## Weekly Highlights

### Croskery is king of the lanes:



Jordan Croskery fired 751 (268- 59 pins over average - 246-237) on lanes 15 & 16 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl to be the top bowler in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) this week. Jordan is averaging 219 for 12 games in the SMCL. Croskery has a career sanctioned 7- 300's and 2 – 800's (highest is 826) to his credit. Croskery is a graduate of the Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowling Program.

### Schofield holds down second spot:

Kevin Schofield rolled 746 (278 – 256 – 212) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League to register the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. The smooth left handed bowler has a career sanctioned 20 -300's and 10 – 800's (5 in Canada and 5 in Florida) to his credit.



**Friis in third position:**

Kerry Friis tossed 716 (278- 89 pins over average – 236 -202 – 149 pins over average for three games) on lanes 23 & 24 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Marcin Bowl to take third position in the high triple department this week in LCTA bowling action. Friis started 10-pin bowling at age 4 coming up through the Huron Bowl Junior Bowling Program in the London and District Bowling Association. Kerry's mother got him interested in bowling so he was basically born and raised in a bowling alley

knocking down the pins for the last 50 years. His other sporting interests are golfing and skiing. His hobbies are boating and puttering around the house doing home renovation projects. Friis, a right handed bowler, has personal high sanctioned scores of 790 and 300 (6). Kerry and his wife Jill commute from Mount Brydges to take part in the SMCL.

**Lewicki slides to fourth:**

Steve Lewicki wheeled 708 (236-239-233) in the Sunday Morning Classic League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the fourth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. **Raymond a close fifth:**

The Wallaceburg resident has a career 3-300's to his credit. He has tossed 2-300's at Marcin Bowl and his other 300 was recorded in tournament action at Revs Rose Bowl in Windsor. This is Raymond's first year back to bowling after taking two years off from the lanes when Covid – 19 invaded our country.
