average for 66 games.
