Weekly Highlights

Chipman is perfect with top triple:



Shane Chipman rolled twelve strikes in a row in his first game of the night to record a perfect game in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. He was participating in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with 792 (300 – 83 pins over average – 235-257 – 141 pins average for three games). His scores were good for both the high single and high triple of the week. His 792 was also a personal best, topping his previous 787 (289-244-254) which he posted in the MFFL last season. It was Chipman's career 4th 300, his 2nd 300 this season and his 8th 700 this season. Chipman bowled his other 300 this season in the Best Wiring Classic League in the opening week of the LCTA bowling season. Shane's gem was the LCTA's 8th 300 this season. The other six bowlers performing the feat can be found on the LCTA web site under Honour Scores. Chipman is now averaging 221 for 42 games in the MFFL this year.



Rogers records career high scores:

Mike Rogers tossed 545 (150-147-248 – 90 pins over average) to record career new personal high scores. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high triple was 542 (169-193-180),



which he bowled in the SPBCML this year and his previous high single was 207 which he rolled in the league last season. Rogers is now averaging 160 for 48 games in the league, bowling with team members Kevin Storozuk, Bill Mayea, Tim Hutton and Dan Vandermeer.

Bell posts new high triple:



Youth bowler Caleb Bell fired 499 (168- 52 pins over average – 152 – 36 pins over average – 179 – 63 pins over average – 151 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to establish a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 452 and his high single is 209. Caleb is averaging 118 after 19 weeks of bowling this year with team members Emily Prentice, Silas Prentice and Killian Book. Last year in the PYL he averaged 132 for 78 games.

Youth bowler tops his high single:

Kian O’Keefe rolled 219 (94 pins over average) in his second game of the day to record a new high single topping his previous 186. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl ending the day with a 491 triple. This is Kian’s first year of sanctioned league bowling, and he is averaging 127 after 19 weeks, bowling with team members Rio Grasser, and Daniel Wright.

It was his 11th 700 of the season.
