Weekly Highlights

Armstrong's strong bowling continues with top triple:



John Armstrong fired 784 (258 – 42 pins over average – 259 – 43 pins over average – 267 – 51 pins over average – 136 pins over average for three games), in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 12th 700 of the season in the LCTA. It was also his second consecutive 700 in the BWCL as last week he tossed 715 (246-210-259). Armstrong has been solid on the lanes the last three weeks as he has posted 5-700's. John is averaging 218 for 84 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 208 for 90 games.

Chipman is good for two:

Shane Chipman rolled 732 (237- 269 – 58 pins over average – 226) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26, and 706 (226-192-288 – 78 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34, both at Marcin Bowl, to register the 2nd and 4th high triples of the week in LCTA bowling action. They were his 9th and 10th 700's of the season as he previously bowled 722, 729, 736, 704, 761, 703, 748 and 792 (300-235-257) which is his career highest triple. Chipman is having a solid year with two perfect games in his pocket this season which



gives him a career 4-300's. Shane is averaging 213 for 87 games in the BWCL and 211 for 78 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Wright posts new personal high scores:



Greg Wright wheeled 528 (201 – 77 pins over average – 150-177 – 53 pins over average – 156 pins over average for three games), in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to top his previous high scores. His previous top numbers were 471 (123-149-199) which he bowled in the MFFL three weeks ago. Greg is averaging 124 after 30 weeks of bowling in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 116 for 66 games.

Youth bowler tops her high scores:

Emily Peters bowled 353 (86-140 – 62 pins over average – 127 – 49 pins over average – 119 pins over average for three games) in the Youth Phantom League (YPL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to record new personal high scores. Her previous high scores were 307 and 120. This is Emily's first year of sanctioned organized league bowling, and she is averaging 78 after 30 weeks on the lanes.

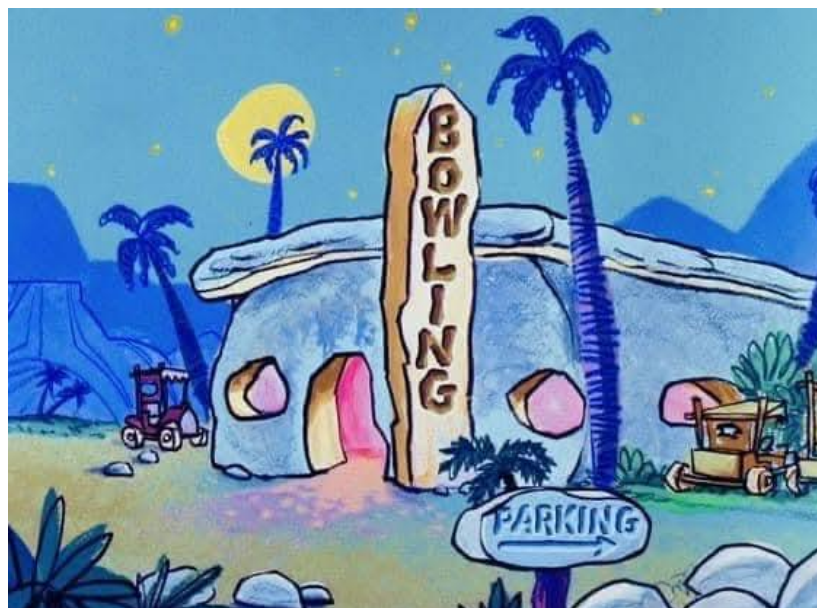
