Weekly Highlights

Watson is perfect:



Bryce Watson rolled the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition as he recorded a perfect game. It was his career 4th 300 and the 7th 300 in the LCTA this season. The smooth rolling twenty-one-year-old, no thumb right hander, was performing in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 669 triple. He accomplished the feat in his first game of the night and was 84 pins over average for the game. Bryce is averaging 207 for 42 games in the FTBMNML this season. Watson is one

of the many fine young bowlers that came up through the Hi-Way Bowl Phantoms Junior Bowling Program when it was operating under the leadership of Mel and Shirley Matthews.

Trio records super game:



Three bowlers on a four-man team recorded a super first game this past week in LCTA bowling competition. Bryce Watson (300), Glenn Crowe (287) and Devon Crowe (246) fired 833 scratch for an average of 277 per bowler. They rolled 30 out of a possible 36 strikes in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater

Monday Night Men's League on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl. Each bowler had the first eight strikes in a row before lead off bowler Devon broke the string in the ninth frame. Their 833 would have been a Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) record

however because it happened on a four-man team, the CTF classifies it as unofficial. Watson (300) and Glen Crowe (287) had a combined 587 for a two-man game score.

Murphy is top kegler again:



Chris Murphy is having a solid year on the lanes this year as he was the top bowler again for the 5th time this season. Murphy hurled 761 (226, 258 – 52 pins over average , 277 – 71 pins over average – 143 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. He now has 9-700's this season in the LCTA. Chris is averaging 209 for 41 games in the SPBCML this season bowling on the "AST Group" team. Murphy is bowling in four leagues this year.

Crowe takes second place:



Glenn Crowe tossed 741 (287 – 93 pins over average , 224, 230 – 159 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl, to record the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 707 (235-195-277 and 713 (248-267-198). Crowe is averaging 197 for 45 games in the FTBMNML this season. Last season in the league he averaged 195 for 90 games.

Ingles ups his high triple:



Blake Ingles fired 720 (200 , 277 – 84 pins over average , 243 – 50 pins over average – 141 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial League (MFFL) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to record a new personal sanctioned high triple in LCTA bowling activity. His previous high triple was 714 (212-254-248) which he bowled in the MFFL two months ago. It was his career 2nd 700 series and with the ice being broken, this writer will probably be highlighting this fine young bowler many more times in the future.

Blake's triple was good for the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. His 277 game was one pin shy of tying his career high single of 278. Ingles is averaging 196 for 51 games in the MFFL this year while last year in the league he averaged 184 for 93 games. Blake started bowling in 2013 at age 9 in the Youth Phantom League at Hi-Way Bowl and is in his 12th year of enjoying the great sport of 10-pin bowling.



Youth bowlers posts new high scores:

Charlee MacKinnon, Cooper Leneve, Chet Dupee and Bronwyn Litchfield recorded new personal high scores in LCTA bowling play this past week.

Charlee fired 412 (94-176 – 61 pins over average – 142) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to top her previous high scores of 389 and 174. She is averaging 115 after 17 weeks in the PYL this season. Last year in the league she averaged 106 for 87 games.

Cooper Leneve hurled 375 (114-146-140 pins over average 115) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to establish new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 341 and 140. Cooper is averaging 106 after 17 weeks of bowling in the PYL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 85 for 78 games.

Chet rolled 323 (109 – 43 pins over average – 105 – 39 pins over average - 109 – 43 pins over average - 125 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record new high scores. This writer did not have any scores on Chet before but I'm putting these scores as his personal best. He is bowling in the PYL for the first and is averaging 68 after 17 weeks of bowling.

Bronwyn wheeled 286 (121 – 74 pins over average – 69 – 96 – 49 pins over average – 145 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to establish new high scores. This writer did not have any scores on Bronwyn also but I'm guessing they are her best. She is bowling in the PYL for the first time and is now averaging 50 after 17 weeks on the lanes.

Gauthier converts the fence posts:

Brandon Gauthier converted the 7-10 split in his second game of the night. He fired the ball hard at the 10 pin which few into the pit hitting another pin that bounced out hitting the 7 pin. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League on lane 31 when he completed the conversion. This split is known as bed posts, goal posts, fence posts, mule ears and snake eyes and is one of the hardest splits to convert. Other bowlers who have converted this split over the last few years are Colleen Baldwin, Connor D.R. Smith, Alex Salmons, Jay Smith, Jason Armitage and Andrew McLean.



Greenway is 100 pins over average:



Will Greenway wheeled 266 (106 pins over average) in his last game of the night to be eligible for the 100 pins over average for a single game award. He was bowling in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 599 triple. Greenway's old high single was 251 and his high triple is 673 (200-247- 226) both rolled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl this season. Greenway started bowling 5 pin as a kid coming up through the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program in Wallaceburg/Chatham when he was 6 years old. At age 27 he started bowling 10 pin and in the 2023-2024 season he bowled in the RCAFA league finishing the year with a 138 average for 93 games. Last year he averaged 160 for 99 games in the RCAFA league. This year he is bowling in the FTBMNML and is averaging 168 for 48 games.

Seven bowlers record new high singles:

Daniel Wright, Richard Lajoie, Will Greenway, Will Waluchow, Sharon Lewicki, Jayme Leneve and Parker Hubbarth bowled new high singles in LCTA bowling activity this past week.



