Legault perfect for the first time:



Karyne Legault experienced the excitement of bowling her first perfect game in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. She performed the feat on lanes 19 & 20 in her second game in the Tuesday Night Ladies League at Marcin Bowl ending the night with a 706 (203-300 - 98 pins over average -203). Karyne started 10 pin bowling at the age of four coming up through Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl youth bowling programs and the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program at Northgate Bowl. At age 22, she took four seasons off from bowling when she brought her son into the world and further

increased her education at college returning back to the lanes in 2016. Her highest single game was 297 and her highest triple is 797. She has several memorable bowling moments including meeting new friends in bowling tournaments in Canada, the USA and Finland, attending a university bowling camp in western Illinois and coming in 2nd place in a Port Huron Doubles Tournament (PHDT) a few years ago losing to PBA (Professional Bowlers Association) bowlers Tom Smallwood and Brian Waliczek (TS/BW). The PHDT was a 4 house scratch tournament meaning you bowled 3 games at 4 different bowling alleys in order to qualify for baker match play doubles (team bowlers rolling alternate frames). In qualifying, Legault averaged 209 for the 12 games and her 2005 team Southern Ontario partner Shawn Legge from Kitchener, averaged 241 for his 12 games. They qualified 5th in the step ladder match play and after bowling 8 games, they



eliminated three other teams to set up the final against TS/BW. They bowled 2 games (highest total pinfall wins) against TS/BW winning the first game but losing the total pinfall after the opposition rolled a perfect game in game two. Karyne' s bowling accomplishments include victories in the 2002 YBC Nationals in New Brunswick, 2005 CYC (Christian Youth Camps) Nationals in British Columbia, 2009 CYC Nationals In Winnipeg and 2010 Team Canada in Finland.

Croskery is week's high bowler:



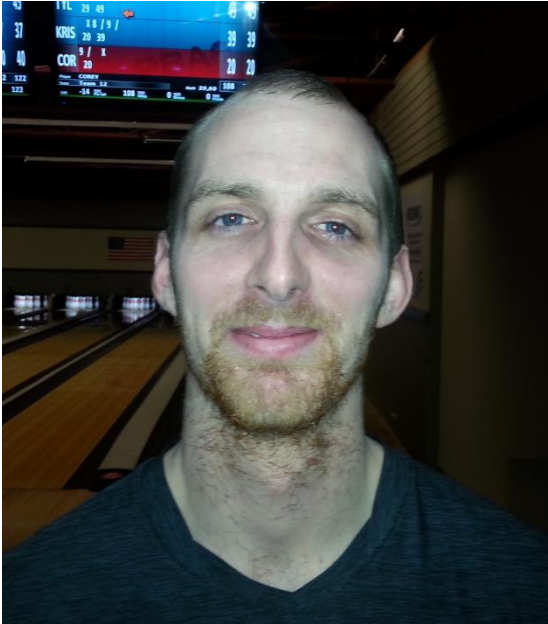
Jordan Croskery fired 751 (236-280-235) in the Thursday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to register the week's high triple in LCTA bowling action. Jordan is one of the many solid bowlers who have come up through youth bowling programs at Marcin Bowl and Hi-Way Bowl and the defunct Lake Huron Lanes, Airey Lanes and Northgate Bowl. He has a career 4-300's two of which were rolled this season: one at Hi-Way Bowl and one at Marcin Bowl in the LCTA Doubles Tournament. He also has a career 2-800's (808-826) to his credit.

Salmons is second best:

Scott Salmons rolled 729 (257-288 – 87 pins over average – 126 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple of the week in LCTA action. Scott has been bowling for fifty years both 5 and 10 pin in the various past and present bowling establishments in Sarnia including the Pindeck, Northgate Bowl, Lakeside Bowl, Graham Bowling, National Bowl, Nico Bowl, Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl. He has 4-300's to his credit with his highest triple being 776 (290-190-296). He is currently averaging 203 after 72 games in the SMML.



Lefebvre is high over average:



Corey Lefebvre tossed 681 (233 - 247 – 75 pins over average – 165 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Men’s League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to post the week’s high over average for three games. Corey joined the TNML 4 years ago averaging 169-173 and 182 his first three years. This year he is averaging 174 after 83 games this season. Corey and his partner Tyler Robertson won the 2017-2018 LCTA Doubles Tournament.

Trott is top youth bowler:



Joshua Trott wheeled 671 (253- 62 pins over average -234) in the Marcin Bowl Youth League Senior Division to lead the way for the youth on the lanes this week.
