Weekly Highlights

Mezzatesta is bowler of the week:



Roy Mezzatesta fired 761 (279 – 71 pins over average – 236-246 – 137 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to post the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. It was his second consecutive strong series in the SMCL as last

week he bowled 748 (279-239-230). He now has 8-700's for this season. He is now averaging 211 for 54 games in the SMCL.



Paquette records personal high triple:

David Paquette rolled 717 (231 – 264 – 78 pins over average – 222 – 159 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling activity to record his career personal high triple. His previous high triple (his career first 700) was 704 (227-242-235) which he rolled last season in the SMCL at Hi-Way Bowl

when Marcin Bowl was closed. His career sanctioned high single is 290. Paquette is averaging 190 for 39 games in the SMCL. Paquette started bowling at age 12 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and remained in the league for 5 years under the guidance of coaches Gil and Carol Jean. He comes from a bowling family with his grandfather and father being avid bowlers over the years. Paquette is a diehard Toronto Maple Leaf fan and hopes this year might be their year to win the Stanley Cup.

Apter rolls personal high scores:

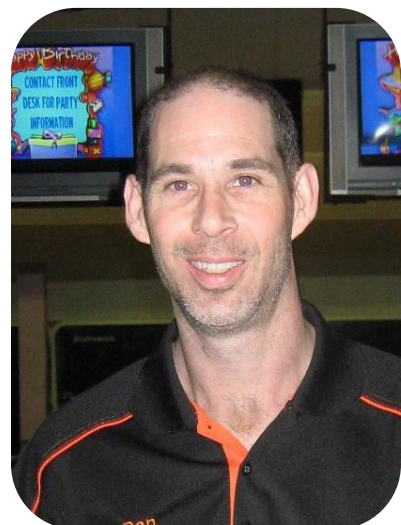
Makayla Apter rolled 650 (193-190-267 - 95 pins over average – 134 pins over average for 3 games) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 21 &



22 at Marcin Bowl to record her career personal high triple and high single with a new bowling ball in LCTA bowling activity. Her 267 was good for the ladies high single of the week and her triple was good for the ladies third high triple of the week. Makayla is averaging 174 after 20 weeks in the league. Makayla started bowling at age 8 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and participated in the program until age 13. She said “my interest wasn’t always there for bowling even though she enjoyed the game but I didn’t see my potential”. She added that her parents always had her enrolled in some kind of sports such as soccer, baseball and rugby to keep her busy. Makayla was two years old when she started soccer and because of her young age her dad had to coach. She said she played all school sports for fun when she was growing up. Eleven years later Makayla is back into bowling in the FNFML and looks forward each week meeting her fellow bowlers on the lanes. Chopp takes second place:

Dan Chopp tossed 746 (235-245-266 – 54 pins over average – 110 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to take second place in the 700 club competition in LCTA bowling activity this past week. Chopp spares in the SMCL and is now averaging 215 for 36 games. He

Marciniszyn good for third spot:

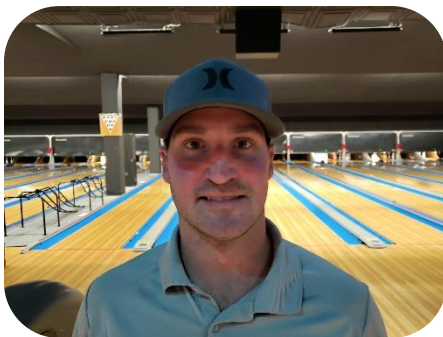


Mike Marciniszyn wheeled 738 (221-251-266) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to register the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. He is now averaging 218 for 60 games in the league. Marciniszyn started bowling in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program when he was 4 and bowled for 4 years until he quit to join youth hockey. He fired his first Canadian sanctioned 800 series in the 2020 – 2021 bowling season when he bowled 812 (268-258-286) in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl. Marciniszyn also has another 800 (804) which he bowled in the Cowboys And Indians League in Port Huron in 2008. His sanctioned high single is 300 (10).



Armitage slides to fifth position:

Jason Armitage fired 713 (196-258 – 69 pins over average – 259 – 70 pins over average – 146 pins over average for three games) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record the fifth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Armitage is averaging 191 after 20 weeks of bowling in the FNFML He also bowls in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League and is averaging 193 for 54 games this year. Armitage did not come up through a youth bowling organization but started bowling in his 20’s. His hobbies are camping and fishing. His career sanctioned high scores are 780 and 300.

Best grabs last spot:

Brad Best hurled 711 (258-221-232) in the Border City Men’s League (BCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to grab the last spot in the 700 division for the week. It was his 7th 700 of the year. His previous 700’s were 726 (244-268-214) - 725 (238-230-257) - 726 (256-214-256) - 718 (246-259-213) - 716 (267-222-227) and 740 (223-227-290). He is in the running for wearing the crown for the bowler with the most 700’s this season. The other bowlers leading the race with their 700’s in brackets are John

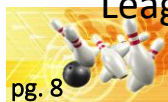
