Wilkinson is week's top bowler:

Johnny Wilkinson fired 781 (257-290 – 69 pins over average -234 – 118 pins over average for three games) in the 1046 Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to post the week's



high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was his second huge triple in the league this bowling season as he rolled 782 (279-257-246) in the third week of October. Wilkinson started bowling at age 5 in the Phantom Youth Junior Bowling Program at Hi-Way Bowl and has been enjoying the great sport of bowling ever since. He got hooked on 10-pin bowling at a young age because a lot of his family members bowled so it was natural for him to also enjoy the fun on the lanes. He said he looked up to his uncle who was a great bowler with lots of high scores and achievements. He also worked at Hi-Way Bowl for 4 years as a teenager which helped to cement his love for the game. His tournament experience over

the years included bowling with his aunt in the Ontario Family Twosome Tournaments, the Junior Nationals in Burlington, participating in Youth and Adult Ontario Provincial

Tournaments, local tournaments as well as 4 house tournaments in Port Huron. He specifically remembers the Invitational Singles Scratch Double Knock Out Tournament at Hi-Way Bowl a few years ago when he took second place competing against 32 other high caliber LCTA bowlers. In that tournament he had the first 11 strikes in his first game but finished with 297 in a boisterous atmosphere of whooping and hollering. He has a career 4-300's (sanctioned), plus a few other 300's (non-sanctioned), 2-791's, 796 and numerous 700's. Johnny said "bowling has been a large part of my life. I've bowled in almost every league in Sarnia at least once. At one time I was bowling 5 to 6 days a week but I still haven't been able to get the bowler's other dream – an 800 series". The high revs right hander is averaging 224 after 39 games in the 1046 Mixed League.

Creasor slides into second:



Jim Creasor wheeled 774 (260-269-245 – 105 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. The right handed kegler, who doesn't use his thumb hole when delivering the bowling ball, has rolled some good triples this season in the BMNML: 654 – 663 -685 – 681 – 707 – 752 - 784. He is averaging 226 after 36 games in the league. The league high average is held by Conner Smith (228 after 21 games) followed by Ben Lapointe (227 after 21 games). Jim has been extremely successful on the lanes with

career sanctioned scores 23-300's and 25-800's to his credit in Canadian/ American league and tournament competition.



Belliveau takes third place:



Pierre Belliveau rolled 744 (235-252-257) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to record the third high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. The lefty from London has recovered nicely from a medical condition that side lined him from the lanes for a month this year. Last week in the SMML a stubborn 4-pin refused to fall leaving him with a 299. He is having a solid year so far averaging 225 after

33 games. His career sanctioned high scores are 300 (October 19, 2017) and 799 (November 27, 2017) both recorded at Marcin Bowl. Pierre started bowling at the young age of 5 going through the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program in Wallaceburg/Chatham and also bowled in the youth bowling program at the now defunct Lakeside Bowl in Sarnia.

Best owns fourth spot:



Billy Best fired 735 (257-240-238 – 135 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to take ownership of the week’s fourth high triple. He is currently averaging 203 after 42 games.

Lefty Dan Cook tossed 729 (235-280 – 78 pins average for three Men’s League (SMML) at

His most memorable occasion on the lanes is when he won the Hi-Way Bowl Open Tournament in 1996. Cook bowls in two leagues this year with averages in brackets: SMML (205 – 45 games) and the Marcin Border City Men's League (195 – 48 games). His career sanctioned high scores are 300-2 and 802 which he bowled in Windsor in 2009.

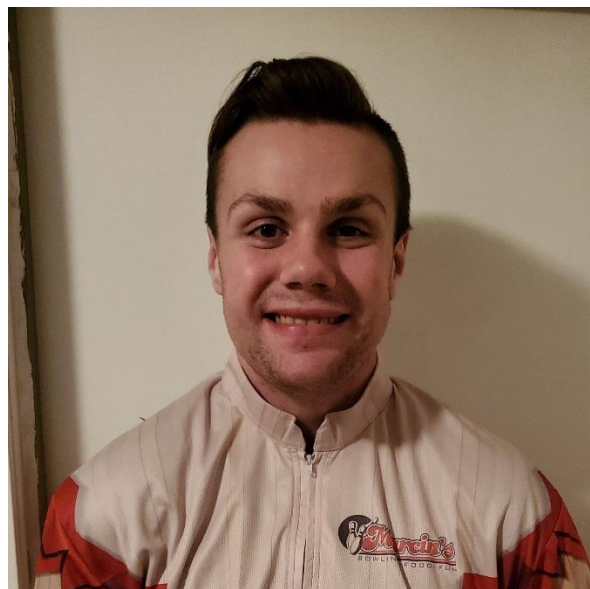
Late Recognition for bowler:

Jacob Bestard fired 695 (233-237-225 – 114 pins over average for three games) in the Intermediate Division in the Youth Bowling Program at Marcin Bowl to lead the way for the youth this week in the LCTA. He had a memorable occasion four weeks ago as he recorded his first 700 (201-220-279) in the LCTA Youth Doubles Tournament at Marcin Bowl. Jacob's bowling game is getting stronger week after week. He started bowling in the Marcin Youth Bowling Program at age 5 and has been enjoying the Saturday friendship with his fellow bowlers for 12



years. The right hander is averaging 196 after 45 games this year. He is following the footsteps of his grandfather (Dan) and his father (Drew) who went all the way through the Marcin SMAA Youth Bowling Program to become strong competitive bowlers until injuries knocked them off the lanes.
