



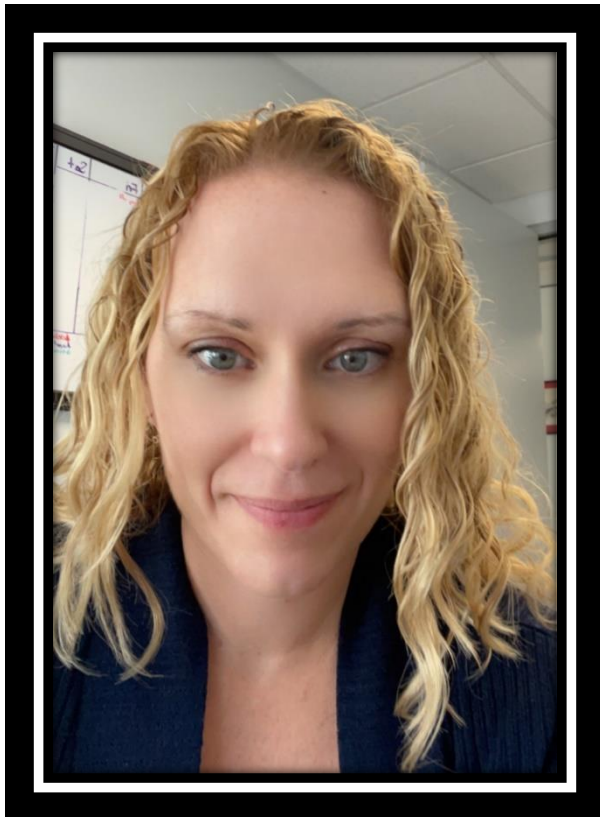

Shephard tops her high single:



Roni Shephard tossed 279 (99 pins over average) topping her previous high 243 which she rolled in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl last week. Her score was good for the ladies' high single of the week. She was bowling in the BWCL on lanes 19 & 20 finishing with a 605 triple which was also good for the ladies' high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Roni is now averaging 183 for 21 games in the league this year.

Phillion is 100 pins over average:

Eric Phillion wheeled 235 (128 pins over average) to be 100 pins over average for a single game this past week. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl as a spare finishing the night with a 492 triple. Phillion is a new bowler and is now averaging 126 for 9 games in the league.

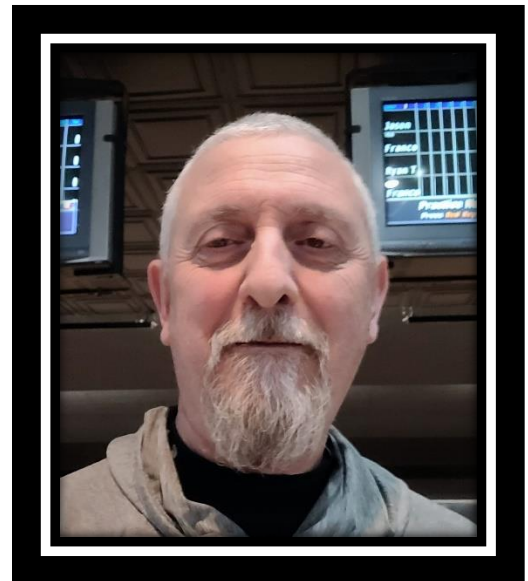


Chipman rolls high triple of the week:

Shane Chipman rolled 736 (267-246-223) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record the top triple of the week in LCTA bowling fun. It was his third 700 this season as he previously rolled 722 (278-224-220) and 729 (195-268-266). Chipman is averaging 223 for 15 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 207 for 75 games. Shane is also bowling this year in the Best Wiring Classic League averaging 212 for 18 games and the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League averaging 216 for 12 games.

Mezzatesta takes second position:

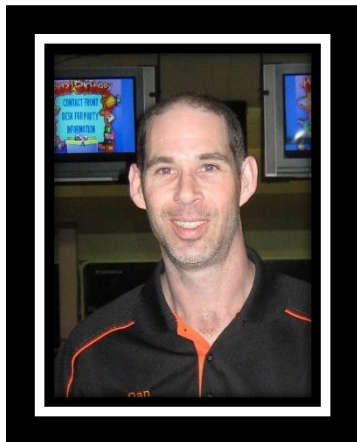
Roy Mezzatesta hurled 722 (265 – 45 pins over average – 245-212) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 4th 700 in the LCTA this year. The "Mezz" is having a great year in the SPBCML this year averaging 223 for 18 games. Last year in the SPBCML he averaged 217 for 96 games. Roy is also bowling full time this year in the Best Wiring Classic League averaging 209 for 15 games and the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League averaging 212 for 12 games.

*Chopp and Adamson tie for last spot:*

Dan Chopp and Kyle Adamson tied for last spot in the 700 department this past week in LCTA bowling action.

Chopp fired 715 (242 – 42 pins over average – 268 – 68 pins over average – 205 – 115 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on





lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to tie for last spot in the 700 race this past week. It was his first 700 this season as “Chopper” has been struggling on the lanes so this should do wonders for his confidence. In the 2022-2023 he had 11-700’s and in the 2023-2024 season Dan rolled 4-700’s. Last year in the SPBCML chopper finished with a 205 average for 87 games. This year in the league he is now averaging 205 for 21 games.

Adamson tossed 715 (224-244-247) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to tie Dan Chopp for the low 700 triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his third 700 this season as he previously tossed 709 (206-245-258) and 747 (247-245-255). Adamson is averaging 220 for 21 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 199 for 99 games. Kyle is also bowling full time this year in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League averaging 210 for 24 games and the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League averaging 204 for 18 games.
