Weekly Highlights

Watson Senior is top bowler of the week:



Brian Watson celebrated his 50th birthday by tossing 767 (255 – 47 pins over average – 279 – 71 pins over average – 233 – 143 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to post the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. It was his 2nd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 702 (245-222-235). Watson is now averaging 210 for 63 games in the BWCL bowling with teammates Kerry Friis and Bill Ridealgh. His career high scores are 785 and 300 (3).

Hoadley tops his high triple:

Tyler Hoadley rolled 726 (247 – 58 pins over average - 235 – 244 – 55 pins over average – 159 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to establish a new personal high triple and post the 5th high triple of the week. His previous high triple was 718 (210-257-251) which he recorded in the FTBMNML six weeks ago. These were his career first 2-700’s and this writer is expecting many more from this young talented



bowler. Hoadley is now averaging 192 for 51 games in his first year in the FTBMNML. His career high single game is 267.

Newman is 100 pins over average:



Lefty George Newman fired 279 in his last game of the day to qualify for the Canadian Tenpin Federation 100 pins over average award for a single game which is a watch. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with 728 (219 – 47 pins over average – 230 – 58 pins over average – 279 – 107 pins over average – 212 pins over average for three games). It was his first 700 of the season and the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Newman did not have any 700's last season. George is now averaging 176 for 66 games in the BWCL this year bowling with teammates Peter English and Mike Marciniszyn. Last year in the league he averaged 177

for 99 games. Two of Newman's most memorable moments in bowling were when he bowled his first 300 and when he had the first 10 strikes in the defunct very difficult American Bowling Congress (ABC) tournament in Reno Nevada finishing with a 289. The ABC has since become the United States Bowling Congress. George's career high triple is 796.

Fraser records new high triple:

Michelle Fraser tossed 637 (233 – 57 pins over average – 179-225 – 49 pins over average) in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record a personal new high triple and take the honours for the ladies high triple of the week in LCTA activity. Her previous high triple was 616 and her career high single game is 244. Michelle is averaging 176 after 21 weeks of bowling in the league with teammates Jayme LeNeve, Colleen Baldwin, Rick Kloczko and Kevin Ptolemy.



Baldwin tops her old high scores:



Colleen Baldwin fired 625 (184-237 – 72 pins over average – 204 - 130 pins over average for three games) in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record new personal high scores. Her previous high scores were 594 (211-199-184), which she bowled in week two in the B10TNML this season and 225. Colleen is averaging 165 after 21 weeks on the lanes this season. Last year in the league she averaged 158 for 90 games.

Legault rolls his first 600:



Noah Legault rolled 606 (203-208-195 – 105 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record his career first 600 triple. His previous high triple was 596 (182-245-169) which he tossed in the PYL this season. He also registered his career high single game (245) the same day. Noah is averaging 167 after 20 weeks in the league this season bowling with teammates Lennox Dean and Brayden Steadman.

Sharon Lewicki wheeled 588 (223 – 55 pins over average – 160-205) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. Her previous high triple was 579 (193-165-221) which she posted in the MFFL last season, and her high single is 235 which she bowled in the MFFL this season. Fox rolls new high scores:

His previous high triple was 685 (178-270-237) which he bowled in the MFFL this season and his high single game is 270. Bonhomme works for the railway and at age 36 in the 2022- 2023 was a late starter to get involved for the first time with the great sport of 10-pin bowling. He moved to Sarnia from Northern Ontario and

thought it would be a great way to get out, have fun and create a new network of friends.

Rob is averaging 181 for 57 games in the MFFL and 179 for 51 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League this year.

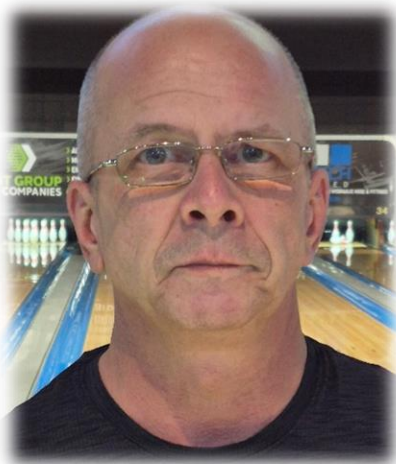
Lapointe is now one behind Shephard:

Ben Lapointe rolled 752 (255-254-243) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling



competition. He also tossed 739 (257-248-234) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to post the 3rd high triple of the week. They were his 20th and 21st 700's this season and his career 134th and 135th 700's. Lapointe is sneaking up to Mike Shephard for the season's 700 crown and now trails Shephard by one as Mike's game has cooled down the last few weeks. Lapointe is having a solid year on the lanes averaging 225 for 54 games in the FTBMNML, 218 for 60 games in the SPBCML and 228 for 57 games in the Best Wiring Classic League.

Cook enters season's 700 club:



Lefty Dan Cook rolled 728 (225-268 – 76 pins over average – 235 – 152 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to record his first 700 of the season and tie with George Newman for the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Cook did not have any 700's last year. Dan did not come up through a youth bowling program but started 10-pin bowling at age 21. He has been knocking down the pins for thirty-five years. His most memorable occasion on the lanes is when he won the HI-Way Bowl Open Tournament in 1996. Cook is bowling in

two leagues this year, averaging 192 for 63 games in the Best Wiring Classic League and 195 for 61 games in the SPBCML bowling with teammates Craig Desmarais, Dan Beauvais and Kevin Lyon. His career sanctioned high scores are 300-2 and 802 which he bowled in Windsor in 2009.

Watson adds to his 700's:

Bryce Watson tossed 718 (251-232-235) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) as a spare on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record the 6th high triple of the week in the LCTA.
