Weekly Highlights

Mezzatesta leads the pack:



Roy Mezzatesta tossed 753 (220-244-289 – 91 pins over average - 159 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to record the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously rolled 745 (278-232-235) and 703 (265-214-224) both recorded in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML). It's good to see Roy back on track as he has been struggling on the lanes lately. The "Mezz" is averaging 205 for 24 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 212 for 88 games. He is also averaging 203 for 24 games in the SPBCML this season while last season he was 215 for 75 games.

Chipman nipped to second place:



Shane Chipman fired 749 (256-248-245) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to record the second high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 2nd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 700 (192-275-233) in the MFFL two weeks ago. Shane is now averaging 214 for 27 games in the MFFL bowling on the "Down Unders" team with teammates Dawn Cook, Sharon Lewicki and Jo-Ellen Beveridge. He also participates in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on the "Lambton Metal Services" team and is averaging 203 for 24 games and in the Best Wiring Classic League averaging 201 for 27 games.



Choptovy records new high three:

Stewart Choptovy hurled 713 (213 – 236 – 264 – 63 pins over average – 110 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to register his career first 700 series and the 5th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. This is Stewart's 2nd year bowling in the LCTA and the FTBMNML and last year he told this writer his high triple was 647 and his high single was 299 both posted in the Greater Toronto Tenpin Bowling Association (GTTBA). Stewart started 10 pin bowling at age 12 at the defunct Northgate Bowl but did not come up through an organized youth bowling organization. Choptovy grew up in Sarnia and after graduating from high school he moved to Toronto where he bowled in the GTTBA.

He has been bowling for 25 years but not always in league action. The right-handed bowler is now averaging 206 for 24 games in the FTBMNML bowling on the "Marcin Maulers" team with team mates Jeff Wickens, Mike Sheppard and Curt Cassetta. Last year in the league he averaged 184 for 96 games. Choptovy's other sporting interests are hockey, baseball, cornhole, NASCAR, golf and football. His hobbies are kayaking and being a do-it-yourself mechanic on his motorcycle and car.

Youth bowler bowls new high scores:

Silas Kelch bowled 321 (73-113-135) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to record new personal high scores in LCTA bowling action. His previous high scores were 254 and 125. This is Silas's 3rd year in the PYL and he is averaging 79 after 9 weeks bowling with team mates Evan Peters and Zachary Ingles. Last year in the league he averaged 88 for 63 games.

Robinson ups his high triple:

Mark Robinson tossed 684 (197 – 241 – 72 pins over average – 246 – 77 pins over average – 177 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 650 (234-230-186) which he bowled in the FTBMNML in the 2023-2024 season and his high single is 252. Robinson is now averaging 179 for 18 games

Legault records new high triple:



Noah Legault bowled 635 (200-211-224) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to record a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 606 (203-208-195) which he rolled in the PYL last season and his high single is 246 which he posted in the PYL this season. Noah is averaging 184 after 9 weeks on the lanes bowling with team mates Cody Pelkie and Brander Averill. Last year in the league he averaged 170 for 75 games.

Nickels tops his high single:

Tim Nickels wheeled 233 (90 pins over average) in his last game of the night to register a new high single beating his previous high single of 230. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 580 (203) triple. Nickels is now averaging 153 for 15 games bowling with team members Scott Shields, Dan Pimentel, Ryan Webb and TJ Kinny. Last year in the MFFL Tim averaged 162 for 54 games.

Beveridge records new high single:

Alexandra Beveridge rolled 210 (68 pins over average) in her second game of the night to record a new high single game topping her previous high game of 196. She was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 505 triple. Alexandra is now averaging 144 for 27 games in the league this year bowling with teammates Becky Adams, Dan Williams and Dion Maness. Last year in the MFFL she averaged 148 for 92 games.

Simard posts new high single:

Bobby Simard tossed 190 (61 pins over average) in his first game of the night to record a new personal high single game topping his previous 171. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 456 triple. Simard's career sanctioned high triple is 486. This is Bobby's first year participating in the LCTA and the SPBCML and he is



averaging 134 for 21 games bowling on the “Insultek” team with team members Luke Janson, Chris Theoret, Blair Wallace, Darcy Paradis, Mike Nimmo, Trevor Fortin and Jahn Budziewiez.

Chopp's game is improving:



Dan Chopp rolled 723 (244-212-267) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his first 700 of this season. Last season he had 3-700's to his credit. Chopper is now averaging 201 for 30 games in the SPBCML this year bowling with teammates Will Cushman, James Hipple and Tyler Warburton. Dan averaged 212 for 81 games in the SPBCML last season. Chopp's career high scores are 797 and 300 (7). He also has a 791 (246-278-267) to his credit which he bowled in the 2013-2014 season.

Mike Shephard hurled 717 (288 – 68 pins over average – 235-194) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 4th high triple of the week in LCTA bowling competition. It was his 8th 700 of the season and he is now tied with Ben Lapointe in the “King of the Lanes” race. It was also his 3rd 700 in a row in the BWCL as the last two weeks he tossed 720 (268-229-223) and 700 (231-248-221). Shephard is now averaging 222 for 27 games in the BWCL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 211 for 96 games.

Jim Lapointe hurled 711 (223-279 – 68 pins over average – 209) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to finally break the ice and enter this year's 700 club and record the 6th high triple of the week in the LCTA.
