Weekly Highlights

Correction:

Last week this writer said Jim Lapointe had 6-800's to his credit when actually he has 7-800's, one (804) bowled in the old American Bowling Congress in the 1997-1998 season and 6 in the Lambton County Tenpin Association.

Lapointe and Wright are perfect:

Ben Lapointe and Daniel Wright rolled perfect games in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. They were the 9th and 10th 300's in the LCTA this season.



Lapointe hurled 784 (236-300 – 78 pins over average – 248 – 118 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to register the high triple of the week and share the high single of the week. Lapointe rolled 12 powerful strikes to record his 3rd 300 of the season and he now has a career 11-300's to his credit. It was also his 24th 700 in the LCTA this season and his career 165th 700. Lapointe is averaging 224 for 69 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 213 for 93 games.



When this writer entered Marcin Bowl on Friday night, Daniel Wright had the first 6 strikes in his last game of the night on lanes 27 & 28 in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL). I witnessed the last 6 strikes and every shot was a powerful, explosive pocket hit. This young man appeared to be so calm on those last 6 strikes it was almost hard to believe. After that final strike, Wright turned around to the cheering and congratulatory handshakes from a very appreciative audience. Mr. Wright finished the night with 768 (247 –



56 over average - 221 – 30 pins over average – 300 – 109 pins over average – 195 pins over average for three games) which was good for the second high triple and high single of the week. Daniel is eligible for a 100 pins over average for a single game award if he has not received this award before. It was his career first perfect game and also his 3rd 700 (700-763) of the season, topping his previous 763 (268-257-238) triple which he recorded five weeks ago in the MFFL. Daniel's previous high single was 276 which he bowled in the MFFL last season. Wright is averaging 194 for 72 games in the MFFL this season. SUPER bowling Daniel !!

Gark is almost perfect:



Lefty Jeff Gark rolled 299 (9 pin) in his last game of the day to post the second high single of the week in the LCTA. He was bowling in the London and District Tenpin Bowling Association Singles Team Tournament on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with 719 (225-195- 299 – 97 pins over average) which was good for the 10th high triple of the week. It was his first 700 of the season. Jeff had 5-700's in the LCTA last season. Gark's previous high single was 289 and his career high triple is 751 (236-248-267) which he bowled in the Mulder Financial Fun League last season.

Mundt and Bonhomme post career first 700's:

Brian Mundt and Rob Bonhomme had an exciting night on the lanes as they both finally broke through the 700 barrier for the first time in LCTA bowling action.



Mundt had a night that he will probably remember for a long time. He tossed 714 (242 – 82 pins over average – 268 – 108 pins over average – 204 - 234 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 12th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. His previous high triple was 606 (179-227-200) and his previous high single was 227, both bowled in the FTBMNML last season. Brian is eligible for a 100 pins over average award for a single game which is a watch with his 268. He was the leader this week in the high over average for three games department and came in second for the high over average for a single game. Mundt is averaging 166 for 39 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last season in the league averaged 159 for 93 games.





Bonhomme wheeled 713 (257 – 75 pins over average – 223 – 41 pins over average – 233 – 51 pins over average – 167 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 13th high triple of the week in the LCTA. His previous high triple was 693 (222-237-234) which he bowled in the MFFL last season. His sanctioned high single is 270. Rob is averaging 182 after 24 weeks on the lanes in the MFFL this season. Bonhomme works for the railway and at age 36 in the 2022- 2023 was a late starter to get involved for the first time with the great sport of 10 pin bowling. He moved to Sarnia from Northern Ontario and thought it would be a great way to get out, have fun and create a new network of friends.

O'Keefe records new high triple:

Youth bowler Kian O'Keefe tossed 506 (167 – 39 pins over average - 166 – 38 pins over average - 173 – 45 pins over average – 122 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple in LCTA bowling play. His previous high triple was 494 and his high single is 219 which he bowled in the PYL last season. Kian is averaging 128 after 24 weeks on the lanes this season. Last season in the PYL he averaged 125 for 90 games.

Mackinnon rolls new high scores:

Charlee Mackinnon rolled 478 (177 – 60 pins over average – 180 – 63 pins over average – 121 – 127 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to post new personal high scores. Charlee's previous high scores were 412 (94-176-142) and 176 which she bowled in the league this season. She is now averaging 117 after 24 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the PYL she averaged 106 for 87 games.

Fraser tops her high single:

Michelle Fraser wheeled 245 in her second game of the night, to top her previous 244 which she posted in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) last season. She was bowling in the KBTNML on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling play finishing the night with a 571 triple. Her career high triple is 637 (233-179-225) which she bowled in the KBTNML last season.



Michelle is averaging 176 after 24 weeks on the lanes this season. Last season in the league she averaged 179 for 96 games..

