Weekly Highlights

Smith leads the way:



Connor Smith fired 752 (278 - 70 pins over average – 259 -215 – 128 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to post the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Connor is a graduate from the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Bowling Program where he developed his bowling skills under the watchful eyes of Shirley and Mel Matthews. He has two very memorable moments on the lanes in his young bowling life so far: bowling his first 300 on December 9, 2016 and achieving the extremely difficult 800 triple when he rolled 815 (258-279-278) on

December 22, 2017. Both exciting moments were recorded at Hi-Way Bowl. He has raised his average to 215 after 18 games in the BCML this season.



Cook takes second place:

Brad Cook wheeled 742 (270-204-268 – 130 pins over average for three games) in the Border City



Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the week's second high triple in LCTA bowling activity. The right handed bowler is averaging 211 after 18 games this season. Last season in the BCML he finished with a 200 average for 78 games in the shortened season due to COVID 19. Cook has three memorable moments on the lanes, two of which were when he tossed perfect games. This writer would think however his most memorable moment was when he accomplished every competitive bowler's dream when he posted his 820 triple in 2015.

Williams rolls first 700 series:



Dawson Williams rolled the first ten strikes in his second game of the day only to come light on his 11th shot leaving three pins on the deck. He made the spare and capped the game off with a strike finishing with a 287 which was good for the youth high single of the week. He finished with a super 732 (224-287- 112 pins over average – 221 – 207 pins over average for three games) triple to record his first ever 700 triple. His 287 was also his career highest single game. His previous career high scores were 630 and 245 which he bowled this year. He was taking part in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the Senior Division under the leadership of Gil and Carol Jean.

This season he is now averaging 189 after 15 games. Last season he finished with a 162 average for 72 games.

Marciniszyn leads the ladies:

Pam Marciniszyn rolled 641 (216-235) in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to lead the ladies on the lanes. Pam is a strong right handed bowler who has averaged between 216 and 224 the last nine years dropping off to 204 last year and is averaging 209 after 9 games this bowling season. The TNML is bowling alternate weeks this season due to COVID limit restrictions in bowling establishments and thus will only get a half season this year. Her career sanctioned high triple is 786 and she has one sanctioned perfect game



bowled at Port Huron Lanes in Michigan and one non sanctioned 300 game rolled at Marcin Bowl. Pam started bowling at age 5 in the Marcin Bowl SMAA Youth Bowling Program and has continued to enjoy bowling and the great friendships she made at the lanes. Pam has also coached in the Marcin Bowl SMAA Youth Bowling Program for over twenty five years.

Windover posts personal high scores:



Joe Windover tossed 630 (202-197-231 –76 pins over average - 165 pins over average for three games) in the Intermediate Division in the Youth Bowling Program at Marcin Bowl to register both his highest personal triple and single game. His previous high scores were 568 and 225. He is currently averaging 166 after 15 games this year. Last year he finished with a 149 average for 78 games. Windover started bowling at age 6 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the 2010- 2011 bowling season finishing the year with a 51 average for 87 games. His other sports enjoyment is playing baseball and helping with umpiring to keep himself

busy in the summer.
