Belliveau takes top honours:



Pierre Belliveau fired 785 (256-289-72 pins over average – 240 – 134 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past

week. The London resident started bowling at the ripe age of 5 going through the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program in Wallaceburg/Chatham and also bowled in the youth bowling program at the now defunct Lakeside Bowl, Sarnia. He is a twice a week bowler, bowling in the SMML with his brother "Jay" on the Dixie Rekt team and at the Royal Bowlerama in London. He has been knocking down the pins for 32 years. His career sanctioned personal high scores are 300 -1 and 799 both rolled in the SMML in the 2017-2018 season.



Wilkinson a close second:

Johnny Wilkinson tossed 782 (279-257-246 – 104 pins over average for three games) in the 1046 Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to post the second high triple of the week in LCTA action. Johnny has participated in the league the last two seasons averaging 209 and 210. The high rev right hander is off to a super start this season as he is averaging 231 after 21 games. He has 4-300's to his credit.



Vandermeer solid on the lanes again:

Dan Vandermeer wheeled 742 (258-225-259) on lanes 15 & 16 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to take the third high triple of the week. It was the right hander's second straight solid triple in the BCML as last week he posted 747 (223-255-269). He is off to a great start this year leading the BCML high average race with 223 after 18 games and helping his team "Lambton Chiropractic King Pins" hold on to first place in the league. His career personal high scores are 289 and 777.



Youth bowlers shine on the lanes:



Dawson Williams rolled 617 (236 – 86 pins over average – 167 pins over average for three games) in the Youth Senior Division at Marcin Bowl to record his career personal highest scores. Dawson started organized bowling in the Marcin Bowl Youth Tenpin Bowling Program three years ago at age sixteen finishing the 2016-2017 bowling season with a 113 average. In his second year, he finished with a 135 average. Last year he improved his average to 155. This year he is averaging 159 after 18 games.
