## Weekly Highlights

### Mezzatesta starts season strong:



Roy Mezzatesta fired 745 (278 – 63 pins over average – 232 – 235 – 135 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30, in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League at Marcin Bowl, to lead the way in the opening week of the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) 2025 – 2026 bowling season. Mezzatesta had a clean night (all spares/strikes) in all three games. Mezzatesta is off to a great start in the 700 race and is hoping to top his last season’s performance on the lanes when he posted 15-700’s.

### Domingue rolls Honour Score:



Steve Domingue rolled the first eleven strikes in his last game of the night. This writer has been in that situation before and I can assure you that Steve’s heart was racing, his hands were sweaty, his bowling ball seemed a lot heavier, the pins looked a lot farther than 60 feet away and he was well aware that pretty much everybody in the bowling alley was going to watch his last delivery. As Domingue set himself on the approach for his last shot he was probably thinking “just one more”. The crowd was hushed as Steve delivered his final ball but it was not to be his moment of glory as the ball came up high leaving an open split for a 298. Mike Rogers wheeled 575 (206-188-181) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 557 (172-203-182) which he bowled in the SPBCML last season and his career high game is 248.

### Park posts new high single:

Shawn Park wheeled 265 (90 pins over average) in his second game of the night to record a new personal high single topping his previous 260. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 632 triple. Park's high triple is 639 which he recorded in the FTBMNML two seasons ago.



### Nutt tops his high single:

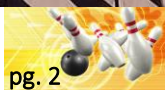


Matt Nutt tossed 258 (77 pins over average) in his last game of the night to register a career new high single beating his previous 247. He was participating in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 610 triple. Nutt's career high triple is 670 which he fired in the FTBMNML last season.

### Lapointe starts season with 2-700's:



Ben Lapointe rolled 731 (290 – 68 pins over average – 250 – 191) on lanes 23 & 24 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League and 708 (224-228-256) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League on lanes 33 & 34 both at Marcin Bowl, to take the early lead in the season's 700 race. Ben was the King of the Lanes last season as he posted 28-700's to be the top bowler in the 700 club.



## Shephard holds on to third:



Mike Shephard hurled 717 (236-223-258) on lanes 13 & 14 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl, to take third place in the 700 race this past week in LCTA bowling action. Mike had a solid year last season as he recorded 27-700's to take second place in the year's 700 race. Shephard also was the top average bowler in the LCTA last season as he posted a 225 average for 72 games in the Klean and Brite Mixed League and a 224 average for 96 games in the FTBMNML.
