## Weekly Highlights

### **Bruder rolls 300:**



Dave Bruder rolled a perfect game in his first game of the day, in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week, to record the high single of the week topping his previous high game of 287. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with a 733 (300 – 104 pins over average , 178, 255 – 59 pins over average - 145 pins over average for three games) triple which was good for the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week. It was his first 700 of the season. Dave had no 700's last season. Bruder experienced the excitement of accomplishing the last strike under stressful body conditions, knowing that every bowler was watching him on his final delivery and he performed with class firing a solid pocket hit. It was his career first 300 and the 8<sup>th</sup> in the LCTA this season. It was also Bruder's career high triple topping his previous 721. Dave is also eligible for a 100 pins over average for a single game award with his perfect game. Bruder did not come up through a youth bowling organization but started bowling at age 31 and credits Larry Plumb as his teacher in helping him improve his game. He has been bowling for 20 years minus two Covid years. Like many bowlers, his interest in bowling started with Rock N Roll with friends which led him to a sanctioned bowling league. Besides bowling, his other sporting interests are hockey and golf. His hobbies are computers, music and video games. Bruder, a right-handed bowler, is averaging 198 for 60 games in the BWCL this season bowling with teammates George Newman and Mike Marciniszyn.



**Smith is number one:**

Connor D.R. Smith tossed 760 (225-245-290 – 77 pins over average – 121 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Connor is eligible for the eleven strikes in a row award with his 290. It was his 3<sup>rd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 709 (242-275-192) and 736 (256-227-253). Smith is averaging 216 for 48 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last year in the league he averaged 217 for 81 games.

**Farrenkopf fires new high triple:**

Adam Farrenkopf fired 705 (226-247 – 53 pins over average – 232 – 123 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League as a spare on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record his new personal high triple and the 7<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. His previous high triple was 700 (220-233-247) which he bowled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) this season. His career high single is 264. Adam bowled in the RCAFA league last year and finished the year with a 194 average for 96 games. This year he is bowling in the FTBMNML and is averaging 187 for 51 games bowling with teammates Will Greenway, Jeff Wicks and John Edwards.

**Brown ups his high scores:**

Wes Brown bowled 587 (154, 248 – 92 pins over average , 185 - 119 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to register new personal high scores in LCTA bowling play. His previous high scores were 567 and 215. Brown did not come through any organized youth league but first started bowling in the RCAFA league shy of mid season in the 2022-2023 season at age 46 finishing with a 144 average for 39 games. In the 2023-2024 season in the league he finished with a 136 average for 99 games. Last season Wes had to leave the league due to a spinal injury and finished the year with a 127 average for 21 games. Brown decided to get back into bowling this season with his back fully recovered and is averaging 156 for 54 games bowling with teammates Jeff Hrycyk, Peter Goodman and Jean Guy Morin.



When asked what got him interested in 10-pin bowling he replied "what interested me the most was the growth and new popularity of the 2- handed bowling in the PBA with guys like Kyle Troup, Jason Belmonte and Anthony Simonsen". Brown, a right-handed bowler, started bowling one handed but switched to 2 handed for a partial season. After his injury, he said he defaulted back to one handed and it seems to be working better for him. His reply to other sporting interests was "all sports related to Detroit or anyone playing against Toronto". His hobbies include country music, fishing and cooking meals. When asked about his most memorable moment in bowling so far he said "Tuesday night's performance (587- 248) was obviously the most memorable event for me but I enjoy the weekly camaraderie and friendly competition of the league every week".

### ***Fox posts new high triple:***



Jason Fox rolled 527 (163-161-203 – 60 pins over average) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to post a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 520 (210-149-161) which he bowled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl this season. Jason's career high single is 215. Fox is averaging 145 for 51 games in the MFFL and 144 for 51 games in the FTBMNML this season.

### ***Youth bowlers top their high triples:***

Shaylyn Blake, Tayllum Taylor and Brynn Nesbitt bowled new high triples in LCTA bowling action this past week in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at Marcin Bowl.



Shaylyn rolled 515 (178 – 50 pins over average – 201 – 73 pins over average – 136 – 131 pins over average for three games) on lanes 15 & 16 topping her previous high triple 513 (196-164-153). Her career high single is 211. Shaylyn is averaging 128 after 18 weeks on the lanes this season. Last year in the league she averaged 134 for 63 games.



