Weekly Highlights

Parkkila's dream comes true:



Every competitive bowler, including Kole Parkkila, dreams of rolling the ultimate 800 series. Parkkila's dream came to reality this past week as he recorded his first 800 series, and this writer believes there will be more to come down the road. Parkkila tossed 819 (287 – 80 pins over average – 277 – 70 pins over average – 255 – 48 pins over average - 198 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, a night that will be etched in his memory for many years to come. He had 28 out of a possible 36 strikes in recording the gem.

It was his 6th 700 this season as he previously bowled 717, 750, 720, 751 and 767. It was also his career 11th 700. His previous high triple was 767 (222-248-297) which he posted in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) this season. Kole is now averaging 212 for 45 games in the FTBMNML and 201 for 54 games in the BWCL this season.

Roehler is 100 pins over average:

Mark Roehler bowled 269 (111 pins over average) in his last game of the night, to be eligible for the 100 pins over average award (watch) for a single game. He was participating in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 591 triple. His 269 game was also a new personal high single game topping his previous 232. His highest triple is 630. Mark is averaging 161 for 42 games in the



league this year bowling with teammates Bill Cole, Zyg Mazgaj, Zack Roehler and Rod Honke. Last year in the league he averaged 161 for 75 games.

Ridealgh takes second place:



Jamie Ridealgh fired 777 (296 – 77 pins over average – 248-233) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 and 711 (212-278 – 65 pins over average – 221) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) both at Marcin Bowl to record the 2nd and 12th high triples of the week in the LCTA. They were his 4th and 5th 700’s of this season as he previously bowled 729, 713 and 705. In Ridealgh’s 297 game, 9 of his first 11 strikes were solid pocket hits and the other 2 came on wide, sloppy hits. On his last ball, he came high on the head pin leaving the 3-6-7-10 split. Jamie’s career sanctioned high triple is 797 and he is averaging 223 for 33 games in the BWCL and 216 for 30 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Hoadley records his first 700 series:



Tyler Hoadley wheeled 718 (210 – 257 -70 pins over average – 251 – 64 pins over average – 157 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record his career first 700 series and the 8th high triple of the week in the LCTA. His previous high triple was 685 (195-234 – 256) which he rolled in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) this season. Hoadley is averaging 188 for 51 games in the BWCL and 191 for 39 games in the FTBMNML this year bowling with team members Wally Chute, Chris Novakowski and Fred Harris.

Shephard posts career high triple:

Roni Shephard tossed 668 (200-235-233) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to post a career sanctioned new high triple. Her previous high triple was 636 (186-193-257) and her highest single game is 279, both recorded in the BWCL this season. Roni is averaging 189 for 51 games in the BWCL



this season. She also bowls full time in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League and is averaging 186 after 15 weeks on the lanes.

VanGrimberghe rolls first 600 series:



Chris VanGrimberghe bowled 663 (192-224 – 63 pins over average – 247 – 86 pins over average – 180 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to register his career first 600 series. His 247 is also a new personal high single topping his previous 237. His previous high triple was 590. Chris is in his 6th year of sanctioned league bowling and is averaging 168 for 27 games in the league this year. Last year in the FTBMNML he averaged 158 for 57 games.

Kitchen hurls new personal high single:



Chad Kitchen hurled 250 (85 pins over average) in his first game of the night to record a new personal high single topping his previous 224. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl ending the night with a 571 triple. Kitchen is now averaging 167 for 42 games in the league this year. Last year in the league he averaged 164 for 87 games.

Lapointe rolls week’s top single:

Jason Lapointe fired the first eleven strikes in his first game of the night. On his last ball, he came in light to the pocket leaving the 2-8 pins ending with a 298. He was bowling in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl ending the night with 740 (298 – 73 pins over average – 212-230) which was good for the 4th high triple of the week. His 298 was good for the highest single of the week. He also wheeled 715 (269-233-213) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) as a spare on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to share the 10th high triple of the week with Roy Mezzatesta.



They were his 5th and 6th 700's this season as he previously bowled 751, 737, 715 and 711. Lapointe bowls full time in the Best Wiring Classic League and is averaging 210 for 45 games and in the B10TNML averaging 225 after 17 weeks of bowling. His career high scores are 792 and 300 (3).

