Weekly Highlights

Parkkila continues his strong bowling:



Kole Parkkila rolled 788 (287 - 75 pins over average – 243-258 – 136 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 7th 700 this season and his career 12th 700. Kole is one of two bowlers posting 800’s this season as he bowled 819 (287-277-255). Mike Shephard has the other one at 804 (268-258-278). Parkkila is averaging 215 for 51 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 199 for 36 games.

Gauthier takes second place:

Brandon Gauthier hurled 776 (290 – 83 pins over average – 276 – 69 pins over average – 210 – 155 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, to take second place in the high triple department this past week. It was Gauthier’s first 700 this season. In the 2022-2023 season he rolled 13-700’s and last season he recorded 10-700’s. His career high scores are 841 (268-



297-276) which he posted in the Mulder Financial Fun League in the 2022-2023 season and 300 (8). Brandon is averaging 211 for 42 games in the SPBCML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 211 for 78 games.

Shura fires career first 700:



Joshua Shura fired 738 (258 – 77 pins over average - 246 – 65 pins over average – 234 – 53 pins over average – 195 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to record his career first 700 series and the 3rd high triple of the week. He also was high over average for three games this week. Shura’s previous sanctioned high triple was 685 (256-269-160) which he fired in the Marcin Bowl Youth League in the 2019-2020 season and his high single is 299 which he bowled in the Mulder Financial Fun League last season. Joshua is averaging 184 after 18 weeks in the PYL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 180 for 92 games.

Bogaert is 100 pins over average:

Laurie Bogaert tossed 244 (113 pins over average) in her second game of the night to be eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation 100 pins over average award for a single game which is a watch. She was bowling in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl. This writer believes that this is also her career highest single game. Laurie is averaging 131 after 19 weeks in the B10TNML this year bowling with teammates Crystal Dunn, Penny Geerts, Marsha Pinel, Matt Hicks and Mike Sheppard. Last year in the league she averaged 129 for 93 games.

Ramsay slides into fourth position:

Kirk Ramsay wheeled 735 (225-246-264) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to post the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. He also rolled 701 (244-199-258) in the Best Wiring Classic League on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to tie for the



low 700 of the week. They were his 7th and 8th 700's of the season. Kirk is holding the high average in the FTBMNML this season, averaging 232 for 42 games bowling on the "TallKirk Financial" team with team members Mel Matthews, George Newman and Dennis Ramsay. Last year in the league he averaged 220 for 33 games.

Nutt records personal high triple:



Matt Nutt rolled 670 (234 – 61 pins over average - 225 – 52 pins over average – 211 – 151 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to record his career high triple. Matt started bowling as a kid in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at HI - Way Bowl under the guidance of bowling coaches Mel and Shirley Matthews. He said he wasn't sure how he got interested in bowling, but it kept him busy as a kid. Nutt, a right-handed bowler, said "I bowled in the PYL for about 5 years until about age 16 and the Matthews taught me everything I know and everything I promptly forgot". He also said, "I gave up bowling to become a soccer prodigy but guess what, there was a spoiler alert, and I didn't make the World Cup". Matt returned to 10 pin bowling this year in the FTBMNML on the encouragement of his friend Warren Knights, after a 20-year hiatus off the lanes. Golf is his main sporting interest, and his hobbies include investing, collecting records, smoking meats, and going on road trips. He said "basically, I'm either planning for the future or living in the past". Nutt wasn't sure of his high single but said "I can confidently say it wasn't televised". Matt is averaging 176 for 48 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Knights fires new high triple:

Warren Knights fired 618 (201 – 41 pins over average – 216 – 56 pins average – 201 – 41pins over average – 138 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to register a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 617 (174-239- 204) which he bowled in the FTBMNML last season. Knights is averaging 163 for 51 games in the FTBMNML this season bowling on the "Bed Rock



Bowlers” team with team members Ben Cicchini, Werner Koundakjian and Matt Nutt. Last season in the league he averaged 162 for 96 games.

Weed records new high scores:



Justin Weed tossed 594 (147-223- 70 pins over average - 224 – 71 pins over average – 135 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to establish career personal new high scores. His previous high scores were 589 (165-219-205) and 219 which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season. Friis fires ladies top triple:

Jill Friis fired 667 (213-195-259 – 61 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) as a spare on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to record the ladies high triple of the week. Jill’s 259 was good for the ladies second high single of the week. She is averaging 200 for 36 games in the



league this year. Last year she averaged 216 for 54 games in the BWCL which was the highest ladies average in the Canadian Tenpin Federation for the year.

Sinclair is second best for the women:



Dara Sinclair tossed 663 (182-224-257 – 70 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to register the women's second high triple of the week. Dara's 257 was good for the women's third highest single of the week. She is averaging 189 for 48 games in the league this year bowling with teammates Doug Black and Jeff Raymond. Last year in the BWCL she averaged 180 for 75 games.

Sitter rolls ladies top single:

Kelly Sitter rolled 279 (90 pins over average) in her last game of the night to record the ladies high single of the week in LCTA bowling activity.
