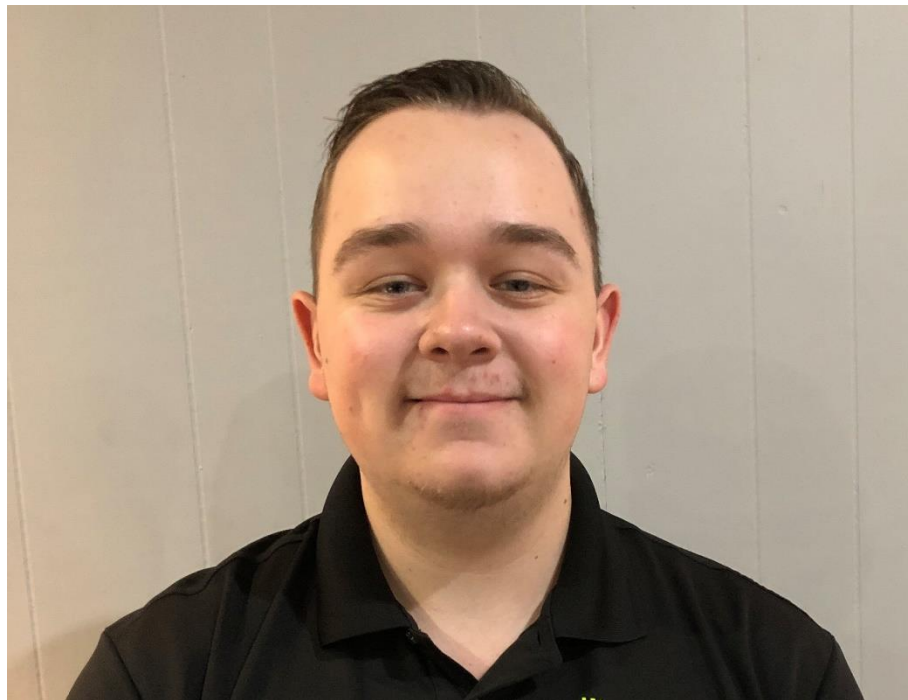

The Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Youth Program bowler's victory qualified him to represent Team Southern Ontario (TSO) in the Canadian Nationals which was to be held on the last weekend in May 2020 in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario. However due to Covid – 19, the tournament never happened. Lapointe had a great weekend to end up in the victory circle. In the qualifying round, on a modified house shot, he rolled games of 174 – 213 - 179 – 237 – 205 and 256 for a 6 game average of 210. In match play competition on Sunday on a challenging 38 foot Taj Mahal (sport shot) lane condition, with a point system in place, he fired 234 -215 – 216 – 166 – 227. At the end of the day, he was wearing the crown after his weekend performance averaging 211 for the 11 games.

Lapointe Senior a close second:



Jim Lapointe hurled 741 (227-257-257) on lanes 11 & 12 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to take second place in the high triple department this week in LCTA bowling activity.
