Weekly Highlights

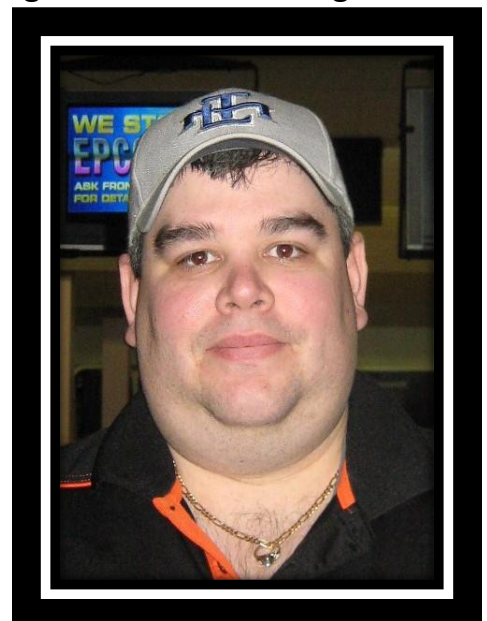
Perfect games highlight opening week:

Two perfect games highlighted the opening week in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) 2024-2025 bowling season. Jim Lapointe and Shane Chipman share the honour of rolling the first 300's of the season and sharing the highest single of the week.



Jim Lapointe was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) in his first game of the season on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 672 triple. It was his career 10th perfect game. Lapointe had 2-300's last season and finished with a 221 average in the BWCL.

Shane Chipman was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) in his second game of the day on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl finishing the day with a 647 triple. It was his career 3rd perfect game. Chipman also fired 722 (278 – 66 pins over average - 224-220) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to register the third high triple of the week. It was his first 700 this season. Last season he had 9-700's. Shane finished with a 207 average for 93 games last season in the BWCL.



Lapointe opens season at blistering pace:



Jason Lapointe opened the LCTA 2024-2025 bowling season with a fine 751 (268 – 58 pins over average – 248- 235 – 121 pins over average for three games) triple to record the opening week’s high triple. He was bowling in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl. He also recorded 737 (211-258—268 – 53 pins over average) on lanes 15 & 16 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) and 715 (277-268-170) and on lanes 15 & 16 in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League (week two) to post three consecutive 700’s. Lapointe had 12-700’s last season and finished the year in the Bar 10 League with a 210 average for

78 games. He also finished with a 215 average for 87 games in the BWCL and a 218 average for 72 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League last season.

Shephard is one pin shy of perfection:



Mike Shephard fired 299 (85 pins over average) in his first game of the night leaving a solid, stubborn 10 pin on his last shot to record the second high single of the week in LCTA bowling action. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl. Shephard struggled in his next two games finishing with a 640 triple. Mike averaged 214 for 96 games in the FTBMNML last season.

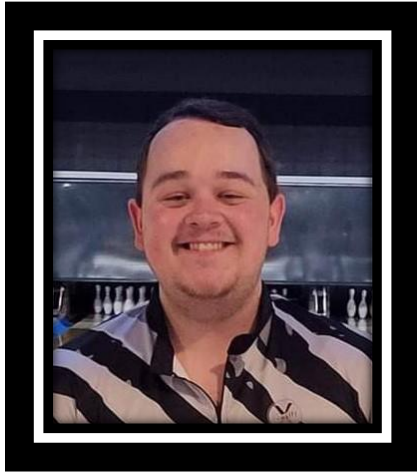
Smith good for third high single:

Connor D.R. Smith rolled 290 in his last game of the day to register the week’s third highest single in LCTA bowling activity. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl as a spare finishing the day with a 695 triple. Smith bowled full time in two



leagues last year. In the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League he averaged 209 for 87 games and in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League he averaged 207 for 84 games.

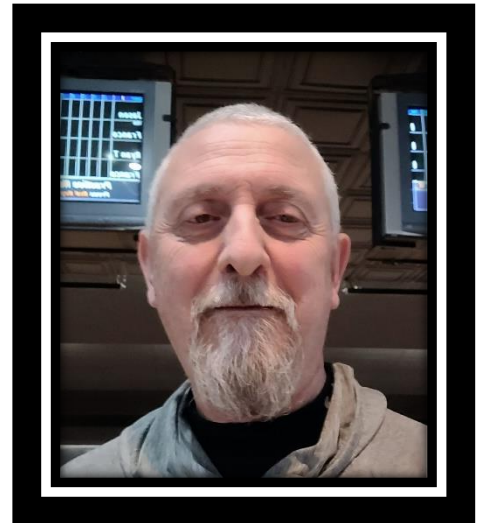
Lapointe adds to his career total:



Ben Lapointe wheeled 711 (255-187-269 – 53 pins over average) on lanes 33 & 34 in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) at Marcin Bowl to record his first 700 of this season and he now has a career 115-700's. Ben had 36-700's last season. His triple was good for the week's 5th high triple. Last season Lapointe averaged 225 for 72 games in the SPBCML.

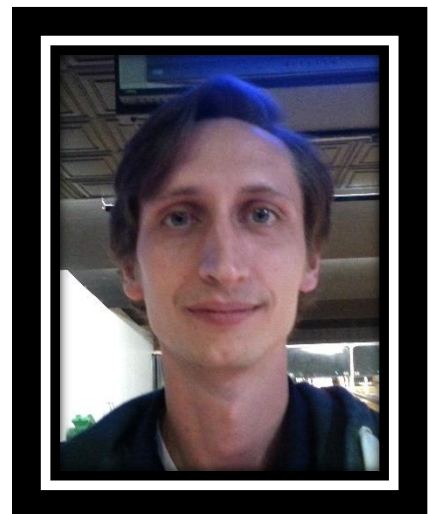
The "Mezz" takes sixth position:

Roy Mezzatesta fired 703 (268 – 51 pins over average – 220-215) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) at Marcin Bowl to take sixth spot in the 700 race in opening LCTA bowling action. Mezzatesta had 12-700's last season and finished with a 217 average for 93 games in the SPBCML. He also finished with a 218 average for 99 games in the Best Wiring Classic League and a 206 average for 93 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League last season.



Ramsay grabs last spot:

Kirk Ramsay rolled 702 (239-235-228) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to grab last spot in the 700 department in the LCTA this past week. It was Ramsay's first 700 of this season. Last season he had 6-700's finishing the year with a 220 average for 33 games in the FTBMNML.

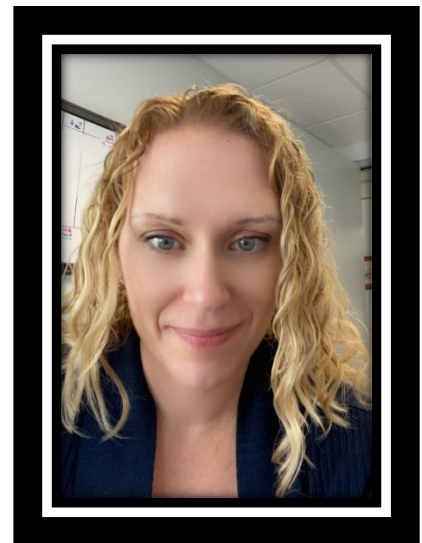


Friis is tops for the ladies:
