The pins didn't have a chance against Roy Mezzatesta on Wednesday night. It was his career passing his previous (January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2003) and 17 pins shy of equaling record held by Jim (299-279-300 – October

15, 2015). It was the first 800 triple in the LCTA this season. Last season, Steve Lewicki tossed the only 800 triple in the LCTA when he rolled 801 in the first week of bowling.



Roy also has 8-300's to his credit. Roy started bowling at age 10 coming up through the Echo Lanes youth bowling program. At age 12, he was a National Singles Champion in the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) tournament held in Edmonton. The 63 year old right hander is bowling full time in three leagues this year: the TTML, the Marcin Border City Men's League and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League.

**Lapointe is second best:**

Ben Lapointe fired 787 (243-265-279) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to post the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was his career personal best high triple beating his previous high of 775.



Ben, a solid right handed bowler with a ton of revs, developed his bowling skills at an early age coming up through the Hi-Way Bowl youth bowling program. The twenty year old bowls full time in two leagues: the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Phantom League and the Hi-Way Bowl RCAFA 403 Mixed League. He also spares in other leagues when required. His career accomplishments so far include 2-298's, 2-299's, 1-300 and 31-700 plus triples (20



in adult leagues and 11 in youth leagues). Ben is presently working and attending Lambton College furthering his education.

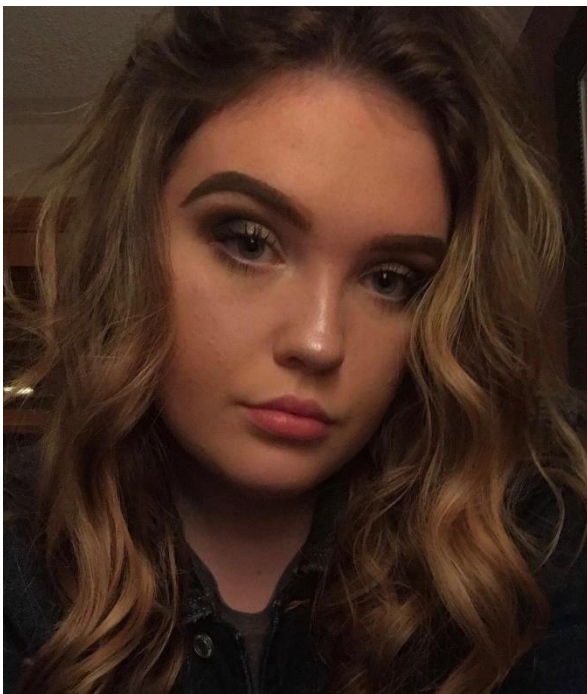
**Legault is tops for the Ladies:**
