Weekly Highlights

Leneve is the number one man:



Brian Leneve had a super night on the lanes as he fired 791 (265 – 55 pins over average – 259 – 49 pins over average – 267 – 67 pins over average – 171 pins over average for three games) to record a new personal high triple and the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. Leneve's previous high triple was 740 (230-231-279) which he posted in the Friday Night Fun League back in the 2022-2023 season and his sanctioned high single is 290. In his first two games, Leneve had the first 9 strikes only to split in the 10th frame in both games. He had 27 out of a possible 36 strikes for the night. It was Leneve's first 700 of the season. Last season he had 2-700's to his credit. Brian is averaging 213 for 60 games in the MFFL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 206 for 99 games. Leneve followed the footsteps of his father (lefty Dick Leneve – 300 – 1990-1991 season and 299 – 1997-1998 season). He started bowling at age 6 taking part in the Lake Huron Lanes and Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowling Programs.

Simard records first 600 triple:



Bobby Simard bowled 616 (203 – 60 pins over average – 201 – 58 pins over average – 212 – 69 pins over average – 187 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to record his career first 600 triple. He also posted a new high single with his 212. His previous high scores were 521 and 201 both bowled in the SPBCML this season. Bobby is a first year bowler in the SPBCML this season averaging 148 for 45 games.



Wolfgram rolls top triple in LCTA tournament:



Jim Wolfgram wheeled 768 (236 – 45 pins over average – 266 – 75 pins over average – 266 – 75 pins over average – 195 pins over average for three games) on lanes 31 & 32 in the LCTA Team Handicap Tournament at Marcin Bowl, to record the tournament's top scratch triple and the 2nd high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was also his first 700 of the season. Wolfgram returned to the lanes this season after a hiatus off the lanes of 15 years. His last LCTA book average was in the 2011-2012 season when he averaged 214 for 24 games in the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League.

Wolfgram's career sanctioned high triple is 805 which he bowled in the 1993-1994 season, Jim also has sanctioned Honour scores of 2-300's, 3-299's and 1-298 to his credit. The FULL TOURNAMENT RECAP will be in next week's bowling report.

Burr posts new high triple:



Sean Burr tossed 690 (246 – 73 pins over average – 186 – 258 – 85 pins over average – 171 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to post a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling activity. His previous high triple was 670 (232-244-194) which he bowled in the MFFL last season. Sean's sanctioned high single is 279. Burr is averaging 179 for 30 games in the MFFL this year. Last year he averaged 172 for 39 games in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League. Sean started bowling at age 6 with his brother in the Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowling program and remained in the program until age 21. He also spent two years as a grease monkey/assistant mechanic at Hi Way Bowl where he learned about the back end of a bowling lane.

Paquette records new high triple:

Nick Paquette wheeled 595 (162-199-234 – 70 pins over average) in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple topping his previous 563. His career sanctioned high single is 252 bowled in the KBTNML this season. Paquette is averaging 164 after 22 weeks of bowling this season.



Warburton registers new high triple:

Tyler Warburton hurled 560 (194-191-175) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to establish a career new high triple topping his previous 538. His career high single is 240. Warburton is averaging 161 for 63 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 162 for 90 games.

Pinel rolls top single in LCTA:

Adam Pinel tossed 298 (100 pins over average) in his last game of the night to post the high single of the week in the LCTA. He was bowling in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 17 & 18 finishing the night with a 681 triple. Pinel is eligible for a 100 pins over average for a single game award with his 298. Pinel is averaging 188 after 22 weeks of bowling this season. Last season in the league he averaged 190 for 93 games. Adam did not come up through a youth bowling program but in his preteen years he bowled a couple seasons of 5-pin at Northgate Bowl. He joined the Thursday Night Mixed League in the 1999-2000 season as a spare and has been there ever since. Pinel, a smooth left-handed bowler, has career high scores of 769 and 299 (7 pin).

