Weekly Highlights

Shephard slaughters the pins with 804:

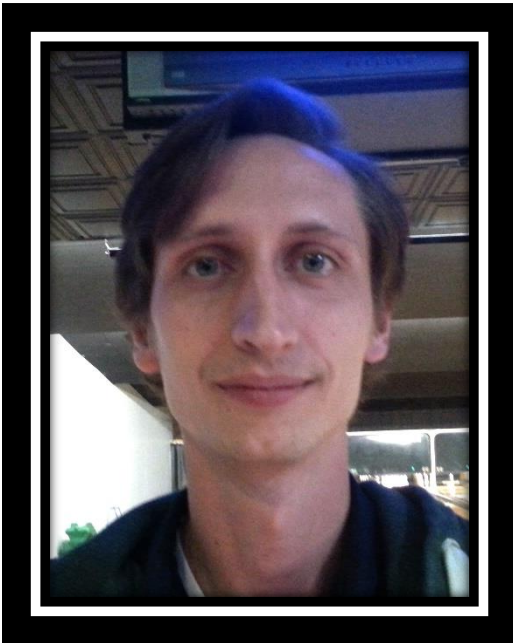
The pins didn't have a chance against Mike Shepherd this past Thursday night in Lambton



County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling activity. He mercilessly slaughtered them as he hurled 804 (268 – 65 pins over average – 258 – 55 pins over average – 278 – 75 pins over average -195 pins over average for three games. Shephard gave quite the “strike” show for his fellow bowlers as they watched him roll 29 out of a possible 36 strikes, 10 in his first game, 8 in his second game and 11 in his last game. Shephard qualifies for an 11 strikes in a row award as in his last game he had a split in the first frame then finished with 11 in a row. He is also eligible for an 800 award. Mike was also high over average for three games in the LCTA this week. He was bowling on lanes 23 & 24 in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl. It was his

career 7th 800 series to go along with his other 800's (815-827-804-805-802-814). It was also the first 800 triple in the LCTA this season.



**Ramsay is good for second place:**

Kirk Ramsay fired 752 (278 – 53 pins over average – 258-216) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to register the second high triple of the week. It was his 2nd 700 of the year as he previously wheeled 702 (239-235-228). Ramsay is off to a super start this season in the FTBMNML averaging 234 for 9 games.

Smith tops his old high triple:

Connor A Smith rolled 696 (211-219-266 – 83 pins over average – 147 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) at Marcin Bowl to establish a new personal high triple. His previous high triple was 674 and his highest single is 269. Smith is averaging 195 for 12 games in the SPBCML this year bowling on the “Gutter Gang” team with Dylon McKinnon, Will Finley, Owen Allison, Matt Nutt and Kris Mandeville. Last year he averaged 179 for 78 games in the league.

**Beveridge rolls career high triple:**

Trevor Beveridge tossed 680 (235-200-245) on lanes 13 & 14 in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl in LCTA activity this past week to post his career new high triple. His previous high triple was 667 and his career high single is 279. Beveridge is averaging 201 for 9 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the MFFL he averaged 187 for 90 games.



Weed fires career high scores:

Justin Weed fired 589 (165-219 – 77 pins over average – 205 – 63 pins over average – 163 pins over average for three games) on lanes 13 & 14 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl this past week to register his career highest triple and single game. His previous high scores were 535 and 192. Justin is a right-handed bowler who did not come up through any organized youth league but did Rock N Bowling a few times. He started organized league bowling three years ago at age 32 in the FTBMNML because his friends were bowling in the league and encouraged him to join their team. In his

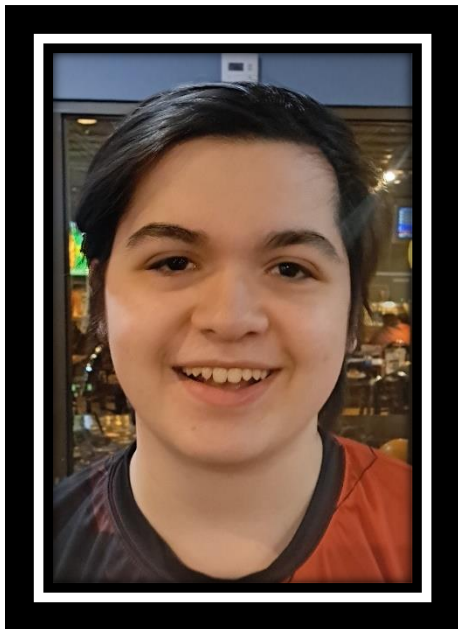
first year in the league in the 2022-2023 season, he averaged 129 for 78 games. Last year he averaged 142 for 75 games. This past Monday was his first action on the lanes this season. Weed’s other sporting interest is fishing, and he said his greatest enjoyment is spending his free time with his kids.

Bonhomme is 100 pins over average:

Rob Bonhomme wheeled 269 in his second game of the night to be 104 pins over average for a single game in LCTA bowling play. It was also his personal highest single game topping his previous 266. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 649 triple. His career high triple is 659. Bonhomme is averaging 182 for 9 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 175 for 85 games.



Allan is second high over average:



Jack Allan fired 242 (91 pins over average) in his second game of the night to be second high over average for a single game this week in LCTA bowling play. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl. Allan’s personal high scores are 651 and 257. Jack is averaging 165 for 9 games in the MFFL this year. Last year in the league he averaged 152 for 90 games.

Hunter records new personal high single:

They were his 4th and 5th 700’s of the season bringing his career total to 119 – 700’s for this young right-handed high revs bowler. Lapointe is averaging 226 for 9 games in the FTBMNML and 229 for 9 games in the SPBCML this year.



Gark notches his first 700 of the year:

Lefty Jeff Gark tossed 715 (245-225-245) on lanes 31 & 32 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record his first 700 of the season and the 5th high triple of the week. Gark had 2-700's in the 2022-2023 season and last year he had 1-700. Gark's career high triple is 725. Jeff is averaging 217 for 9 games in the FTBMNML this year. Watson sneaks into sixth spot:

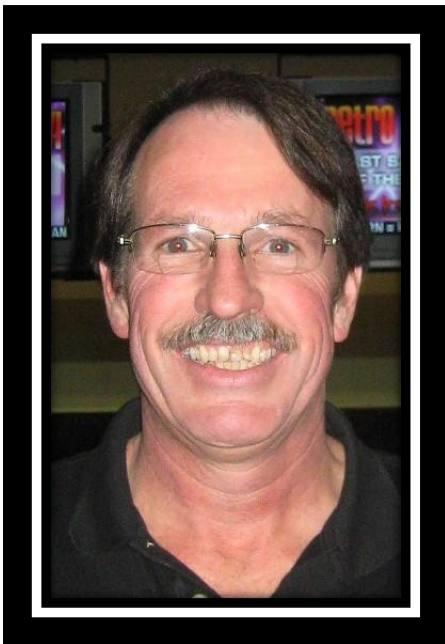
