



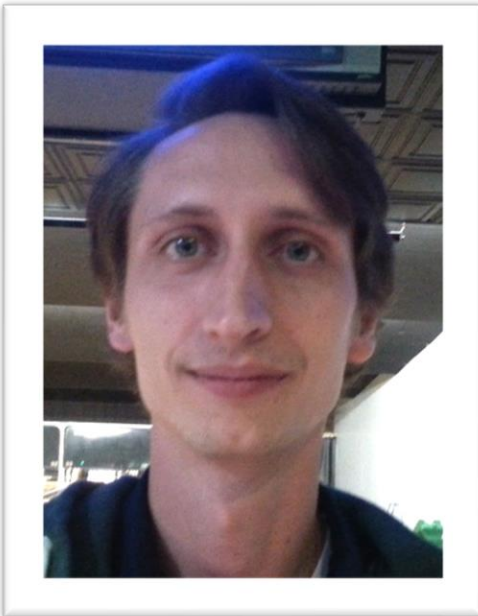

## Weekly Highlights

### Ramsay fires new high triple:



Kirk Ramsay fired 756 (253- 45 pins over average - 259- 51 pins over average – 244 – 132 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. Ramsay beat his previous high triple of 751 (247-268-236) which he bowled in the BWCL this season in January. He now has a career 2-700's to his credit. Ramsay is averaging 210 for 66 games in the BWCL this year.

### McLean establishes new high triple:

Andrew McLean tossed 736 (279- 84 pins over average – 228-229) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to register the 7<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his first 700 in the LCTA this year. McLean is averaging 203 for 18 games this year bowling on the "Napa Auto" team with Jim Amlin, Randy McEachern, Steve Best, Justin Armstrong and Justin Weed.



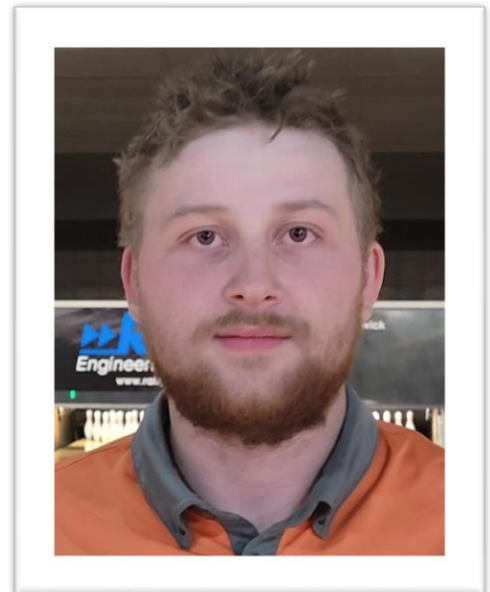
**Ingles wheels new high triple:**



Blake Ingles wheeled 665 (262 - 87 pins over average – 214 – 189 – 140 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl to establish a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 620 and his high single is 279. Ingles is averaging 177 after 23 weeks of bowling in the PYL this year. Last year in the PYL he averaged 165 for 67 games.

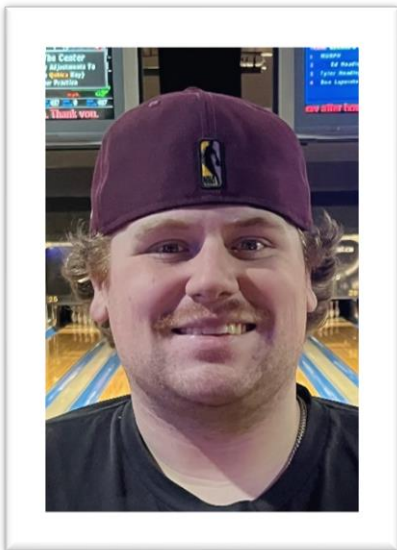
**Coleman 100 pins over average:**

fired 256 in his second game of the night to be 100 pins over average for a single game. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with 656 (185-256 – 100 pins over average – 215 – 188 pins over average for three games) to record a new personal high triple. His career high single is 260. He was high over average this week for both the single game and three games. He is eligible to receive the Canadian Tenpin Federation award which is a watch for being 100 pins over average for a single game. Coleman is averaging 158 for 54 games in the SPBCML this year.



