Pinel fires week's top triple:

Lefty Adam Pinel fired 768 (245-256-267 – 174 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. Adam is a once a week bowler but also participated in the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League for three years. He has carried a consistent average for the last eight years averaging between 193 and last year's 205.

Creasor second best:



Jim Creasor rolled 744 (224-266-254) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to post the second high triple in LCTA this week. Jim is off to a great start this bowling season as he is averaging 233 after six weeks of action on the lanes. He has been a dominant player the last eight years in the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League, the defunct Marcin Bluewater Men's League and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League. His final averages for those leagues starting in the 2010/2011 season and going to last season were 232, 229, 237, 227, 227, 224, 234, 234, 224, 238, 221, 229, 228, 230 and 224.

Chopp almost perfect:

Dan Chopp wheeled 297 in the Border City Men's League at Marcin Bowl to walk off the lanes with the high single of the week. Chopp rolled perfect pocket hits in his first eleven deliveries. On his last shot he threw it out a couple more boards to the right with a slower speed only to have the ball come high on the head pin leaving the 4-6-7 split. He was bowling on lanes 19 & 20 ending the night with a 687 triple. He is averaging 233 after eight weeks of competition.

**Pelkie tops again:**

Morgan Pelkie tossed 644 (215-247) in the Youth Intermediate Division at Marcin Bowl to take honours for the female youth top triple of the week. She is having a great season so far having already posted triples of 653, 633 and 613 and is averaging 199 after the first seven weeks on the alleys. As mentioned (picture) on the LCTA web site, Morgan has qualified to bowl on the Team Canada Youth squad and each week she is polishing up her game getting ready for the competition in 2019.

Trott leads the way for the male youth:

Joshua Trott fired 623 (211 – 246 – 66 pins over average) in the Youth Senior Division at Marcin Bowl to register the male youth high triple of the week. Joshua is struggling with his game this year but is still managing to average 184 after 18 games. His career personal best scores are a 715 triple and a 275 single game.
