Weekly Highlights

Adamson rolls top Scores:



Kyle Adamson rolled the first nine solid pocket strikes in his first game of the night. Then lane 25 pin setter broke down. Once the lane was repaired, he completed strikes 10 and 11 with solid pocket hits. He set himself up on the lane for his final shot with his heart RPM's picking up speed and a multitude of eyes watching him from both leagues. He released the ball with good follow throw but the ball came up slightly light on the head pin with all the pins falling except the stubborn 7 pin. Another pin was rolling in a circle just shy of the pin holding

him back from another perfect game. He turned around with disappointment on his face to carry out the hand shaking with his fellow bowlers. He finished with a 299 game which was good for the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. He was bowling on lanes 25 & 26 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 733 (299 – 96 pins over average – 223 – 211) which



was also good for the high triple of the week. He is now averaging 206 for 45 games in the BCML. Adamson has a career sanctioned 19 Honour scores to his credit: 800's-6, 300's -7, 299's-3 and 298's-3.

Youth bowler rolls personal high scores:



Noah Legault tossed 515 (190 - 70 pins over average - 160-165 – 155 pins over average for three games) in the Marcin Bowl Junior Bowlers Program to record his personal high scores. Noah started bowling in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program at age 5 and he has been knocking down the pins for 5 years now. Noah's parents are both bowlers so it was only natural that he was exposed to bowling since he was born. Noah started league bowling with his cousin Braeden and being on the same team they anxiously looked forward every week to the Saturday morning fun. Noah's other sporting activity is baseball. 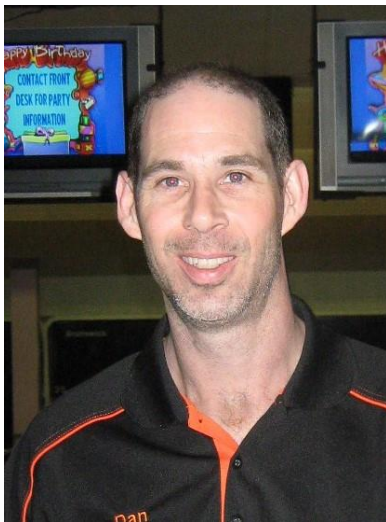
Fraser rolls personal high triple:

Webb is 100 pins over average again:



Ryan Webb fired 276 (107 pins over average) in his second game of the night in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to be the week's high over average for a single game in LCTA activity. This is Webb's second time in the last two years to achieve this accomplishment. Last season in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl he tossed 256 which made him eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation

Gark posts top triple in SMCL:

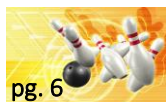

He bowled as a spare and is averaging 213 after 6 games in the SMCL. Gark started bowling at age 7 coming up through the SMAA in the early 70's and continued in the program until he was 16 years old. The 60 year old left handed bowler

has been bowling recreationally over the years together with some organized mixed league bowling when he was in his 30's and he has also spared in men's leagues over the years. This writer checked the LCTA year average books over the last 11 years and was unable to find an established average for Gark. To establish an average you have to bowl 21 games in one league. Gark became interested in bowling through his parents and his grandfather. His parents were in the SMAA executive at that time of his youth bowling. His other sporting interest is basketball, a game he has played competitively since grade 9. Jeff said he played basketball at Central High School for John Thrasher and then went on to Laurentian University where he played Varsity basketball in his university years. After university he joined the Sarnia Police Force where he played on several police basketball teams that competed across the country. Gark has been helping to coach high school and Lambton College basketball teams over the last 20+ years. The last 5 years he has helped coach the Lambton College woman's basketball team. Presently he is helping with the under 17 girls' basketball team at Northern High School. Besides bowling his other hobbies are hunting and fishing. Gark, who has been pretty much a spare bowler over the years, has sanctioned high scores of 289 and 709.