**Osborn rolls career high triple:**

Aiden Osborn rolled 649 (219-215-215) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to record his career high triple in LCTA bowling activity this past week. His previous sanctioned high triple was 637 and his sanctioned high single is 255. Osborn is averaging 176 for 66 games in the MFFL this year bowling with team members Matthew Ingles, Sarah Ingles and Shane Chipman.

**Mauger beats his old triple:**

Evert Mauger tossed 641 (202-190-249 – 82 pins over average – 140 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 584 and his high single is 258. Mauger purchased a new balling from Steve Lewicki at Marcin Bowl last season and since then his game has been improving week by week. Mauger did not experience the fun of bowling in an organized youth league as he started organized 10 –pin bowling at age 50. The right handed bowler was introduced to bowling when friends wanted him to join their team in the FTBMNML and he has now been bonding with the boys for 6 years. Evert is averaging 169 for 63 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year he finished with 150 for 93 games in the league.



**Hannah rolls first 600 triple:**

Logan Hannah rolled 639 (177-243 – 83 pins over average – 219 – 59 pins over average – 159 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at Marcin Bowl to record his career first 600 triple. His previous high triple was 598 and his high single is 258 which he rolled this season. Hannah is averaging 162 after 23 weeks of bowling in the PYL this year. Last year in the PYL he averaged 162 for 84 games.

**Park posts new high triple:**

Shawn Park fired 639 (179-204-256 – 99 pins over average – 168 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to register his career new high triple nipping his previous 638. He was also second high over average for a single game in the LCTA this week. His highest single game is 260. Park purchased a Storm Red Hybrid ball this year but has really struggled with it until recently. He said his average went down from around 175 all the way into the 140's but he is rebounding now that he's getting used to the new ball. Park is averaging 160 for 69 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 172 for 96 games.



**Parkkila tops his high single:**

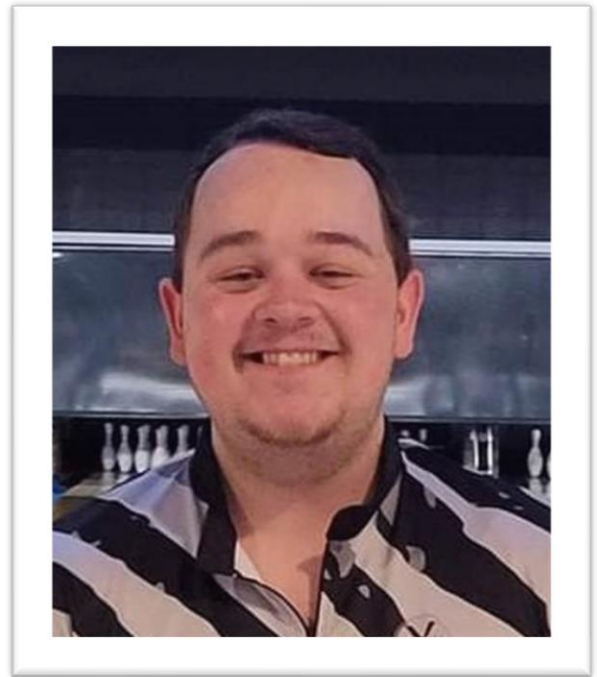
Cameron Parkkila tossed 266 (83 pins over average) in his first game of the night to post his career sanctioned high single game beating his previous 265. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl ending the night with a 665 triple. His sanctioned high triple is 673. Cameron started bowling 10 pin when he was six years old but switched to 5 pin bowling for two years before returning back to 10-pin. In the 2012-2013 LCTA bowling season, he averaged 64 for 72 games as a Senior Bantam. This year he is averaging 185 for 66 games in the MFFL.

