## Weekly Highlights

### Robinson rolls career high triple:



Mark Robinson tossed 650 (234 – 63 pins over average – 230 - 59 pins over average -186 – 137 pins over average for three games) to register his career sanctioned high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action on the lanes this past week. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high triple was 625 and his sanctioned high single game is 252. Mark finished with a 177 average for 66 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he finished with a 171 average for 69 games.

### Gauthier closes season with top triple:

Brandon Gauthier hurled 759 (268-234-257) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to close his season with the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was his 10<sup>th</sup> 700 in the



LCTA this season as he previously posted 765-702-772-722-749-764-729-713-704. Last year Brandon had 13-700's in the LCTA. Gauthier finished with a 222 average for 24 games as a spare in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 21 for 75 games.

### **Shephard grabs second place:**



Mike Shephard fired 729 (279-235-215) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to grab second place in the 700 department this past week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 7<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously recorded 766-729-726-710-780-717. Last year Mike had 13-700's in the LCTA. Shephard finished with a 214 average for 96 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he finished with a 215 average for 93 games.



### **Lewicki a close third:**

Steve Lewicki rolled 727 (238-210 - 279 - 67 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to take the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 7<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously bowled 717-726-703-716-727-715. Last year Steve also had 7-700's in the LCTA. Lewicki finished the year in the BWCL with a 213 average for 96 games. Last year in the league he finished with a 216 average for 78 games.

### **Best nipped to fourth position:**

Brad Best wheeled 726 (259-235-232 - 132 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League



(BWCL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post the fourth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 this year as he previously rolled 706-703-722. Last year Brad had 8-700's in the LCTA. Best finished the year with a 200 average for 84 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the league he finished with a 194 average for 94 games.

**Ramsay and Raymond toss same triples:**

Kirk Ramsay and Jeff Raymond tossed identical triples in the 700 race this past week in LCTA bowling play.

Ramsay bowled 719 (185-245-289 – 76 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to share the fifth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 6<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this year as he previously tossed 751-756-712-706-715. He had no 700's in the



LCTA last season. Ramsay finished with a 214 average for 93 games in the BWCL this year.



Raymond fired 719 (279 – 73 pins over average – 202-238) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to share the fifth high triple of the week with Kirk Ramsay. It was his 5<sup>th</sup> 700 of the year in the LCTA as he previously recorded 776-706-771-717. Jeff had 4-700's in the LCTA last season. Raymond finished with a 207 for 99 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the league he finished with 207 for 96 games.

**Salmons good for sixth place:**

Alex Salmons tossed 710 (255-211-244) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWC) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the sixth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 6<sup>th</sup> 700 of the year in the LCTA as he previously posted 727-766-737-758-753. Alex had 3-700's in the LCTA last season. Salmons finished with a 212



average for 75 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he finished with a 195 average for 96 games.

### **Ridealgh comes in seventh in the race:**



Billy Ridealgh wheeled 706 (216-244-246) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record the seventh high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 6<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season in the LCTA as he previously fired 717-704-750-735-713. Last season Billy had 4-700's in the LCTA.
