Lewicki perfect with 800 series:

The pins didn't have a chance against Steve Lewicki on Friday night. He mercilessly slaughtered them as he hurled 836 (257- 300 - 86 pins over average -279 – 194 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to register the high triple and share the high single in Lambton County Tenpin Association

Lewicki tied his Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) career high triple again as he now has rolled 3-836's and 14-800's posted in the CTF (7), the defunct American Bowling Congress (1-841) and the United States Bowling Congress (6) in league and tournament action. His



highest triple is 857 which he recorded in the Port Huron Bowling Association in 2011. He now also has a career sanctioned 21-300's to his credit. It was the first 800 and 2nd 300 recorded in the LCTA this season. Lewicki also tossed 740 (290-216-234) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) this week. Lewicki, who is 49 years old, started bowling as a youngster coming up through the Hi-Way Bowl Youth bowling program. The lefty is bowling/sparing in two leagues this year with current average and games rolled in brackets: the RCAFA (220 for 24 games) and the SMCL (221 for 63 games).

Shephard also perfect:

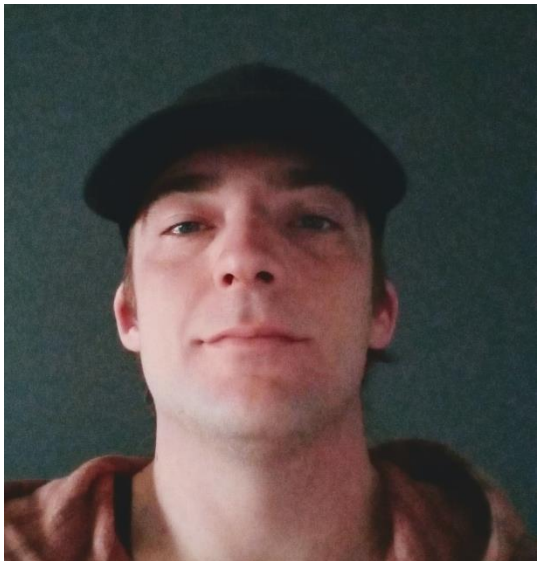


Mike Shephard mowed down the pins with twelve consecutive powerful, pocket strikes to record a perfect game and share the high single of the week with Steve Lewicki in LCTA bowling competition. The right hander accomplished the gem in his first game of the day on lanes 7 & 8 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) finishing the day with a 715 (300 – 73 pins over average – 204-211) triple. It was the second 300 this week and the third in the LCTA this bowling season. Shephard now has a career sanctioned 12-300's to his credit. He is currently averaging 227 after 63 games in the SMCL.



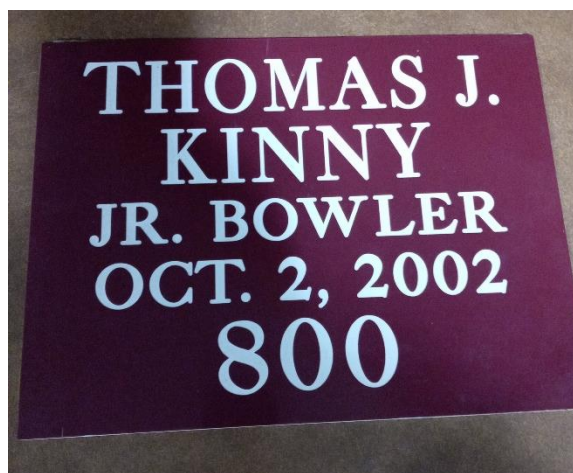
Kinny grabs second spot:

Thomas Kinny tossed 741 (246-247-248) on lanes 11 & 12 in the



RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to post the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. Kinny started bowling around age 5 going straight through the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Bowling Program until age 21 under the watchful eyes of Mel and Shirley Matthews. He participated in a couple adult leagues

over the years but hasn't really bowled in the last 10 years. Kinny said it has been a family sport over the years with his grandmother and mother being avid bowlers. He said his cousin Ryan Webb got him back into bowling after this writer highlighted Ryan in a recent



bowling report. He is not bowling full time in any league this year but is hoping to get enough sparing (only his second week) in the RCAFA to get enough games in to have an average for this year's Ontario Provincial Tenpin Bowling Tournament. Kinny is also hoping to bowl full time next season. His personal high scores are 279 and an even 800 triple which he rolled as a Hi-Way Bowl Junior



bowler at age 19 on October 2, 2002. He's very proud of the 800 plaque he has that hung on the "Wall of Fame" at Hi-Way Bowl for many years when the late Sonny Schofield owned the bowling alley. Not too many bowlers ever experience the excitement of bowling an 800 in their lifetime. His other exciting memorable bowling achievement was when he won the 1997 Mobile 1 Pro-Am in Bay City Michigan when he was 14 years old. He recalls that one professional bowler that he bowled against that day was Wayne Webb. His other interests include hockey and fantasy football and when he's not working he says he's with his wife and two dogs or playing video games.

Lapointe adds to career 700 total:



Ben Lapointe wheeled 713 (258-248-207) on lanes 7 & 8 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to increase his total career 700 triples. He now has 61-700's to his credit. He is having a great year on the lanes as he has fired 13-700's in his regular leagues and when he spares. He is one of many solid bowlers who have come up through

the different bowling houses youth bowling programs in Sarnia/Lambton over the years under the watchful eyes of many excellent coaches.
