## Weekly Highlights

### Shephard regains the crown lead:



Mike Shephard hurled 736 (244-246-246) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 26<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season and he regains the lead over Ben Lapointe for the season's 700 crown. Shephard is bowling in three leagues this year. His averages (with games in brackets) are FTBMNML 224 (77), the Best Wiring Classic League 214 (81) and the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) 226 (63). Mike is one of two bowlers rolling an 800 series this season as he tossed 804 (268-258-278)

in the B10TNML in September and the other one belongs to Kole Parkkila as he recorded 819 (287-277-255) in the FTBMNML in January.

### Ingles rolls new high scores:

Matthew Ingles rolled 542 (189 – 52 pins over average – 138 – 215 – 78 pins over average – 131 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 451 and 190. Matthew is averaging 139 for 78 games in the MFFL. Last season in the league he averaged 128 for 99 games.



### *Visser records new triple and single:*



Zachary Visser fired 526 (138-187- 51 pins over average - 201 – 65 pins over average – 112 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 461 and 186. Visser is averaging 138 for 78 games this year in the league. Last year in the Mulder Financial Fun League he averaged 120 for 84 games.

### *Wright tops his old numbers:*



Greg Wright tossed 471 (123-149 – 199 – 78 pins over average) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to register new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 461 and 195. Wright is averaging 123 for 54 games in the MFFL. Last year in the league he averaged 116 for 66 games.

### *Bogaert posts new high single:*

Kyle Bogaert bowled 256 (83 pins over average) in his first game of the night to record his new high single game topping his previous 242. He was bowling in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl. His career high triple is 614. Kyle is averaging 173 after 28 weeks in the B10TNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 158 for 33 games.

### *Dominque beats her old high single:*

Regi Domingue fired 212 (82 pins over average) in her last game of the night to record a new high single game beating her previous 202. She was bowling in the Mike Guzik Realty Re/Max RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl. Regi, a right-handed bowler, said she wasn’t sure of her highest triple, but this writer has seen a 525 come from her bowling ball in the RCAFA league. Regi did not come up through an organized youth league but started 5-pin bowling in Alberta



in her late teens. When she and her husband moved to Ontario in 1998, they joined a 10-pin league to get to know people on the encouragement of her husband's brother who bowled in the league. Regi said "it was a date night as we had little children". They have been bowling on and off for years. When she was growing up, she played slo-pitch and softball. She enjoys playing Corn Hole at the campground. Corn Hole is a fabric sack/bag toss game usually played on lawns in which players or teams throw bags from a distance at an inclined board with a hole in it. Her hobbies include camping, reading, singing and enjoying time with her family. Regi is averaging 130 for 63 games this year. Last year in the league she averaged 137 for 63 games.

### *Beveridge wheels career high single:*



Lily Beveridge wheeled 191 (65 pins over average) in her third game of the day to record a new personal high single topping her previous high 179. She was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 457 triple. Her career high triple is 513 (158-179-176) which bowled in the PYL this season. Lily is averaging 126 after 27 weeks on the lanes this year. Last year in the league she averaged 101 for 87 games.

### *Parkkila notches number fourteen:*



Kole Parkkila tossed 717 (280 – 80 pins over average – 225-212) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to record his career 14<sup>th</sup> 700 series. It was his 9<sup>th</sup> 700 series this season. His triple was also good for the second high triple of the week in the LCTA. Parkkila is bowling full time in three leagues this year. His averages with games in brackets are SPBCML 203 (54), the Fabri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 214 (75) and the Best Wiring Classic League 202 (84).



### *Ridealgh grabs last spot:*



Bill Ridealgh rolled 712 (256-214-242) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to take third spot in the high triple department this past week in the LCTA. It was his 9<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season. Ridealgh is bowling in two leagues this year. His averages with games in brackets are the FTBMNML 211 (78) and the Best Wiring Classic League 212 (78).

### *Sinclair fires ladies high triple:*



Dara Sinclair fired 679 (193-224-262 – 72 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies high triple of the week in LCTA activity. Her 262 was also good for the ladies high single of the week. Dara is averaging 191 for 66 games in the BWCL this year bowling with teammates Doug Black and Jeff Raymond. Dara started bowling 10-pin at age 5 coming up through the SoCoMo (Sombra, Courtright, Mooretown) Youth League at the defunct Airey Lanes under the watchful eyes of Bud Sparling, Jackie McLellan (her mother) and Inez LaForge. She bowled in the SoCoMo youth league until age 16, then she joined an adult league. She has been enjoying the friendship on the lanes ever since. Her career high scores are 781 and 300 (2).

### *Ingles posts second high three for the ladies:*



Sarah Ingles tossed 624 (214-168-242 – 70 pins over average) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to post the ladies second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Sarah is averaging 173 for 66 games in the MFFL this season. Last year in the league she averaged 173 for 99 games. Her career sanctioned high scores are 662 (265-195-202) which she bowled in the MFFL last season.

Roni Shephard wheeled 247 (64 pins over average) in her last game of the night to post the ladies second high single of the week in the LCTA. She was bowling in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl. Roni is averaging 183 after 28 weeks in the league. She also bowls in the Best Wiring Classic League this year and is averaging 188 for 81 games. Her career high scores are 668 and 279.

Logan Hannah fired 579 (209-157-213) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to post the youth high triple of the week in the LCTA. Logan is averaging 171 after 27 weeks this year in the PYL. Last year in the league he averaged 163 for 72 games. His career high triple is 639 (177-243-219), which he bowled in the PYL last season, and his high single is 269 which he recorded in the PYL this season.
