Weekly Highlights

Smith demolishes the pins with 800 triple:



Connor D.R. Smith had no mercy on the pins on Monday night as he fired 801 (264 – 46 pins over average – 278 – 60 pins over average – 259 – 41 pins over average – 147 pins over average for three games) to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl using his 15-pound Brunswick “Hypnotize” bowling ball. He had 29 out of a possible 36 strikes in his achievement. It was his career sanctioned 2nd 800 series and his 4th 700 plus triple of the season as he previously bowled 711 (227-259-225), 721 (244-257-220) and 725 (230-267-228). It was the 3rd 800 series in the LCTA this season with Kole Parkkila 819 (287-277-255) and Mike Shephard 804 (268-258-278) rolling the other two. Smith is averaging 220 for 72 games in the FTBMNML this season. Connor’s career high scores are 815 (258-279-278 – 32 out of a possible 36 strikes) which he tossed in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl and 300 both recorded in the 2016-2017 bowling season.

Watson is purr-fect again:

Bryce Watson rolled twelve consecutive strikes in his first game of the night to record a perfect game in LCTA bowling action this past week. Ten of his strikes were solid pocket hits and the other two were messengers that usually happen when the ball enters the



pocket with explosive power leaving the 7 or 10 pin. A “messenger” is the name used to describe the pin that is hit, travels across the pin deck and then hits other pins (usually the 7 pin for a left-handed bowler and the 10 pin for a right-handed bowler) to complete a strike or break up a split. It was his first 300 bowling with two hands as he previously bowled with a one arm swing delivery. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 679 triple. It was his career 3rd perfect game and the 12th in the LCTA this season. Check out the LCTA web site to see the other bowlers who accomplished this feat. Bryce also fired 708 (222-253- 49 pins over average – 233) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to record his 9th 700 this season, his career 15th 700 and the 7th high triple of the week.

Hoadley is 100 pins over average:



Tyler Hoadley hurled 289 (103 pins over average) in his first game of the night to be 100 pins over average for a single game in the LCTA this past week. He established a new high single game beating his previous 267. He is eligible for a CTF award which is a watch for his achievement if he has not already received this award. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 709 (289-205-215 – 151 pins over average for three games) triple which was good for the 6th high triple of the week. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously rolled 718 (210-251-257) and 726 (247-235-244). Tyler is bowling full time in three leagues this season. His averages with the number of games in brackets are MFFL 188 (52), the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League 192 (72) and the Best Wiring Classic League 190 (78). His career high triple is 726.

Wiles is 100 pins over average:

Doug Wiles wheeled 278 (111 pins over average) in his second game of the night to be 100 pins over average for a single game in the LCTA this past week. Wiles is eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) award which is a watch for his great game. He also established new personal high scores topping his previous 590 and 229. He was bowling in the Target Trios Mixed League on lanes 7 & 8 at Hi-Way Bowl, finishing the night with a 633 (278-208 – 132 pins over average for three games) triple. Doug is



averaging 169 after 29 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the league he averaged 158 for 90 games.

Blake tops her triple:



Shaylyn Blake fired 513 (196 – 65 pins over average – 164-153 – 120 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple topping her previous 496 (183-176-137) which she bowled three weeks ago in the PYL. Her sanctioned high single is 211. Shaylyn is averaging 131 after 28 weeks on the lanes this season. Last year she averaged 132 for 87 games.

Nesbitt rolls new high three:

Karys Nesbitt rolled 457 (130-167 – 35 pins over average – 160) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to post a new high triple beating her previous high 443. Her career high single is 182. Karys is averaging 132 after 28 weeks in the PYL this year. Last year in the league she averaged 130 for 93 games.



Armstrong has strong week:



John Armstrong tossed 748 (246-267 – 43 pins over average – 235) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 35 & 36 and 728 (246-245-237) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 29 & 30 both at Marcin Bowl, to register the 2nd and 3rd high triples of the week in LCTA bowling competition. They were his 9th and 10th 700’s of the season as he previously bowled 752, 753, 744, 728, 701, 743. 717 and 724. Armstrong is averaging 216 for 78 games in the BWCL this year, 227 for 21 games in the SPBCML and 233 for 12 games in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League. John has 3 sanctioned 300’s to his credit, a correction from a previous highlight.



Parkkila edged to fourth spot:

Justin Parkkila wheeled 725 (256-241-228) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) as a spare on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously rolled 712 (252-241-219) and 713 (222-257-234). Justin is averaging 208 for 12 games in the BWCL this season. He also bowls in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's league averaging 200 for 39 games. Parkkila's career high scores are 754 (266-232-256) which he bowled in the Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl in the 2019-2020 season and 300 (3).

Crowe has another solid night:

Devon Crowe tossed 721 (241 – 265 – 59 pins over average – 215) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to post the 5th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 759 (256-267-236) and 751 (257-246-248). Devon is averaging 207 for 81 games in the FTBMNML this season. Crowe's career high scores are 759 which he bowled this season and 289 which he bowled in the Monday Night Men's League in the 2019-2020 season.

Parkkila notches number ten:

Kole Parkkila rolled 706 (279 – 65 pins over average – 236-191) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to notch his 10th 700 of the season and the 8th high triple of the week in the LCTA. His other 700 plus triples this year are 717, 750, 720, 751, 767, 819, 788, 711 and 717. It was his career 15th 700 series. Kole is averaging 215 for 78 games in the FTBMNML this season.



Lapointe and Peters tie with same triple:

Ben Lapointe and Steve Peters shared the same triple in LCTA bowling action this past week.



Lapointe hurled 705 (245-235-225) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to share the 9th high triple of the week. It was his 26th 700 of the season and his career 140th 700. Lapointe now ties Mike Shephard for the season's 700 crown. It looks like it will be a race right down to the wire for the crown with only a few more weeks to go on the lanes.

Lapointe is averaging 216 for 84 games in the SPBCML this year.

Peters wheeled 705 (238-232-235) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to share the 9th high triple of the week.
