Weekly Highlights

Lapointe grabs the lead:



Ben Lapointe hurled 782 (237-278- 65 pins over average – 267 – 143 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his career 79th 700 series in the LCTA which does not include any that he has

rolled over in Port Huron. It was also his 15th 700 this season and he now takes the lead in the race for the bowler with the most 700's this season. Roy Mezzatesta has 14 with one more week to go in the BCML, 2 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League and 3 in the Sunday Morning Classic League. Lapointe is averaging 214 for 54 games in the BCML. Ben also bowls/spares in three other leagues. His career high scores are 787 and 300 (3).



Dunn is 100 pins over average:

Kevin Dunn fired 278 in his last game of the night to be 102 pins over average for a single game which makes him eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch. He was bowling in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 670 triple. Dunn is averaging 176 in the TNML after 31 weeks. His career high scores are 710 and 298.

Hannah rolls career high single:

Logan Hannah rolled 242 (+81) in his second game of the day to record his personal high single game. He was bowling in the Marcin Bowl Youth League (MBYL) on lanes 15 & 16 finishing the day with a 560 triple. His previous high single game was 233 and his career high triple is 597. Hannah is averaging 161 for 29 weeks in

the MBYL this year.

Youth bowler records career high scores:

Daniel Wright wheeled 556 (188 – 58 pins over average – 170- 198 – 68 pins over average – 166 pins over average for three games) in the Marcin Bowl Youth League (MBYL) on lanes 13 & 14 to record his career highest scores. His 166 pins over average for three games also



was the high over average in the LCTA this week. Daniel started sanctioned league bowling in the Phantoms Youth League at Hi-Way Bowl in the 2018-2019 bowling season. He finished with a 92 average for 72 games that year. This year in the MBYL he is averaging 130 after 28 weeks on the lanes.

Karchewski rolls triplicate:



Cheryl Karchewski tossed 300 (100-100-100) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl last week to post a triplicate score. Triplicates are usually a rarity in a 10-pin bowling association. They happen every two to three years or perhaps longer. But not this year in the LCTA. Cheryl's triplicate was the third one recorded in the LCTA this season. The other two were registered in the Border City Men's League at Marcin Bowl: Mel Kongus – 549 (183-183-183) and John Armstrong – 741 (247-247-247).

Cheryl said she started 5-pin bowling as a kid but didn't get into 10-pin bowling until her 20's. She said "I'm 56 years young so I guess I've been bowling for 45 years or so but very sporadic as an adult". Like most bowlers, she got interested in bowling by following the footsteps of her parents. Cheryl is a baseball fan and loves watching the Blue Jays perform on the field. Her hobbies are quilting, knitting, crocheting, reading and playing games with family and friends. Karchewski said "bowling has become my newest obsession as I



can't wait to get to the lanes on Friday night. I bowl with my husband, daughter and son in law. I know I'm not the greatest bowler but I'm always trying to improve my game". The RCAFA league secretary verified her career high scores are 372 and 173. Cheryl is averaging 108 for 84 games in the league.

Skinner takes second spot:



Kyle Skinner fired 719 (228-265 – 56 pins over average - 226) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his fourth 700 series this season. Skinner is averaging 210 after 84 games in the BMNML this year. Skinner's career sanctioned high scores are 807 and 299.

Lapointe Sr. slides into third:

Jim Lapointe hurled 711 (224-209-278 – 74 pins over average) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League (FNFML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to take third spot in the 700 race this week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 9th 700 this season. Lapointe is averaging 214 after 30 weeks in the FNFML this year.



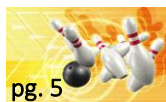
Chopp holds down last place:

Adamson 210 (93). Chopp's career sanctioned high scores are 797 and 300 (8).

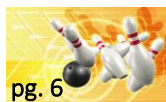
Youth featured bowler:
