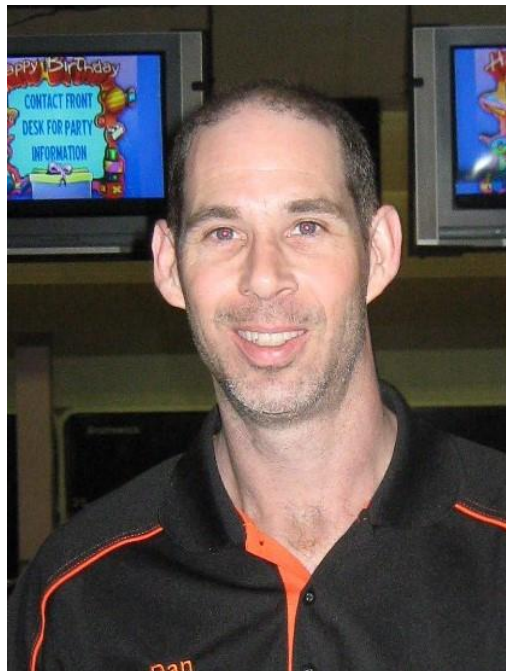
Pelkie hammers the pins:



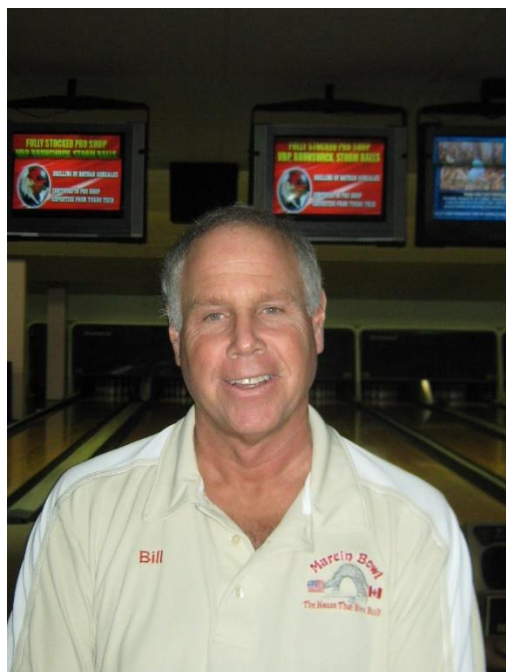
Team Canada Youth member Morgan Pelkie had a brilliant day in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program on Saturday in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) action this past week. She merciless

hammered the pins as she fired 780 (279 - 80 pins over average - 11 strikes in a row – 236 - 265 – 183 pins over average for three games) on lanes 23 & 24 in the Intermediate Division. Morgan rolled 29 strikes out of a possible 36 strikes. She achieved not only her first 700 but also her personal highest triple. Her previous high triple was 695 and her highest single is 297. The right handed bowler raised her average to a solid 203 after fifteen weeks (45 games) of bowling. Morgan is polishing up her game as she is getting ready to bowl for the Youth Team Canada squad next year. CONGRATULATIONS Morgan on the SUPER bowling.



Chopp is men's top bowler:

Dan Chopp rolled 760 (247-267-246) in the Border City Men's League at Marcin Bowl to record the men's high triple of the week. Dan started bowling at age seven coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. He has been bowling for 43 years and is one of the toughest guys to beat on the lanes. His career sanctioned high scores are 6-300's and a 797 triple. He is the top average bowler this year in the LCTA carrying a solid 229 after sixteen weeks. His closet rival is Jim Creasor with a 226 average in the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League.

Cole is men's second best triple:

Bill Cole fired 744 (278- 77 pins over average – 244 - 222 – 141 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the men's second high triple. Bill is another bowler who picked up his bowling skills through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. He started bowling at age 12 and been enjoying the great sport for 45 years. His career sanctioned high scores are 4-300's and a 766 triple. Bill enjoys the competition in tournaments and always takes part in the Ontario Senior Singles/Doubles Tournaments, the annual Ontario Provincial Tournaments (OPT) and the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) tournaments. He has attended USBC tournaments in

Reno, Las Vegas, Albuquerque, El Pas and Baton Rouge. His most memorable moment in bowling happened in 2001 when he bowled his first perfect game in the OPT (Doubles)



at the Super Bowl Lanes in Windsor. Bill is a diehard Miami Dolphin fan and has been known to drive to Miami to watch a game.

Marciniszyn is men's third best bowler:



Mike Marciniszyn tossed 742 (235-263-244) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to have a solid day in LCTA competition this week. Mike is a consistent right handed opponent who has averaged 218 (starting in the 2010-2011 season and going upward), 217, 217, 217, 216, 218, 223 and 224 in the SMML This year he is averaging 224 after fifteen weeks of bowling. He has 8-300's (sanctioned) to his credit.

Watson comes in fourth for the men:



Brian Watson bowled 733 (246-279 – 73 pins over average) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the men's fourth high triple this week. Brian is another bowler who picked up his lane skills from a youth bowling program. He went through the Hi-Way Bowl Phantoms Youth Bowling Program becoming a solid rival in league competition. His highest sanctioned scores are 785 with 3-300's and 1-299 under his belt. He has been a relatively consistent bowler over the last seven years in the BMNML averaging (starting from the 2010-2011 season) 218, 212, 214, 209, 208, 215, 210 but dropped to 203 last year. This year he is averaging 206 after 42 games.

Nimmo posts men's high over average:

Right hander Ken Nimmo rolled 668 (244-244 – 79 pins over average - 173 pins over average for three games) in the Triple A Mixed League (TAML) at Marcin Bowl to post the men's high over average in LCTA bowling action this week. Ken spent most of his youth in the United Kingdom where no bowling programs existed. He started bowling in the early seventies at around age 28/29 with the Catalytic Bowling League at Northgate Bowl as a night of fun with workmates and has been on the lanes for 46 years. His best years were in 2010-2011, 2011-2012, 2012-2013 bowling seasons when he was averaging in the 190's. His most memorable moment in bowling is when he bowled his first perfect game in the TAML in March 2011. Ken rolled another 300 in the TAML in February 2013 and his highest triple is 777 (247-264-266). He said he is still trying to get a Dutch 200 (strikes and spares in alternate frames), an all spare game and a triplicate series (all three games the same score). Ken enjoys bowling competition always participating in the Marcin Bowl Shoot Outs and the annual Ontario Seniors Single Handicap Tournament (usually held in Burlington or St. Catharines) and the Seniors Double Handicap Tournament held in Windsor. He is participating in TAML and the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League this year.

Youth tops personal high scores:

McKenna Scott wheeled 450 (204 – 73 pins over average) in the Marcin Youth Intermediate Division to record her personal high single and triple. McKenna stated bowling three years ago at age thirteen because she was bored sitting around watching her brother bowl. She has been successful in winning scholarship money in Ontario Provincial Youth Handicap Tenpin Tournaments. She won the E Division of the Doug Imms Memorial Tournament in 2015 and placed 4th in the Ontario Youth Singles Tournament in 2016. She enjoys going with her family and friends to local tournaments and out of town tournaments. The last couple years she has travelled with



family and a few other youth bowlers from Marcin Bowl to Quinte Bowl in Belleville to compete in the Ontario Youth Doubles Handicap Tournament. She does babysitting and works at the Progressive Centre on “Sting” hockey nights to earn spending money.
