



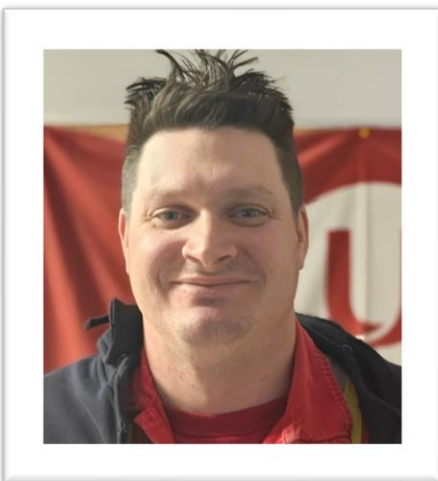

Weekly Highlights

VanGrimberghe beats previous high scores:



Chris VanGrimberghe rolled 590 (192-161-237 – 85 pins over average – 134 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) this past week to establish new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 568 and 229. VanGrimberghe’s game is getting stronger this

season as his high triple as gone from 542 to 568 to 590 with a 600 just around the corner. He is averaging 157 for 30 games in the league this year.

Crowe posts new high triple:

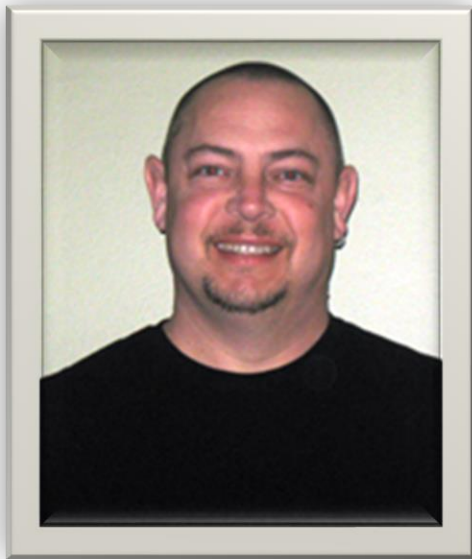
Baldwin rolls career high single:

Catherine did not come up through a youth bowling organization but started bowling 10 pin in family outings at a young age and then left the game for a period of time. Baldwin said she has been bowling 10 pin for twenty years mostly in the B10TNML. This writer checked the LCTA average year books for the last 13 years to see how Catherine was doing average wise in the B10TNML. Starting in the 2010-2011 bowling season and cascading upwards, she



averaged 141-143-145-147-151-148-152-149-151-148. She took the 2020 – 2021 and 2021-2022 seasons off when Covid entered our lives. Last year she finished with a 138 average for 93 games. This year she is averaging 138 for 57 games. Catherine, a right handed bowler, did not know her highest triple. Her other sporting interests are golf, darts and bocce ball mixed with her hobbies playing poker and camping. Catherine works at Canadian Tire as a Proactive Supervisor.

Senior Lapointe is King of the lanes:

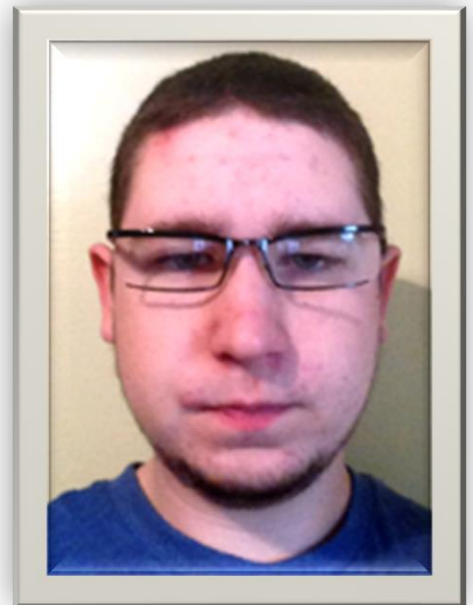

He bowls with Jason Lapointe and Jason Armitage and the

trio are in first place in the BWCL. Lapointe is averaging 218 for 48 games in the BWCL and 212 for 48 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League.

Zevenbergen sneaks into second spot:

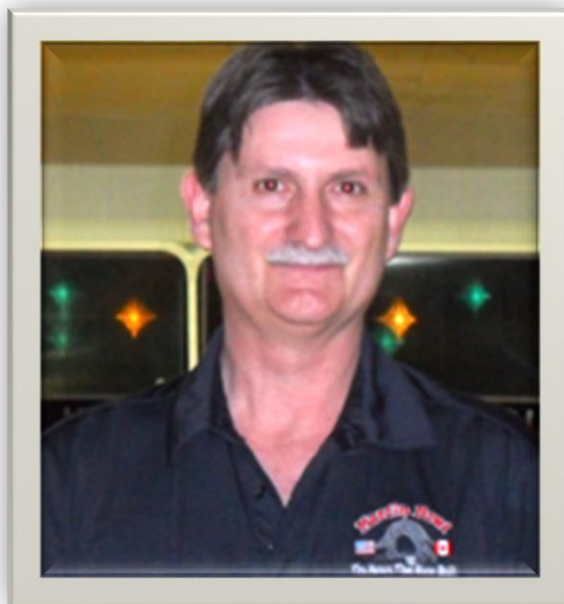


Romanik enters this year's 700 club:
