Weekly Highlights

Kinny is week's only 700 keglar:



The lane conditions were tough this week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. TJ Kinny was the only bowler to post a 700 series this week. He fired 705 (240-262-203) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week. It was his second 700 this year both rolled in the BCML. His other one was 703 (234-234-235). Kinny is now averaging 213

for 15 games in the BCML.



Ambrose fires personal best game:

Last week Heather Ambrose posted her career highest single game when she rolled 212 (82 pins over average) in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl. At the time it was too late to highlight her so she is being highlighted this week. Heather did not come up through an organized youth league but started bowling at age 23 and has been knocking down the pins

for 8 years now, 6 of them in the TNML. Heather got interested in bowling because she wanted to hang out and spend time bowling with her grandmother and now her entire family has joined the league. Her other sporting interest is playing 2-pitch baseball. She said her hobbies include spending time with family, bowling and snacking. She is a right handed bowler with career high scores of 598 and 212. Heather is averaging 138 in the league this year and last year she finished with a 130 average for 96 games. In closing Heather said “we win some we lose some and there is always cold beer on tap”.

Cunningham wheels personal high game:

Eric Cunningham wheeled 196 (92 pins over average) in his last game of the night to record his career personal highest single game. He



was bowling in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 458 (137-125-196 – 146 pins over average for three games). He is averaging 114 for 15 games in the league this year. Cunningham started league bowling last year for the first time in the BCML and finished the year with 129 average for 84 games.

Blysniuk rolls career high single:



Steve Blysniuk rolled 185 (75 pins over average) in his first game of the night to register his career highest single game. He was bonding with the boys in the Border City Men's League on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 396. He is averaging 116 for 12 games this year in the league. This is Blysniuk's first year in organized league bowling.

Vandermeer is 100 pins over average:



Dan Vandermeer tossed 289 to be 100 pins over average for a single game to post the high single of the week in LCTA bowling activity. He was bowling in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl. He also tied his career high single game and his sanctioned high triple is 777. Vandermeer is



averaging 208 for 9 games this year in the BCML. Last year he finished with a 189 average for 48 games. Dan bowls on the “Lambton Chiropractic King Pins “team, with Mike Rogers, Bill Mayea, Kevin Storozuk, Tim Hutton and Tyler Warburton.

Best fires week’s second high single:



Brad Best had the first ten strikes in his first game of the night. On his 11th delivery he rolled the ball a little too far to the right and came up light on the head pin leaving 3 pins. He made the spare and struck on his last ball for a 287 game which was good for the second high single of the week in LCTA bowling competition. He was bowling in the Border City Men’s League (BCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. Best is averaging 199 for 15 games in the BCML this year. His career high scores are 768 and 289.

Apter rolls ladies high triple:

Makayla Apter wheeled 623 (190-236-197) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record the ladies high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. Her 236 was also good for the ladies second high single of the week. Makayla is averaging 190 for 12 games



in the FNFML this year. Last year she averaged 173 for 82 games in the FNFML. Her career high scores are 650 and 267.

Marciniszyn posts ladies top single:



Pam Marciniszyn tossed 240 in her second game of the night to record the ladies high single of the week. She was bowling in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl. Pam is averaging 189 for 15 games in the TNML this year. Last year in the TNML she averaged 208 for 93 games. Her career high scores are 786 and 300.

His hobbies include weight lifting and board games. He said some of his most memorable moments in bowling were when he was enjoying the fun on the lanes with his dad.
