## Weekly Highlights

### Gauthier is perfect:



Brandon Gauthier hurled a perfect game in his second game of the day to record the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with 729 (216-300 - 78 pins over average – 213) which was good for the 2<sup>nd</sup> high triple of week in the LCTA. It was the right handers career 8<sup>th</sup> 300 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> 300 in the LCTA this season with

the other one belonging to Bryce Watson. It was also his 7<sup>th</sup> 700 series in the LCTA this season as he previously rolled 765-702-772-722-749-764. Gauthier bowls as a spare in the BWCL and is now averaging 227 for 12 games. He bowls full time in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League and is averaging 210 for 39 games this season.



**Adamson fires week's top triple:**



Kyle Adamson fired 781 (264 - 60 pins over average -248-269 – 65 pins over average – 169 pins over average for three games) on lanes 19 & 20 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the week's high triple in LCTA bowling action. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 this season as he previously had triples of 701-707-700. Adamson is averaging 207 for 45 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the FTBMNML he averaged 207 for 96 games.

**Laframboise records new high triple:**



William Laframboise rolled 657 (220-245 – 75 pins over average – 192 – 147 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to record a new high triple beating his previous high 640. His sanctioned high single game is 259. Laframboise is averaging 170 after 16 weeks in the MFFL this year.

**Burr tops his high triple:**

Sean Burr wheeled 650 (185-200-265 – 94 pins over average – 140 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to top his previous high 633. His career sanctioned high



single is 279. Sean started bowling at age 6 with his brother in the Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowling program and remained in the program until age 21. Burr worked 2 years as a grease monkey/assistant mechanic at Hi-Way Bowl where he learned about the back-end of a bowling lane. This gained him the knowledge he needed to help set up an outdoor “Bowling Lane” in the Hi-Way Bowl parking lot a few years ago for a charity fundraiser for the Cancer Society for two consecutive years. Sean is averaging 171 for 30 games in the RCAFA league this year

### **Landon wheels career high triple:**



Jeremy Landon tossed 648 (215-235 – 76 pins over average – 198 – 165 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to register his career high triple. Jeremy said the 235 is his second highest single game behind his high game of 248. Landon started bowling as a little kid at Marcin Bowl at family outings. Then he and his sister joined the Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Junior Bowlers League where they were coached by their dad along with Shirley and Mel Matthews. Landon is bowling in two league this year. In the Mulder

### **Lapointe adds to his total:**

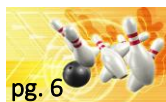

their bucket list. He received the Canadian Tenpin Federation “National League Award” for bowling the Male High Series (862) in Canada in the 2022-2023 season.

Mike Shephard rolled 710 (247-239-224) in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to take fourth position in the 700 race this week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this year going along with his 766-729-726. Shephard is

**Friis rolls ladies second high triple:**

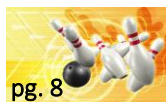

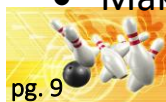