Tayllum fired 492 (130-180 – 40 pins over average – 182 – 42 pins over average) on lanes 23 & 24 topping his previous high triple 477 (175-155-147) which he bowled in the PYL this season. His career high single is 212 which he also posted in the PYL this season. Tayllum is averaging



140 after 18 weeks of bowling this season. Last season he averaged 120 for 84 games.

Brynn tossed 393 (124-156 – 37 pins over average – 113) on lanes 15 & 16 topping her previous high 370. Her career high single is 156. Brynn is averaging 119 after 18 weeks of bowling this season. Last season she averaged 100 for 87 games.

***Bowlers record new high single:***

Will Waluchow, Chad Cook and Karys Nesbitt recorded new personal high singles in LCTA bowling action this past week.

Waluchow fired 252 (95 pins over average) in his last game of the night in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to post a new personal high single in the LCTA. His previous high single was 238 which he bowled in the KBTNML last week. Waluchow finished the night with a 623 (177-194-252 – 152 pins over average for three games) triple which tied his previous high 623 (196-192-235) which he rolled last week in the KBTNML. Waluchow, a first time bowler in a sanctioned league, is averaging 157 after 18 weeks on the lanes this season.

Cook wheeled 231 (65 pins over average) in his second game of the night to register a new personal high single topping his previous 221. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 566 triple. Chad's high triple is 598 (221-169-208) which he bowled in the MFFL this season. Cook is averaging 167 for 36 games in the league this season. This is Chad's first year in a sanctioned bowling league in the last 15 years as this writer checked back in the LCTA year books and was unable to find a sanctioned league average for him.

Nesbitt tossed 183 (50 pins over average) in her second game of the day to record a new personal high single topping her previous high 182. She was bowling in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl ending the day with a 470 triple. Her career high triple is 500 (152-182-166) which she bowled in the PYL this season. Karys is averaging 133 after 18 weeks of bowling this season. Last season in the league she averaged 131 for 96 games.



**Ridealgh slides into second:**

Bill Ridealgh hurled 747 (221-258 – 45 pins over average – 268 – 55 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record the week's second high triple in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously bowled 743 (248-216-279). Bill is averaging 215 for 54 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 212 for 93 games. Ridealgh's career sanctioned high scores are 789 and 300 (4).

**Armstrong is high over average:**

Justin Armstrong tossed 663 (192-245 – 83 pins over average – 226 – 64 pins over average – 177 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to be high over average for three games in the LCTA this week. Justin's career high triple is 679 (245-260-174) which he bowled in the FTBMNML in the 2023-2024 season. He was 220 pins over average for three games that night. His career high single is 268. Ben Lapointe fired 724 (211 – 279 – 59 pins over average – 234) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 4<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 17<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season and he increased his career total to 158. He leads the King of the Lanes race by 5 over his closest competitor. league he averaged 223 for 90 games.

**Lapointe Senior's game getting better:**

Jim Lapointe hurled 720 (260 – 49 pins over average – 223-237) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 5<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 3<sup>rd</sup> 700 of the season as



he previously bowled 711 (223-279-209) and 725 (256-253-216). Jim is behind his last year's pace when he had 10-700's but his game is getting better as the season swings into the second half. Lapointe is averaging 213 for 51 games in the FTBMNML and 213 for 57 games in the Best Wiring Classic League this season.

When the 2025-2026 bowling season started, Blake Ingles was still looking for his first 700. **Shephard holds down last spot:**

Mike Shephard hurled 700 (185-247-268) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to take ownership of the low 700 of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 12<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season in the LCTA and he trails Ben Lapointe by 5 in the LCTA King of the Lanes race. Mike's game is still strong but he has been struggling



with his eyes as of late. He is averaging 221 for 51 games in the FTBMNML and 218 for 57 games in the Best Wiring Classic League this season. Mike also is bowling in the Cowboys and Indians League in Port Huron this year, averaging 223 for 54 games with 6-700's to his credit, his last one being 738 (236-247-255).

**Shephard leads the ladies:**

Roni Shephard wheeled 587(193-202-192) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to post the ladies top triple in the LCTA this past week. Roni is averaging 180 for 54 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league she averaged 185 for 96 games. Her career high triple is 682 (256-204-222) which she posted in the BWCL this season and her high single is 279 bowled in the BWCL last season.
