Pam has been a strong competitor in the league over the years. Her final averages in the TNML over the last eight years were 224 – 223 – 222 – 216 – 214 – 218 – 206 and 208. The once a week right handed bowler is having a solid year in the league this year again averaging 210 after 42 games. Her career high triple is 786. She has 2-300's to her credit (one sanctioned and one non sanctioned).

Braeden topped his previous highest scores 561 and 242 which he registered two weeks ago. Braeden started bowling at age 9 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Junior Bowlers Program and is entering his 7th year on the lanes. When Braeden first hit the lanes as a Bantam in the 2013-2014 season he ended the
