



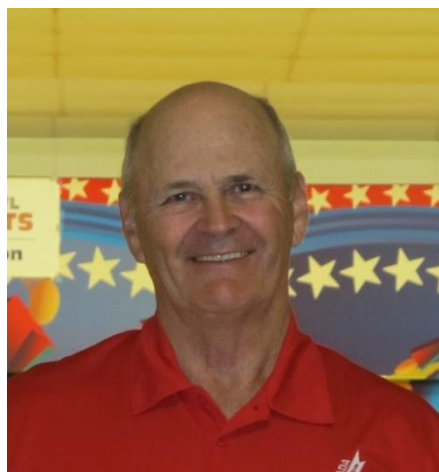

## **Right hander leads the way:**



Jim Creasor fired 749 (243-238-268) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to lead the way with the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association bowling (LCTA) action this week. Jim is having a solid year so far in the league leading all the bowlers with a 229 average after 30 games.

## **Lefty is second best:**



Kevin Schofield tossed 743 (267-221-255) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the week's second high triple. Kevin is polishing up his game for the "World Police and Fire Games" which he competes in every two years. These games are the second largest sporting event next to the summer Olympics. He has won 9 gold medals, 5 silver medals and 5 bronze medals at these games in Indianapolis, Barcelona Spain, Quebec City, Vancouver,

Australia, Belfast Ireland, Fairfax Virginia, New York City and Los Angeles. The next games he will be attending are in Chengdu China in 2019.

### **Adamson rolls top single:**



Kyle Adamson rolled 297 – came a tad light leaving 2-4-5 pins – 104 pins over average - lanes 25 & 26 – 2<sup>nd</sup> game – 682 - in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to post the week’s high single in LCTA bowling action. Kyle is a right handed bowler who did not come up through the ranks in a junior bowling program but took part in 5 pin bowling until he was seventeen years old. He then decided to try his luck with 10 pins on the deck rather than five. He is a solid competitor having recorded 7-300’s, 6-800’s (his highest is 813) and 3-298’s.

### **Lapointe is high over average:**



Jason Lapointe wheeled 705 (230-266 – 88 pins over average – 175 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to register the week’s high over average for three games. Jason, a right handed bowler, picked up his bowling skills when he went through the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Bowling program. He has carried a 200 plus average over the last eight years (208-215-202-216-206-200-210-208) but this year he is struggling a bit on the lanes averaging 185 for 24 games.
