Skinner perfect for the first time:



Ryan Skinner fired 717 (300- 111 pins over average – 2nd game - 245 – 150 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. It was his career first perfect game and the 6th recorded in the LCTA this season. The right handed bowler was playing the deep inside shot and had twelve explosive pocket hits. Ryan, who throws a ton of revs, started bowling at age 4 in the Hi-Way Bowl Phantoms Youth League and with the great coaching he received has become a solid bowler. He has been enjoying the fun on the lanes for 26 years. He is a once a week bowler, besides sparing, with a personal high triple of 793 and now his high single is 300.

Lapointe is week's top keglar:

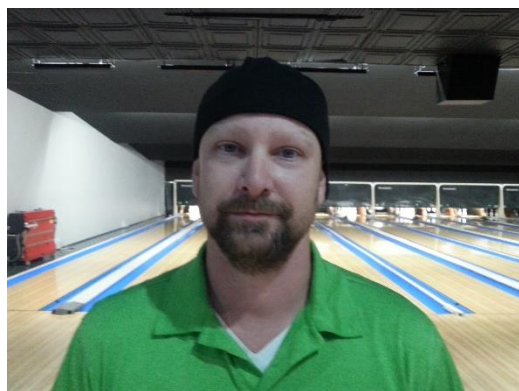


Jim Lapointe hurled 747 (229-228-290 – 11 strikes in a row) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to post the top triple in LCTA bowling action this week. The right handed hurler was also playing the deep inside shot and hammered the pins all night long. He is a twice a week bowler also participating in the RCAFA 403 Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl. He is currently averaging 232 after 30 games in TNML.

George rolls career high triple:

Elgin George rolled 730 (258-72 pins over average - 230-242 – 172 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Aamjiwnaang Mixed League (SAML) at Marcin Bowl to record his career personal highest triple. Elgin is a right handed bowler who came up through the Marcin SMAA Youth Bowling Program and is a once a week bowler in the SAML. He started relishing the good times on the lanes at age 7 and has been bowling for 25 years. His career highest single game is 290. He said one his memorable events in bowling is when he rolled 290 games about a year apart. He is currently averaging 192 after 27 games.

Lucas tosses first 600 triple:



Jason Lucas tossed 618 (220-213) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to register his career first 600 triple. Jason is a right handed bowler who partakes in league bowling once a week. He did not come up through a youth bowling program starting bowling at age thirty-three. This is his 4th year in the BCML. His highest single game is 255. Jason said one of his most memorable moments in

bowling was when he did a face plant on the lanes with the first ball he throw in the BCML.

Collins is high over average:



Lewis Collins wheeled 596 (215 – 76 pins over average – 179 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the high over average for three games. Lewis is a lefty bowling only in the BCML. He started bowling at age 11 in the Youth Bowl Canada program in Chatham and has been hitting the lanes for eleven years. His highest triple is 625 and his highest single

game is 257. When asked about any memorable moments in bowling his reply was “I just enjoy the game and love to meet people and enjoy the game”.

Personal best triple for youth bowler:

Hollie-Anne Jean tossed 577 (218 - 60 pins over average – 101 pins over average for three games) in the Intermediate Division of the Marcin Bowl Youth Tenpin program to register her personal highest triple. Hollie has been with the junior program for approximately 11 years and started as a Junior Bantam at the age of 5. Rarely do you not see Hollie at the lanes on a Saturday morning helping in any way she can. For the past 4 years she has been active as a Junior Coach helping with the younger divisions or helping as a lane runner for the adult LCTA tournaments. Her goal each year is to improve her average and attend as many CTF (Canadian Tenpin Federation), provincial and local tournaments as possible. She has been successful by medaling in those tournaments of past several years. Her current average is 162 and to date she has a career high game of 227 and series of 577 with a hope of hitting her 600 soon. You can usually find her practicing during the week with head coach Gil Jean (aka Grandad) but also gives credit to all the coaches that have helped her over the years. Hollie says she has had many memorable moments in bowling but winning the Bowler of the year in 2015-16 was probably the top one. Hollie likes to participate in intermural sports at school and although she admits she may not be the best player in each sport, her commitment is doing her best each time. Her good sportsmanship, commitment and team spirit has earned her Female Athlete of the year for grade nine and ten at school. She carries this over to her everyday school life where she has been awarded the IODE (Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire) grade 9 achievement award and a citizenship award. Hollie's other passions are with horseback riding/lessons which she has done for 6 years and playing paintball with her dad, Shawn at very competitive stages of the games.