Adamson breaks out of slump:



Kyle Adamson fired 762 (247 – 43 pins over average – 269 – 65 pins over average – 246 – 42 pins over average – 150 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 2nd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 735 (214-244-277). Adamson has been struggling a bit on the lanes lately so it was nice to see him break out of his slump. Kyle is bowling in three leagues this year with his present averages and games in brackets are the following: FTBMNML 206 (69), Best Wiring Classic League 196 (78) and the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League 204 (60). His career sanctioned high scores are 813 (6) and 300 (8).

Watson grabs fourth place:



Bryce Watson rolled 758 (286 – 82 pins over average – 256 – 52 pins over average – 216 – 146 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) as a spare on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 7th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 740, 703, 748, 779, 706 and 700. He now has a career 22-700’s to his credit. Watson is averaging 212 for 18 games in the SPBCML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 206 for 81 games.

Lapointe Senior on a roll:



Jim Lapointe hurled 755 (223-297 – 83 pins over average – 235) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 5th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 6th 700 series of the season. Lapointe had the first 11 strikes in his second game with good hits but came wide on his last ball to leave the 2-8-10 split. His 297 was the third high single of the week in the LCTA. Lapointe’s game is getting stronger every week and last week



he displayed his bowling skills by rolling 804 (277-258-269) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League to record his career 7th 800 series. Jim is averaging 216 for 69 games in the BWCL this season. Lapointe has 10-300's to his credit.

Kinny takes sixth position:



TJ Kinny fired 746 (267 – 58 pins over average – 256 – 47 pins over average – 223 – 119 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 6th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 2nd 700 this season as he previously bowled 716 (236-237-243). TJ is averaging 209 after 24 weeks of bowling this season in the MFFL. Kinny started bowling at age 5 going straight through the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Bowling Program until age 21. His career sanctioned high triple is 800 triple which he rolled as a Hi-Way Bowl Junior at age 19 in the 2002-2003 season, and his high single is 300 which he fired in the Friday Night Fun Mixed

League at Marcin Bowl in the 2022-2023 season.

Paquette tops his triple again:



David Paquette posted two personal high triple scores two weeks in a row. Two weeks ago, he rolled 730 (269-236-225) for a new high triple and this past week he tossed 736 (280 – 78 pins over average – 227-229 – 130 pins over average for three games) topping his previous high triple and taking the 7th high triple of the week in the LCTA. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl. They were his first 2-700's of the season in the LCTA. David is averaging 204 for 63 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the BWCL he averaged 205 for 72 games.

Murphy's game is vastly improved:

Chris Murphy tossed 727 (192 – 280 – 70 pins over average - 255 – 45 pins over average) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 and 718 (244-239-235) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League both at Marcin Bowl, to record the 8th and 11th high triples of the week in the LCTA. They



were his 15th and 16th 700's of the season. Murphy, a right handed bowler, is on a tear this season as last season he only had 4-700's. Chris is averaging 213 for 37 games as a spare in the FTBMNML and 213 for 62 games in the SPBCML this season.

Lewicki notches number eight:



Steve Lewicki hurled 726 (259 – 44 pins over average – 218-249) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 9th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 8th 700 in the LCTA this season, all bowled in the BWCL. Lewicki also bowls in the Cowboys and Indians League (CIL) in Port Huron and this writer guesses he probably has several 700's in that league. Steve is averaging 216 for 72 games in the BWCL and 224 for 66 games in the CIL this season.


Chipman and Peters share same triple:

Shane Chipman and Steve Peters rolled the same triple this past week in their respective leagues in LCTA bowling play.



Chipman tossed 706 (248 – 42 pins over average – 248 – 42 pins over average - 210) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to share the 14th high triple of the week in the LCTA. Shane is having a solid year on the lanes as it was his 9th 700 of the season. Chipman is bowling in three leagues this season. His averages in the leagues with the number of games in brackets are FTBMNML 207 (63), Best Wiring Classic League 217 (75) and Mulder Financial Fun League 215 (57).

Peters wheeled 706 (246 – 56 pins over average – 235 – 45 pins over average – 225 – 136 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to tie for the 14th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 2nd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 700 (235-206-259). Steve's career high triple is 740 and his high single is 296 which he bowled this season in the BWCL. Peters is averaging 191 for 78 games in the BWCL this season. Last season in the BWCL he averaged 202 for 60 games.

Jill Friis rolled 658 (246 – 48 pins over average – 204-208) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) as a spare on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to post the ladies high triple of the week in the LCTA. Kelly Sitter wheeled 635 (174 – 237 – 49 pins over average – 224) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Marcin Bowl, to record her 6th 600 of the season and the ladies 2nd high triple of the week in the LCTA. Kelly's previous 600's were 604, 618, 666 (201-255-210), 624 and 601. She is averaging 188 for 54 games in the RCAFA League and 182 for 57 games in the Best Wiring Classic League this season.