**Mezzatesta records new high single:**

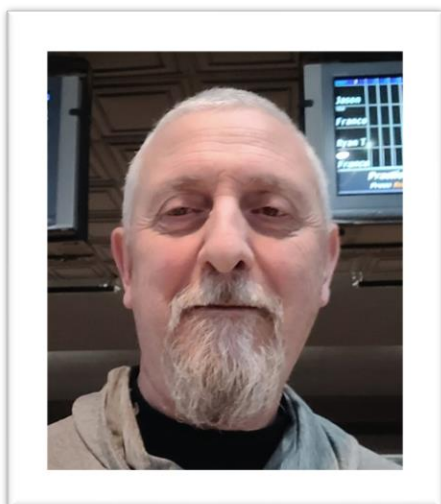
Steve Mezzatesta wheeled 202 in his last game of the night to record his new high single game beating his previous 200. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl. Steve's career high triple is 556. Mezzatesta is averaging 146 for 66 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year he averaged 123 for 81 games in the Target Trios Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl.

**Lapointe is week's top bowler:**

Ben Lapointe rolled 794 (278 – 59 pins over average – 257-259 - 137 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. He also rolled 754 (239-274 – 53 pins over average – 241) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl. His triples were good for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> high triples of the week. They were his 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> 700's in the LCTA this season and his career 104<sup>th</sup> and 105<sup>th</sup> 700's in the LCTA.



Lapointe is bowling full time or sparing in four leagues this year. His averages with the number of games in brackets are the following: BWCL 222 (48), Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League 217 (66), SPBCML 223 (60) and Mulder Financial Fun League 223 (45).

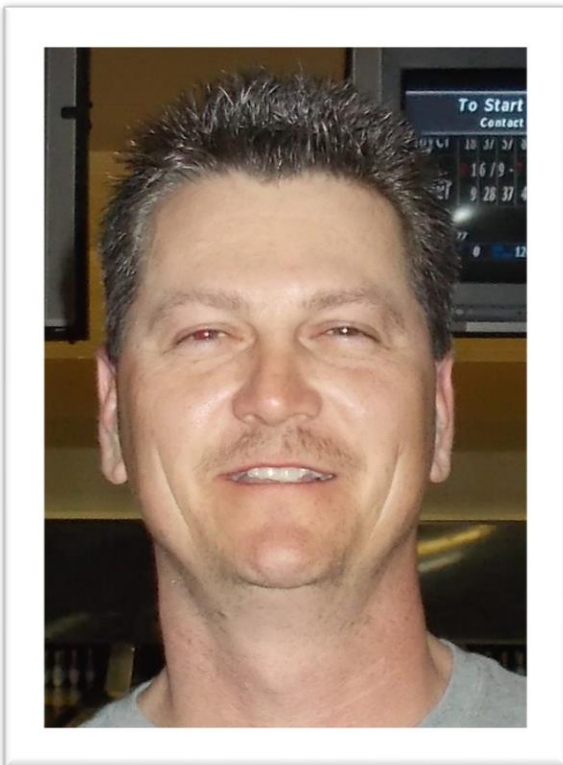
**Mezzatesta has solid week:**

Roy Mezzatesta started the first half of this bowling season in slow mode but his game is getting progressively stronger each week in the second half. He had 2 -700's this week in LCTA bowling activity. He wheeled 782 (245-257-280 – 66 pins over average – 140 pins over average for three games) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 25 & 26 and 732 (218-256 - 55 pins over average - 258 – 59 pins over average – 129 pins over average for three



games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to post the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> high triples of the week. They were his 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> 700's in the LCTA this season. He also had 699 (237-218-244) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) this week. Mezzatesta is bowling full time in three leagues this season. His averages with the number of games in brackets are BWCL 216 (72), FTBMNML 203 (66) and SPBCML 215 (75).

### **Creasor tops in Fabbri Tile league:**



Jim Creasor tossed 749 (277- 73 pins over average - 234-238 – 137 pins over average for three games) as a spare in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to record the top triple in the FTBMNML and the 5<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his first 700 triple in the LCTA this year. Creasor has three memorable bowling accomplishments: In the 2008 Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Provincial Tournament in St. Catharine's, he fired back to back 300's and 269 to end up with a super 869 triple. The Canadian Tenpin Federation record is held by Bill Kirton (889). He also tied

the Port Huron Tenpin Bowling Association triple record 868 (289-300-279) in 2017 and established a new LCTA triple record 876 (297-279-300) in 2015. Jim is currently averaging 212 for 18 games in the FTBMNML this year.