Wright wheeled 276 (63 pins over average) in his first game of the night topping his previous high 269 which he bowled in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) this season. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 691 triple. His sanctioned high triple is 700 (252-216-232) which was his first 700 which he posted in the FTBMNML this season. Wright is now averaging 216 for 15 games in the FTBMNML as a spare and 186 for 51 games in the MFFL this season.



Lajoie rolled 264 (95 pins over average) in his second game of the night to best his previous high single 233. He was bowling in the in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl, finishing with a 581 triple. Lajoie, a right-handed bowler, said his sanctioned high triple is 630. Richard did not come up through any organized youth league but only started sanctioned league bowling two years ago at age 50. He said his father and son got him interested in 10-pin bowling and the rest is history. His other sporting



interest is chasing that little white ball on the golf course to keep himself occupied in the summertime. He also said, "I love spending time at my cabin in the wilderness". Richard is averaging 171 for 48 games in the MFFL this season bowling with teammates Carolyn Lajoie, Cindy Lajoie and Claude Lajoie. His game has improved immensely as last season he averaged 130 for 99 games in the league. When this writer asked him about any memorable moments in bowling his answer was simply "every Friday night of bowling is memorable because I am with family and friends".



Greenway tossed 251 in his second game of the night to top his previous high single game 247 which he recorded in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) this season. Two days Later he increased his high single to 266 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League. He was bowling in the FTBMNML on lanes 15 & 16 finishing the night with a 658 (164-251 – 86 pins over average -243 – 78 pins over average – 163 pins over average for three games) triple. His career sanctioned high triple is 673 (200-247-226) which he bowled in the FTBMNML this season. Greenway is averaging 168 for 48 games in his first year in the FTBMNML as last year he bowled in the RCAFA league and averaged 160 for 99 games.

Waluchow fired 238 (83 pins over average) in his first game of the night to record a new personal high single. He was bowling in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high single was 235 and his high triple is 623 (196-192-235) both bowled in the KBTNML this season. Waluchow, a first time bowler in a sanctioned league, is averaging 155 after 17 weeks on the lanes.



Lewicki rolled 237 (77 pins over average) in her second game of the night, to top her previous high single of 235 which she posted in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) this season. She was bowling in the MFFL on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with a 560 (197) triple. Her sanctioned high triple is 611 (204-202-205) which she rolled in the MFFL last season. Sharon is averaging 162 for 51 games in the MFFL this season. Last year in the league she averaged 165 for 99 games.





Leneve rolled 198 (69 pins over average) in her last game of the night to beat her previous high 197. She was bowling in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League (KBTNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl. Her sanctioned high triple is 506. Jayme is averaging 129 after 17 weeks in the KBTNML this season. Last season in the league she averaged 129 for 72 games. Jayme, a right-handed bowler, started bowling at age 8 coming up through the Sarnia Minor Athletic Association bowling program at Marcin Bowl. She said she got interested in bowling because her mother used to bowl and encouraged her to also enjoy the fun on the lanes. She has been bowling for 18 years but only 6 of them in her present league. She is employed in the Bluewater Bridge Security department.

Hubbarth tossed 138 (51 pins over average) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to top his previous 132 high game. Parker's career high triple is 361. He is averaging 87 after 17 weeks in the PYL this season. Last season in the league he averaged 77 for 78 games.

Chipman posts number seven:



Shane Chipman fired 738 (269 – 62 pins over average – 266 – 59 pins over average – 203 – 117 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 7th 700 of the season as he previously bowled 700-749-724-747-708 and 803 (256-257-290) which is his career highest triple. Chipman is averaging 209 for 48 games in the FTBMNML this season.

Pair share same triple:

Roy Mezzatesta and Devon Crowe wheeled the same triple in LCTA bowling action this past week in their perspective leagues to share the 5th high triple of the week.

Mezzatesta rolled 706 (194, 246 – 51 pins over average , 266 – 71 pins over average – 121 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl. It was his 2nd 700 in a row as last week he posted 754 (244-



277-233) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League. It was also his 7th 700 of the season. Mezzatesta is averaging 200 for 21 games as a spare in the BWCL this season. In the 1986-1987 Sarnia and District Bowling Association City Championship Tournament, a team consisting of Roy Mezzatesta, Mark Haight, Mark Cook, Joe Morgado and Jamie Watts were the champions with a score of 3381.



Crowe bowled 706 (246-246-214) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl. It was his second 700 of the season as he previously bowled 757 (256-279-222). Devon is averaging 207 for 46 games in the FTBMNML this season while last year in the league he averaged 203 for 96 games. Crowe's career sanctioned high triple is 759 (256-267-236) which he bowled in the FTBMNML last season and his high single is 289 which he posted in the FTBMNML in the 2019-2020 season.

Parkkila holds down last spot:



Kole Parkkila hurled 704 (247-233-224) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl, to hold down last place in the 700 club this past week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his second 700 of the season as he previously bowled 705 (236-235-234) and his career 18th 700. He is averaging 209 for 15 games in the FTBMNML this season. Kole started enjoying the great game of 10-pin bowling at age 5 in the Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowlers League in the Bumpers Division. Kole is now 21 years old, so he has been attacking the bowling pins for 16 years even though a couple of those years were 5-pins at Marcin Bowl. The Parkkila twins also improved their games over the years under the watchful eyes of coaches Mel and Shirley Matthews.
