Stephane Sirois left everybody in the dust in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl this week as he fired 757 (278 - 71 pins over average – 254 -225 – 136 pins over average for three games – 28 out of a possible 36 strikes) to record the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this week. Under challenging lane conditions, his closet rival in the BCML was 115 pins behind him. The right handed bowler did not start bowling in a youth program but started enjoying this great sport at age 26 and has been bonding with the boys on the lanes for 24 years. His career sanctioned high scores are 2-300's and a 791 triple. He said his most memorable moment was in February 9th, 2017 when he posted his first perfect game.

Corey Willemsen rolled 730 (238-265-227) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin bowl to take home the week's second high triple in LCTA bowling this past week. Corey is averaging 217 after 42 games in the BMNML league. He is a once a week league bowler consistently averaging around the 211 mark the last 4 years in the league. Crowe is ladies best:

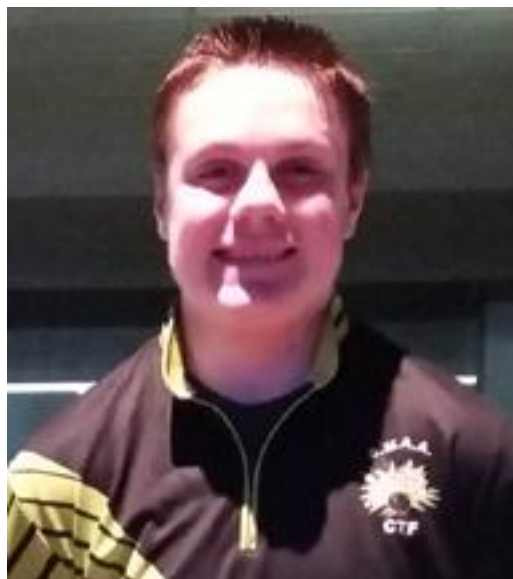

She has 2-297's to her credit, one being bowled at Northgate Bowl which was the highest game recorded in that house.