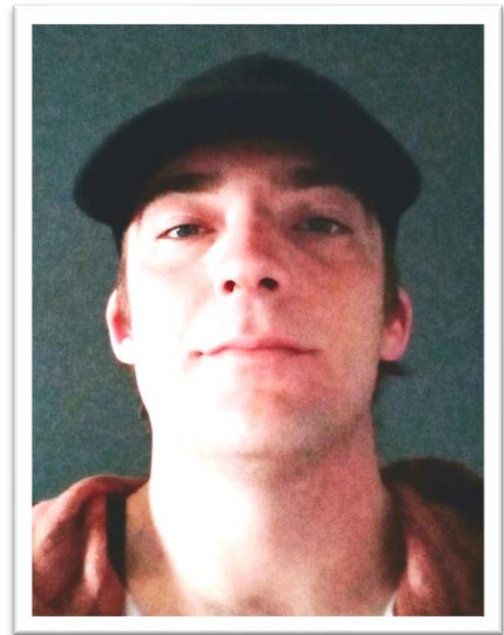
**Adamson takes sixth position:**

Kyle Adamson wheeled 742 (255-245-242) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to register the 6<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 5<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously tossed 701-707-700-781. Adamson is bowling full time in three leagues this year. His averages with the number of games in brackets are as the following: FTBMNML 210 (69), Best Wiring Classic League 197 (72) and Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League 201 (69). Kyle's career sanctioned high scores are 813

(6) and 300 (7).

**Kinny takes ninth position:**

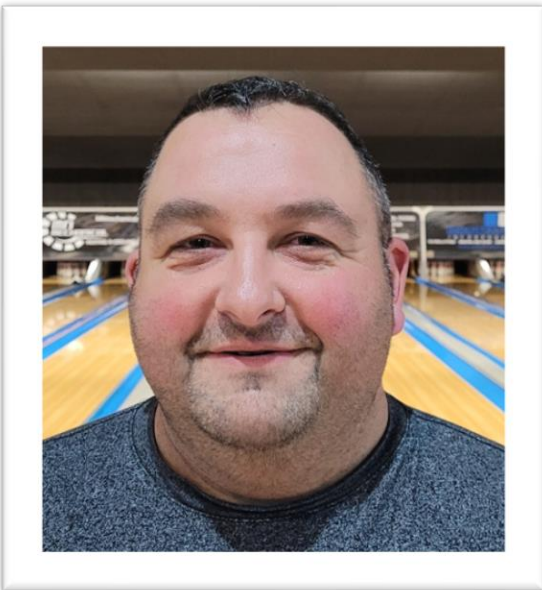
TJ Kinny hurled 727 (245-226-256) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to register the 9<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his 8<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season. Kinny, a strong right handed bowler with a ton of speed, is averaging 213 for 54 games in the MFFL and 208 for 60 games in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League this year.



**Watson rolls another 700:**

When the 2023-2024 bowling season started in September Bryce Watson had zero 700's. Let's fast forward this story and he now has 4-700's in his pocket in the LCTA with his latest one coming on Sunday morning. Watson tossed 716 (232-215-269 – 74 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic league (BWCL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the 10<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. His previous 700's were 713 (242-256-215), 725 (257-265-203) and 726 (234-223-269). He has 2-300's to his credit. Bryce is averaging 197 for 66

games in the BWCL this year.

**Gabriele grabs last place:**

Franco Gabriele rolled 700 (258 - 80 pins over average – 268 – 90 pins over average – 174 – 166 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post the low 700 triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. He needed a strike on his last ball to clinch the 700. It was his first 700 in the LTA this season. Gabriele's career sanctioned high scores are 745 and 273. Franco is averaging 181 for 51 games in the SPBCML this year. Last year he averaged 196 for 48

games in the SPBCML.

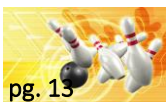
