## **Smith strong on the lanes:**

Connor Smith fired 771 (279-244-247 – 96 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Smith, a graduate of the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom Bowling Program, was also strong on the lanes last week in the BMNML as he rolled 738 (278). Last year he averaged 215 in the BMNML and this year he is averaging 230 after 18 games in the BMNML. He also partakes full time in the RCAFA 403 Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl and spares in other leagues as required.



**Creasor a solid second:**

Jim Creasor tossed 752 (257-278) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to post the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. Creasor is a solid right handed bowler who doesn't use the thumb hole when he rolls the ball. By using this delivery style, he gets a ton of revs on the ball as soon as the ball leaves his hand resulting in more explosive power as the ball hammers the pins. Jim has an awesome career sanctioned HONOUR score list: 23-300's and 25-800's – which this writer is aware of but there could be more. I'm sure many competitive bowlers wish it was their feats including this writer. His HONOUR

scores have been accomplished in three bowling associations: the Canadian Tenpin Federation, the defunct American Bowling Congress and the new United States Bowling Congress. He also holds the LCTA triple record (876), shares the Port Huron Tenpin Bowling Association record (868) and has rolled 869 in the Ontario Tenpin Provincial Tournament at St. Catherine's in 2008.

**Stonehouse fires personal best scores:**

Rob Stonehouse fired 667 (257 - 81 pins over average 234 – 139 pins over average for three games) in the Triple A Mixed League (TAML) at Marcin Bowl to register his personal highest triple and his highest single game. Stonehouse did not come up through a youth bowling



program but got interested in the game when he went to Rock & Bowl with his friends a few times while also testing out the lanes at Lakeside Bowl and Northgate Bowl when they were still going strong. According to his recollections, he started knocking down the pins in organized league play at about the age of 30 around 1995 when he joined the early Tuesday Night Mixed League (TNML) at Hi-Way Bowl. The same year he and



some co-workers formed a team and joined the late night Hi-Way Tuesday Night Men's League. He bowled in both leagues and a Friday night league at Marcin Bowl for four seasons but found that his shift work was playing havoc with his bowling. He took a twenty year break from bowling and returned last season in the Marcin TAML where he finished with a 169 average for 90 games. This year he is averaging 182 after 15 games. His two most memorable moments in bowling are: bowling by himself with three ladies on the team in the TNML and experiencing the competitive nature in the Hi-Way Tuesday Night Men's League against the "Mezzatesta" clan, the Scofield bothers (Kevin and the late Sonny) and Brian Clark to name a few. Rob said it was really AWESOME watching Brian Clark bowl a 300: it was the first one he witnessed. Some of his other interests include participating in pick up hockey and watching baseball and NASCAR races. Stonehouse finished by saying "I like to watch what everyone is doing on the lanes. When I see someone doing well, I cheer "em" on even though last week my team was razzing me for cheering our opponents".

### **Williams rolls his highest triple:**



Dawson Williams rolled 627 (204-224 – 55 pins over average – 199 - 120 pins over average for three games) in the Youth Senior Division at Marcin Bowl to record his career highest triple. He bettered his high triple of three weeks ago when he posted 617 with a 236 single which is his highest single game. Dawson was a late starter in organized bowling as he commenced bowling in the Marcin Bowl Youth Tenpin Bowling Program three years ago at age sixteen finishing the 2016-2017 bowling season with a 113 average. The last two years he raised his average by 42 pins to 155. This year he is averaging 159 after 27 games.

**Crowe rolls youth top score:**

Devon Crowe rolled a 266 single game – 92 pins over average in the Youth Senior Division at Hi-Way Bowl to post the youth high single of the week and also the youth high over average. His 266 was his personal highest game surpassing his previous 257 which he recorded last year. He finished the day with a 576 triple short of his personal best score of 606. Devon started bowling at age 5 and has been enjoying the Saturday morning fun for 13 years in the Phantom Youth Bowling Program at Hi-Way Bowl. He has steadily raised his average over the years under the watchful eyes of the Hi-Way Bowl youth coaches going from a 126 average in the Preps Division in the 2010-2011 to 175 in the 2018-2019 season. He is presently averaging 174 after nine weeks this season. Sharing friendship on the lanes with the other bowlers as he came up through the ranks is one of his memorable bowling moments. Devon has taken part in the Canadian Tenpin Federation and the Ontario Provincial Youth Tenpin Tournaments along his bowling journey. His other interests include curling and video games.
