Weekly Highlights

Lapointe closes season with top triple:

Jim Lapointe hurled 737 (234-245-258) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) season closing bowling action. It was his 17th 700 of the season in the LCTA. Last season Lapointe had 10-700's to his credit. Jim's top triple this season was 804 (277-258-269) while his top triple last season was 800 (254-247-299). Senior Lapointe's closing average in the FTBMNML this season was 221 for 93 games. He was bowling on the "Lambton Metal Service" team with team members Shane Chipman, Ben Lapointe and Connor Smith.



Troiani rolls new high single:

Giordano Troiani rolled 198 (69 pins over average) in his second game of the night to record a new personal high single in the LCTA. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 449 triple. This was Giordano's first year bowling in the FTBMNML and his closing average was 129 for 60 games His previous high single of



180 was recorded in the FTBMNML this season.. He was bowling with team members Adrian Mezzatesta, Mateo Troiani and Luke Crombeen.

Peters finishes with strong bowling:

Steve Peters fired 733 (254-200-279 – 89 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to finish his season with the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition and back to back 700 triples. Last week Peters posted his career high triple 787 (251-278-258) in the Best Wiring Classic League at Marcin Bowl. Peters high triple last season was 714 (237-253-224). Steve had 4-700's this season while last season he had 2-700's to his credit. Steve's closing average in the FTBMNML this season was 192 for 93 games. Glenn Crowe and Ben Lapointe tied for third place in the high triple department this past week in LCTA bowling action.

Crowe rolled 717 (186-265 – 64 pins over average – 266 – 65 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to share the 3rd high triple of the week. Glenn had 4-700's to his credit this season. He had no 700's last season. Glenn's closing average in the FTBMNML this season was 203 for 93 games. Lapointe tossed 717 (247-256-214) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl.
