Croskery is perfect again:



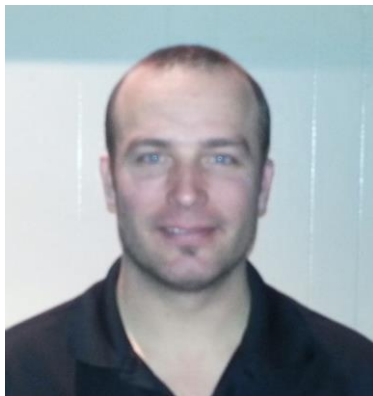

Peter MacRae tossed 773 (257-237-279 – 167 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the LCTA high triple of the week.