Romanik enters 700 club:



Justin Romanik tossed 737 (245-258-234 – 158 pins over three games) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (Bar10TNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record his first 700 of this season and post the 5th highest triple of the week. Last season Justin had 2-700's. Romanik is averaging 193 after 17 weeks in the league this year. Last year in the B10TBML, he averaged 205 for 75 games. His career sanctioned high scores are 772 and 300 (2).

Shephard continues his strong bowling:



Mike Shephard had a strong week on the lanes in LCTA bowling action as he posted 3-700's. He hurled 726 (220-289 – 62 pins over average – 217) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 13 & 14, 700 (248-227-225) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 and 702 (278-221-203) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 all at Marcin Bowl to record the 7th, 14th and 15th high triples of the week. They were his 19th, 20th and 21 first 700's of the season and he now leads Ben Lapointe by 4 in the 700 crown race this season. Shephard is averaging 227 for 51 games in the BWCL, 229 for 45 games in the FTBMNML and 227 after 17 weeks in the B10TNML this season. His career high scores are 827 (7) and 300 (13).

Plumb good for third spot:

Larry Plumb hurled 764 (247-255-262) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to take 3rd spot in the high triple department this past week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 4th 700 this season as he previously bowled 773, 708 and 714. Plumb is averaging 217 for 54 games in the BWCL this season. His career sanctioned high scores are 815 and 300 (7).



Raymond and Lapointe Junior post identical triples:

Jeff Raymond and Ben Lapointe wheeled identical 729 triples in the LCTA this past week.



Raymond wheeled 729 (265-234-230) as a spare in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to share the 6th high triple of the week with Ben Lapointe. It was his 4th 700 this season as he previously bowled 709, 714 and 732. Raymond bowls full time in the Best Wiring Classic League and is averaging 212 for 54 games this year.

Lapointe rolled 729 (237-247-245) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 and 711 (238-226-247) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 both at Marcin Bowl to record the 6th and 12th high triples of the week. They were his 16th and 17th 700’s of the season and his career 130th and 131 first 700 posted in the LCTA. He now trails Mike Shephard by 4 in the season’s 700 crown race as Shephard fired 3-700’s this week. Lapointe is averaging 229 for 51 games in the BWCL this season chased by Mike Shephard with 227 for 51 games. He is averaging 223 for 45 games in the FTBMNML this year.



Ramsay grabs ninth place:



Kirk Ramsay rolled 716 (277-238-201) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to grab 9th place in the high triple department this past week. It was his 6th 700 this season as he previously recorded 702, 752, 753, 761 and 764. Ramsay is averaging 232 for 36 games in the FTBMNML this year and is being chased by Mike Shephard who is averaging 229 for 45 games in the league.

Mezzatesta ties with triple score:

Roy Mezzatesta wheeled 715 (233-247-235) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to share the 10th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action with Jason Lapointe. It was his 9th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 703, 704, 726, 722, 709,



710, 779 and 793. Mezzatesta is averaging 215 for 48 games in the BWCL this season, 210 for 39 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League and 219 for 39 games in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League.

Peters joins 700 club:



Steve Peters rolled 714 (237-253-224) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record his first 700 of the season and the 11th high triple of the week. Steve had 1-700 last year in the LCTA. Peters is averaging 207 for 42 games in the league this year. His career high scores are 740 and 288.

Adamson takes thirteenth position:

Kyle Adamson fired 705 (202-247-256) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to register the 13th high triple of the week. It was his 4th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 709, 747 and 715. Adamson is averaging 215 for 54 games in the BWCL this year. His career high scores are 813 (6) and 300 (7).



Watson shares same triple:



Bryce Watson tossed 700 (287 – 79 pins over average – 211-202) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to share the 15th highest triple of the week with Mike Shephard. It was his 5th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 712, 707, 717 and 795. It was also his career 10th 700. Watson is averaging 209 for 51 games in the BWCL this season. His sanctioned high scores are 795 (242-290-263) which he posted in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League this season and

300 (2).

Sitter is second best for the ladies:

Kelly Sitter rolled 639 (244 – 57 pins over average – 173 -222) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record the ladies second high triple of the week. Kelly is averaging 188



for 45 games in the league bowling on the “Organized Chaos” team with Lisa Pownall, Chantelle Steele and Sarah Meere. Kelly is not sure of her highest triple, but she has bowled 670 (224-189-257) this season and her high single is 279.