**Grasser tops his high single:**

Rio Grasser rolled 241 (82 pins over average) in his second game of the day to register a new personal high single. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with a 520 triple. Rio's previous sanctioned high single was 214 which he rolled in the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Youth Singles Tournament at Classic Bowl in Mississauga last season. His sanctioned high triple is 564 (202-206-156) which he recorded in the PYL this season. Rio, a right-handed bowler, started sanctioned league bowling in the 2022-2023 season at age 9 in the PYL and finished with an 80 average for 39 games. He is averaging 159 after 22 weeks on the lanes this season. Last season he finished the season with a 123 average for 90 games.



Brissette records new high scores:

Heather Brissette tossed 430 (101 – 164 – 66 pins over average – 165 – 67 pins over average – 136 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record new personal high scores in the LCTA. Her previous high scores were 389 and 161. Heather is averaging 101 for 48 games in the MFFL this season bowling in a sanctioned league for the first time.

Youth bowler records new triple:

Mazlynn Allen bowled 405 (141-96-168 – 50 pins over average) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple topping her previous 391. Her sanctioned high single is 189. Mazlynn is averaging 118 after 22 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the league she averaged 111 for 96 games.

Lapointe rolls 3-700's:

Ben Lapointe rolled 749 (257-235-257) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28, 715 (223-268-224) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 and 714 (224-245-245) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 all at Marcin Bowl, to record the 3rd - 5th and 6th high triples of the week in the LCTA. They were his his 20th, 21st and 22nd 700's in the LCTA this season and he now has a career 163-700's to his credit. Lapointe is averaging 222 for 69 games in the BWCL this season followed by Mike Shephard at 220 for 69 games. Lapointe also holds the high average in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at 225 for 63 games followed by Mike Shephard at 222 for 63 games. Lapointe is averaging 221 for 63 games in the SPBCML this season.

Friis takes fourth place:

Kerry Friis fired 734 (234-268- 58 pins over average – 232) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 4th 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously bowled 712, 707 and 737. Friis is averaging 213 for 55 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 202 for 90 games. Kerry and his wife Jill commute from Mount Bridges to participate in the league.



Shephard adds 2-700's:

Mike Shephard hurled 713 (241-279 - 57 pins over average – 193) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 and 711 (227 – 297 – 72 pins over average – 187) on lanes 29 & 30 in the LCTA Team Handicap Tournament (THT) at Marcin Bowl, posting the 7th and 8th high triples of the week in the LCTA. They were his 16th and 17th 700's of the season in the LCTA. Shephard also bowls in the Cowboys and Indians League in Port Huron and has 6-700's in the league this season. Shephard had the first eleven strikes in his second game on Sunday in the THT, but came light on his last shot leaving the 2-4-5 pins. His 297 was good for the second high single of the week in the LCTA.

Mezzatesta notches number four:

Paul Mezzatesta fired 706 (249-240-217) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record his 4th 700 of the season and post the 9th high triple of the week in the LCTA. His three other 700's this season were 711 (219-212-280), 715 (210 – 299 – solid 10 pin – 206) and 701 (217-258-226). Paul is averaging 203 for 57 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 204 for 84 games.

Murphy reaches a dozen:

Chris Murphy has tripled his output in the 700 department over last season wearing his green shirt, green shorts and his new lime green bowling shoes. Last season he recorded 4-700's and this year Chris now has 12-700's to his credit. Murphy posted his latest one when he hurled 704 (227-255-222) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 10th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Murphy's most notable 700's this season are 760 (235-227-298), 760 (244-249-267), 762 (245-259-258), 775 (278-242-255) and 761 (226-258-277). Chris is averaging 214 for 45 games in the RCAFA league this season.



Trio share the basement:

Bryce Watson, Jamie Ridealgh and Kole Parkkila were at the bottom of the 700 club this week in LCTA bowling competition posting the same triple..



Watson tossed 700 (194-216-290 – 80 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to share the low 700 of the week with Jamie Ridealgh and Kole Parkkila. It was his 6th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 740 (266-237-237), 703 (268-222-213), 748 (268-259-221), 779 (290-232-257) and 706 (246-224-236). Bryce now has a career 21-700’s to his credit. Watson is averaging 211 for 57 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Burlington in 2023. The second one was at the International Golden Ladies Tournament in Las Vegas, Nevada in 2024.
