Shephard tops on the lanes:

Mike Shephard hurled 783 (267-280 -236 - 120 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple in this week's Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. As a youth bowler, Mike came up through the SOCMO (Sombra, Courtright and Mooretown) youth bowling program at the defunct Airey Lanes in Courtright. Shephard is a powerful right handed bowler who usually plays around the 10-board area with a lot of speed. He has a career sanctioned 15 HONOUR scores to his credit: 9-300's, 5-800's (827 – 804 – 805 – 802 - 814) and a 299. He is currently averaging 223 after 48 games in the BMNML.



Salmons takes second by a sliver:

Scott Salmons had a super day on the lanes in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl this past week. He tossed 773 (267-240-266 – 161 pins over



average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 to take the honours for the week's second high triple in LCTA bowling action. Scott has been bowling for fifty years both 5 and 10 pin in the various past and present bowling establishments in Sarnia including the Pindeck, Northgate Bowl, Lakeside Bowl, Graham Bowlway, National Bowl, Nico Bowl, Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl. He has 4-300's to his credit with his highest triple being 776 (290-190-296). He is currently averaging 208 after 42 games in the SMML.

Adamson edged into third place:



Kyle Adamson also had a solid day in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl. He fired 772 (226-268-278 – 118 pins over average for three games) on lanes 27 & 28 being one pin shy of second place taking the third high triple of the week. Adamson is bowling in two leagues this year with averages in brackets: the SMML (220 after 51 games) and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (209 after 48 games). He also spares in other leagues where required. The right hander, who usually swings his delivery between the 5 - 10 boards, has a career 16 sanctioned HONOUR scores to his credit: 7-300's, 6-800's (802 – 813 – 801 – 802 – 805 – 805) and 3-298's.

Best rolls career high scores:



Noah Best rolled the first ten strikes in his first game of the night. He was starting to experience the tension that bowlers go through when they are in that situation – the wobbly legs, sweaty palms, the heartbeats picking up speed and silence in the bowling alley as numerous eyes are watching. On his eleventh delivery he left an unapologetic 7 pin to his disappointment. A spare and another strike finished his great game much to the appreciation of his fellow bowlers. When the night was over, he had tossed 754 (289 – 96 pins over average – 247 – 175 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the second high over average for



a single game and high over average for three games. His 289 and 754 were also his career personal highest scores. The 19 year old started 10-pin bowling at age 10 in the Phantom Junior Bowlers Program (PJBP) at Hi-Way Bowl and participated in the league for 3 years. He was following the footsteps of his family members who were also enjoying the great sport of 10-pin bowling. At age 13, he gave his bowling equipment a rest switching to hockey and baseball. He still plays hockey but his love for bowling brought him back to the lanes once again. Some of his memorable bowling moments include bowling his 1st 700 (701) this season, helping coach the junior bowlers in the PJBP for a couple years and of course establishing his new personal sanctioned high scores last night including his attempt to bowl his first perfect game under the watchful eyes of Grampa Carl and Uncle Billy. Noah is averaging 198 for 30 games in the BMNML.

Pereira 100 pins over average:



Tony Pereira rolled 534 (242 – 101 pins over average) on lanes 25 & 26 in his second game of the night in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the week's high over average for a single game in the LCTA.
