Weekly Highlights

Crowe posts career first 700:

Devon Crowe experienced the excitement of tossing 700 (210-248 – 56 pins over average – 242 – 50 pins over average – 124 pins over average for three games) to record his career first 700 series. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to post the low 700 of the week in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA). His previous high triple was 695 and his high single is 289. Devon is a graduate of the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program. The twenty three year old started knocking down the pins and sharing the friendship on the lanes at age five. Crowe is averaging 194 for 63 games in the FTBMNML this year.



Gray records career high scores:

Collin Gray fired 407 (109-132-166 – 53 pins over average) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at Marcin Bowl on lanes 13 & 14 to record his career high scores. His previous high scores were 291 and 155. Collin is averaging 113 after 22 weeks of bowling in the league this year. Collin was 8 years old when he started bowling in the Phantom Junior Bowling Program (PJPB) at Hi-Way Bowl and has been enjoying the great sport of 10-pin bowling for 7 years. He originally got interested in bowling at age 6 when his mom used to take him and his sister 5-pin bowling all the time. Two years later he switched to 10-pin and joined the PJPB. The last time this writer highlighted Collin, he was playing baseball as a second sporting interest and loved playing video games especially at District Beta (a games establishment in Sarnia).

Best wheels personal high triple:

Steve Best fired 694 (236 - 50 pins over average - 203-255 – 69 pins over average – 136 pins over average for three games) in the LCTA this past week to register his career highest triple. His previous high triple was 670 and his high single is 268. Best was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. Best is averaging 189 for 48 games this year bowling on the "Napa Auto" team with Jim



Amlin, Justin Armstrong, Justin Weed, Randy McEachern and Andrew McLean.

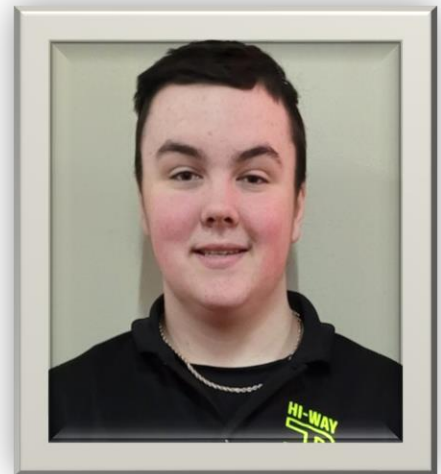
Shephard is week's top bowler:



Mike Shephard hurled 780 (247-278 – 64 pins over average – 255 – 138 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 5th 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously bowled 766-729-726-710. Mike is averaging 216 after 66 games this year in the FTBMNML. His career sanctioned high scores are 827 (6) and 300 (13).

Hannah is 100 pins over average:

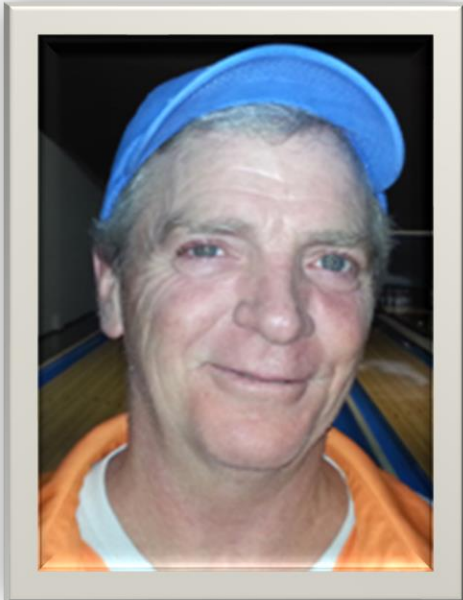
Logan Hannah rolled 258 (100 pins over average) to record his career highest single game in LCTA bowling action this past week. He was bowling in the Phantom Youth League at Marcin Bowl on lanes 23 & 24 finishing the day with a 545 tripe. Hannah is eligible to receive a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch award for being 100 pins over average in a single game if he has not received this award before. His previous high single was 242 and his high triple is 598. Hannah is averaging 158 after 21 weeks in the league this year.



Lefties roll top scores in Classic League:

Left handers Ralph MacDuff and Steve Lewicki rolled 716 triples in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) to share the top scores in the league and share the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition.





Macduff fired 716 (245-279- 83 pins over average – 192) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record his 2nd 700 in a row in the BWCL as last week he tossed 708 (238-192-278). It was his 2nd 700 in the LCTA this season. MacDuff is averaging 197 for 69 games in the BWCL this year.

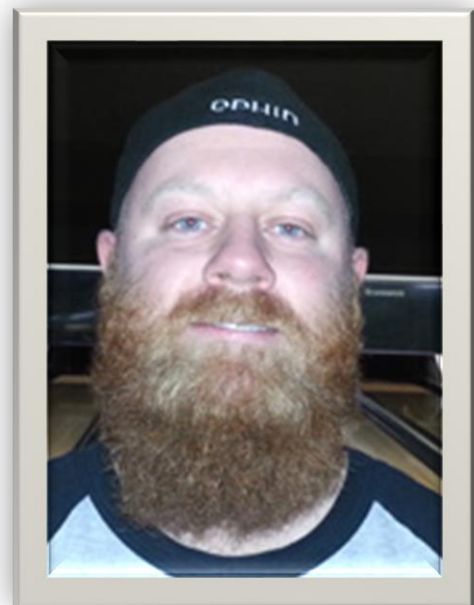


Lewicki rolled 716 (257-228-231) on lanes 31 & 32 at

Salmons slides into third spot:

Matt Salmons hurled 713 (243-237-233) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to post the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 2nd 700 in a row in the FTBMNML as last week he had 748 (260-265-223). It was his 5th 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously bowled 748-748-713-705. Salmons is



averaging 209 after 60 games in the FTBMNML this year.

Mezzatesta sneaks into fourth position:



Roy Mezzatesta rolled 708 (206-255-247) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to sneak into fourth position in the LCTA 700 race this past week. It was his 2nd consecutive 700 in the SPBCML as last week he posted 706 (203-278-225). It was also his 7th 700 this season in the LCTA as he previously rolled 769-725-710-739-740-706. Mezzatesta is averaging 214 for 72 games in the SPBCML this year.

Gauthier good for fifth place:



Brandon Gauthier hurled 704 (199-267-238) as a spare in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 9th 700 in the LCTA this year. Gauthier is averaging 229 for 15 games in the BWCL this year. Brandon only bowls full time in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League this year and he is averaging 211 for 57 games.

Breaking News – Lapointe streak is over:

Jim Lapointe had 10 consecutive 700's in nine weeks but that streak came to an end this past week. Lapointe had 2 solid 600's but came up a tad short on each one. Jim hurled 699 (249-248) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's
